


### Our Vision

# Program Overview

- Competitive scholarship opportunity
- Tuition assistance and seed capital every semester
- Primarily focused on Customer Discovery
- Students are organized into annual cohorts that work together and hold each other accountable
- Core outcomes:
  - Gainful employment as an innovator in their field
  - Placement in an accelerator, incubation, or apprenticeship program
  - Raise capital to work on their ideas as Founders



## Award Package Breakdown

- Up to \$12,000:
  - \$1,000\* in seed capital per semester
  - \$1,000\* in tuition assistance per semester
- Up to \$18,000:
  - paid summer internships with local startups
- Fine Print:
  - Total \$30,000 award package is contingent on completing six semesters in the program and three paid summer internships.



### What We Look For

- Empathy, passion, curiosity, coachability, and ingenuity
- Full-time students in post-high-school institutions in the Washington D.C. & Baltimore Metro Areas or any University System of Maryland institution
  - Includes community colleges and trade schools
- Novel, technology-enabled ideas in science, technology, engineering, math, healthcare, finance, infrastructure/civil, education/literacy, and business
- Strong history of academic achievement
- Students that are in the early stages of their entrepreneurial journey



## **Application Process**



Submit the following by the deadline:

- Start-up proposal that outlines their bright idea
- Cover letter
- Official transcript
- Letters of support from at least one mentor and stakeholder



The selection committee deliberates on the top applicants that become semi-finalists




The finalists are selected and admitted into the next cohort.
