We have selected to place our operations in two American factories (Greenfield, IN and Morristown, TN), and now being recognized by both national and state governments. Our Facilities

Drive down Jannetides Boulevard to the new campus and main headquarters of ULC located just east of Indianapolis.

The new headquarters is approximately 508,000 square-feet and boasts a 59,000 square-foot exhibit hall that artfully displays all the functional and stylish products ULC offers. Within this hall, ULC has constructed full-room setups and small vignettes for customers to get an idea of what furniture pairs beautifully together and how it would look within their space.

Now in its 3rd expansion, most of ULC's upholstery is manufactured in the heart of the Eastern Tennessee valleys of Morristown, TN.

The Tennessee plant is approximately 120,000 square-





feet, with 60,000 square-feet set aside for manufacturing ULC products.

It is here that all frames are handcrafted, the fabric is cut and accent pillows are filled to create a custom upholstered product.

On select upholstered products, ULC utilizes Velcro technology, a process in which the upholstery is attached onto the frame with hook and loop. This concept is not only eco-friendly, but saves customers money, as they can replace certain damaged pieces



of upholstery instead of the entire chair.

ULC also has showrooms in Japan and China, with an office and manufacturing facility in Malaysia.

In 1994, Jannetides founded Friends of the World (FOW). This group supports the use of environmentally farmed timber products and all of the organizations that produce those products.

Whenever possible, ULC uses farmed Hevea Brasiliensis. This product is harvested, managed, and farmed to prevent deforestation. In addition to utilizing safe lumber practices, the farms that grow the trees use the latex that secretes from the trees' vessels to produce latex based products, such as surgical gloves. On the average, one tree is used in the construction of 20 desks. The farms ULC buy wood from are certified by The Malaysian Timber Council and endorsed by The Forest Stewardship Council.




Greenfield, IN Facility

LOFT's big box customers require an aggressive shipping program with plenty of warehouse space to accommodate large quantities of product.

In addition to warehousing and shipping the main hardwood assembly and manufacturing resides in the Greenfield facility. ULC has a complete mill room.

Our manufacturing style is based on the Toyota Way. Components are delivered to one end of the cell and then assembled as they progress around the cell. Items are inspected and then boxed at the end of the cell. This type of manufacturing allows for the line supervisor to be involved throughout every step of the assembly process.





ULC's beginning was in college and university furnishings, so we have over 31 years of experience manufacturing these products, and our workmanship is second to none. In our wood furniture, we use mortise and tenon joinery, which is one of the oldest and strongest joinery methods in woodworking for angled joints. We also use English Dovetail

joints, which allow for the largest possible drawers, no matter what the design of the furniture.

Our ball-bearing drawer glides provide superior strength and functionality. They have been tested with a 100 pound load in the drawer and then repeatedly opened and closed, so you can be confident that our drawers will stand up to rigorous daily use. We also use high pressure laminate tops to provide a long-lasting surface that stands up to impacts that would damage conventional wood tops.





As ULC has grown as a company, we've added to our superior college furnishings and have used our manufacturing knowledge to provide innovative, high quality products in other markets as well. We are continually striving to improve, as is shown through our retail upholstery. ULC recently introduced new foam coil cushion technology.

The seating is a combination of high-density polyurethane foam and pocketed steel coil inner springs. Each steel coil is encased in its own non-woven fabric pocket, which allows each spring to work independently. These pocketed coils are then joined together to form a coil pack which will be inserted into the

foam cushion. The independent coils provide more support and comfort than the typical upholstery seating.

Diversified Testing Labs tested this new technology at 40,000 cycles, or the equivalent of five years of use. This is TWICE as long as the standard testing that our competition uses. Not only did ULC's foam pass the test, but the vinyl showed no wear and there was no seam slippage or thread breaking. This recent testing is just one example of the superior quality offered by ULC that is far above the competition.

In addition to the high quality we provide, our furniture is #1 in safety. Every piece of furniture undergoes rigorous testing and inspections. 





Recycling

University LOFT Company rejects product components that do not meet our stringent quality inspections. These products are reclaimed and repurposed to build items for our sample room and components of our standard items. No wood is wasted at any of our facilities. Any wood that cannot be used at the Indianapolis facility is sent to the upholstery plant for use in our solid hard wood frame construction. We also reuse our cardboard and ply container boxes, and pallets.







Succession

If anything should happen to incapacitate James Jannetides, the CEO, then Jeff Carlson, Vice President of Sales would assume the role of CEO. Every department has contingency plans for succession. Cross training is a part of every department.

Disaster Recovery Plan

Several Plans are in place or have been utilized in the event some type of disaster happens that affects our ability to service our customers. One particular disaster happened September 1, 2003, when heavy rains caused our building to flood. In this case, the President, Vice President of Operations, Plant Manager, Assistant Plant Manager and the Administrative Assistant to the President all responded to the disaster and were on scene until we had control of the water coming into the building. The next day we ceased operating the facility in our normal manner and all employees, salaried as well as hourly, were assigned specific tasks to minimize damage to product, computers, carpeting and other office equipment. Within three days we had all the water out of the building and were inspecting and segregating product that had sustained damage. We inspected 100 percent of all product suspected of water damage and repackaged the good product in new cartons. After we had recovered from this incident, we made several physical changes to drains on the building that would prevent this from happening again.

More general plans, processes, suppliers and material backups are in place in the event something happens affecting our ability to service our customers. These are as follows:

- We carry spare critical parts for our major woodworking equipment in the event it goes down.
- We have backup equipment for our air compressor, panel saw, routers, table saws, finish line, sanders, boring machine and dovetailers. Should any one of these pieces go down we have the capability to make the part, but not as labor efficient.
- Two backup woodworking vendors are located within an hours drive of our facility.
- We have multiple sources for laminate tops.
- 30,000 square feet of our facility are currently being utilized to store raw materials we may need in emergencies. Some of the items in this area are side panel, drawers, doors, frames, wood tops, odd size laminate tops and purchased dimension stock.
- We have a huge supply of drawer glides available.
- We have multiple finish material suppliers.
- A carton supplier can turn orders for us in 24 hours if needed.
- Multiple sources are available for nearly all our purchased items.
- We are currently developing three more sources for our wood, plywood and lumber needs. All are within a 2 1/2 hour drive of Indianapolis.
- We have a backup plant in Tennessee that has the same capabilities we have.
- ULC has a total of over 200 years of woodworking experience who can handle any emergency regarding delivering a quality product to our customers.
- Most importantly, we have EXPERIENCED DEPENDABLE people in place who can handle the emergency.

ULC REMAINS COMMITTED TO USING SOLID WOOD THAT IS ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY

At University Loft, we've made a conscious and strategic decision to do what we can to help preserve our environment. We feel certain that if we do not protect the environment, we will have nothing for future generations to inherit. And as a manufacturer, we know that we must guard our natural resources even as we maximize our production capabilities. With this in mind, ULC uses environmentally farmed timbers in our furniture production so we do not contribute to deforestation.

Why is this important? Worldwide, more than 3/4 of the planet's original primary forests have already been destroyed or degraded. Still, irresponsible transnational corporations continue to engage in destructive logging for wood and paper production.

Worldwide, forests are under attack due to harvesting practices widely used by logging industries. Deforestation and the destruction of the environment has become an enormous problem. That's why, in 1998 with Executive Order 13-101, President Clinton mandated that Federal agencies use any resources available to them to "green" the government. At University Loft Company, we recognize the urgency of this issue and support environmentally responsible efforts at all levels.

THE MANY ADVANTAGES OF UNIVERSITY LOFT'S ENVIRONMENTALLY FARMED TIMBER

At ULC, we know that our customers expect only the best from us. That's why - in support of our environmental commitment - we use **Hevea Brasiliensis** (**HB**), an eco-friendly species of tree we refer to as Environmentally Farmed Timber, or EFT. University Loft Company purchases HB from farms certified by The Malaysian Timber Council and from the SCS Forest Management Program endorsed by the Forest Stewardship Council which ensures farm quality, land management, and work practices. Classified as a hardwood, HB has been proven stronger than Northern Red Oak in independent lab testing.

Another benefit of HB is that when finished, it looks virtually identical to natural

oak. With mostly straight grain with few concentric markings, it's an attractive and durable solid wood furniture material.

HB is also the environmentally responsible choice. During its growth cycle, HB produces a natural form of latex that is tapped from its trunk to be used in the production of rubber. Hevea Brasiliensis is a managed crop. It is laid out in sectors and harvested on a 20-year plan. When HB trees are 3 to 4 years old, they are tapped for latex. This latex is used to produce tires, surgical gloves, and other rubber products. In the past, HB trees that had exhausted their latex supply were burned or left to rot. In time, however, it was discovered that HB could be dried to a hardwood suitable for furniture production. With virtually no timber waste after years of productive latex tapping, HB is indeed an eco-friendly Environmentally Farmed Timber. Hevea Brasiliensis produces latex for 20 years, after which it is cut down for timber use. Since the late 1800's, HB trees have been farmed, grown for their rubber and then harvested for timber.

HARDWOOD HEVEA BRASILIENSIS PROVEN STRONGER THAN OAK IN LAB TEST


Northern Red Oak is often considered the standard for strength and durability in furniture production. But at University Loft, we've found an alternative that's been proven stronger than oak in independent laboratory testing.

In one such test, the "screw pull" test, HB broke at 160 lbs. of pressure while Northern Red Oak snapped under 140 lbs. of pressure. This test and others have shown time and again that HB is a superior material for furniture manufacturing.

HB TREES HAVE THE 3-TO-1 ENVIRONMENTAL ADVANTAGE OVER OAK

HB trees take 20 years to grow to harvestable maturity. Oak trees take 60 years. In other words, 3 Hevea Brasiliensis trees can be grown and harvested in the time it take for one oak tree to be ready to be milled. This 3-to-1 HB advantage demonstrates the sustainability of this natural resource.

Although many logging companies have begun using responsible forestry management practices, this typically only includes planting additional oak seedlings for every full-grown tree cut down. This is a good start as a hedge against deforestation, but it will still take at least 60 years for each of these trees to reach a harvestable diameter. In that same time frame, 3 full-size HB trees can be harvested for furniture production by University Loft. Because of this, we believe our use of this Environmentally Farmed Timber is the eco-responsible way to supply our furniture production without depleting the world's forests.



UNIVERSITY LOFT'S GREEN PLAN

To maintain commitment and focus in our environmental initiatives, ULC utilizes a Green Plan. A Green Plan is a resource the Greenpeace organization defines as containing long-term environmental strategies that ensure a high quality of life for present and future generations.

Any good Green Plan must be long-term and comprehensive; and it will clarify environmental goals and translate them into specific actions. Green plans consider not only environmental, but also economic conditions.

Under the direction of ULC's President and CEO James Jannetides, University Loft Company was an early adopter of green initiatives. In January 1999, Jannetides drove the company to become a model for all businesses in caring responsibly for the environment, now and for future generations.

The true and continuing effect of this initiative is that it changes how businesses purchase products. Working cooperatively, businesses find new ways of sharing "green" knowledge and best practices while involving an ever-increasing number of employees, suppliers and clients.
