
From The Desk of El' Presidente



August 2009 Car of The Month Mark Kuzia's 1975 Dodge Dart



I bought this 75 Dart in March this year, intended it to be a cruiser until I get my 68 Dart restored. It had a 225 slant 6 with a 904 auto, 4 wheel drum brakes, and a relatively recent (but cheap) paint job on a completely rust free body. The next week I made it to the Allen Samuels LX show on March 22nd, and that was the last place it ever went. I got home, parked it, and the next morning the trans hemorrhaged all it's life blood. The bands were shot, every seal was leaking and there were several stripped bolts in the case.

My next thought was, if I am going to replace the trans, I might as well throw in a V8! I secured a 318/904 combo, but soon found out that the 318 was seized. On the bright side, the trans was almost new. I found a 360 that I put together on the cheap with some mild parts and a few deals from club members. It is a 77 360 with a 204/214 cam, 340 intake, 625 Carter, Hedman headers, and Pypes exhaust. I have spent the last two months getting it all together and in the car, most that time was just trying to find the correct accessory brackets and pulleys. I ended up spending a lot more money than I intended, but I now have a nice cruiser that I can be proud of. Now I just have to pray that the 7 1/4 rear stays together long enough for me to find a 8 1/4 or 8 3/4 rear end.




