

UNISA in Ethiopia






- UNISA is operating in Ethiopia based on the invitation of the Government to collaborate in high level human capital development.

Applying for Admission

- In order to be admitted to UNISA PhD and Master's programs in 2021, you need to apply for admission.
- All UNISA admission applications are done online at: www.unisa.ac.za/apply.
- The application period is from 15 September to 06 November 2020.
- Thereafter, only a few qualifications with spaces available will remain open until the end of January 2021
- You can apply for the following qualifications outside the application period.
 - MSc in Nature Conservation
 - Qualifications in the Department of Decision Sciences
 - Qualifications in the College of Science, Engineering and Technology (except for Computer Science qualifications)
- Students will be informed the outcome of their application towards the middle of February / beginning of March 2021.





Steps in Admission Application

- You will go through the following steps to complete your online application.
 - Access UNISA web and find your qualification of interest. Then read about admission requirements, research focus area, and other details about the qualification.
 - Apply for a student number (If you already have a Unisa student number, this is not needed)
 - Apply for admission
 - Upload your documents
- Before you apply for admission for your selected qualification, **prepare your research outline** in line with the departmental requirements based on one of the focus areas available.
- Students applying in the College of Science, Engineering and Technology must contact the department prior to applying in order to find a suitable supervisor who will provide a letter of confirmation.

Documents Needed for Application

- The following documents are needed for application.
 - Academic Documents
 - degrees and academic records (student copies) of all completed qualifications
 - Passport OR birth certificate
 - Must indicate birth date and full name including grand father's name in English
 - Outline of proposed research (3-5 pages) describing:
 - Title
 - Summary of topic
 - Short literature review
 - Expected contribution of the study
 - Methodology to be followed
 - Availability of the data
 - List of references
 - Reasons why you are interested in the topic
 - Curriculum Vitae (CV)
 - The departmental questionnaire (only for applications in the College of Agriculture and Environmental Sciences)





Preparing Documents for Application

- Your documents must be made ready in electronic format (scanned/saved) in your computer for uploading.
- The files to be uploaded for application need to conform to the following specification.
 - Each document must be uploaded as a separate file. Academic documents can be combined as one file.
 - Maximum number of files allowed is 5.
 - Files can't be larger than 2MB (2048KB) each.
 - Only black and white documents may be submitted.
 - Only the following file types are allowed: PDF, DOC (Word document file) or TIF (image file).
- Suggestions:
 - If you do not have a scanner, download 'Clean Scanner' on your smart phone and scan with it.
 - If your file is larger than 2MB, you can compress it at http://pdfcompressor.com/

- send the list with a formal letter to MOSHE and UNISA Ethiopia Centre.



- your full name (including grand father's name)
- qualification applied for,
- Unisa student number (that would be provided to you in the online application process),
- your telephone number, and
- your email address.
- Apply as early as possible. Do not wait for the list to be sent.

- Please review the guide before you start and refer to it during online application.
- Skipping steps and uploading incomplete documents were main reason for rejection of many applications in the past.
