

Key functions

1.
Cong press power button to turn the unit `ON` or `OFF`

2. ▷ Short press to play or pause music

3. W Volume increase/next track

4. ₩ Volume decrease/previous track

5. DC:5V Use the provided USB cable for charging the unit with DC 5V charger or Connect to Computer

6. MIC Microphone

7. LED indicator Blue light indicates working, Red light indicates charging

8. Pick up/End call

9. Reset Hard press to restart the unit if the unit appears not to be working.

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Operating the speaker

A. Power On Status

Long press the power button for several seconds and you will hear the `Beep` sound and the blue indicator light starts blinking quickly.

B. Power Off

Long press the power button for several seconds, and you will hear a `Beep` sound 4 times and the unit will power off.

C. Bluetooth Pairing

If the speaker never has been paired with a Bluetooth device before, you need to follow the instructions below to pair the speaker with your Bluetooth device.

- After hearing the `Beep` sound, the speaker is ready to pair with your Bluetooth device and the Blue LED indicator light will flash quickly.
- Activate Bluetooth on your compatible device and set it to search for compatible devices.
- Select the speaker "ENV-1359" from the list of found devices.

Note:

If the speaker is already connected to another Bluetooth device, the speaker will not appear in the search list, so you need to disconnect the already paired Bluetooth device from the speaker and search again.

- 4) If your device asks for a passkey, enter the digits "0000" and press "OK" (varies depending on the Bluetooth device manufacturers, model and software version).
- 5) If the pairing is successful, the speaker will play a short `Beep` sound and the Blue LED indicator light will be constantly illuminated instead of flashing rapidly and your speaker is ready to play music and receive calls from mobile device. When you play music, the Blue LED indicator light will flash slowly. Once you pause music, the light will flash slowly for a couple of seconds, and then the light is constantly illuminated.

Note:

If the speaker has been paired to the Bluetooth device before you need to follow the pairing instructions below to connect the speaker to the Bluetooth device:

Activate Bluetooth on your compatible device and the speaker will connect automatically to the compatible device and you will hear the `Beep` sound.

A. Playing Music in Bluetooth Mode

After Bluetooth is connected successfully, the speaker will play the music played on your mobile device. Short press the `\!\ \text{button to pause the music, and short press the \text{\text{bull}} \text{\text{button again to resume the music.}}

Press shortly the ` ₩ ` button to play next track and press shortly the ` ₩ ` button to play the previous track.

Hold down the `™` button to increase the volume and hold down the `™` button to decrease the volume.

B. Using the Speaker as Hands-free Bluetooth Speaker Phone

When your Bluetooth device is paired with the speaker and if there is an incoming or outgoing call, the speaker will shift from music mode to call mode automatically. In case of an incoming call, press 2 on the speaker to pick up the call.

After completing the call, press again to hang up. The music will automatically resume after the call is has ended.

Speaker charging

The speaker has a built-in rechargeable battery. Connect the provided USB cable to a computer or into a DC 5V power adaptor to charge. When the speaker is charging the LED indicator light will be red. When the speaker is fully charged, the red LED will turn off (the charging time is approximately 3 hours). Unplug the Speaker from the power device once the speaker is fully charged.

The battery playing time depends on the playing volume (the higher volume, the shorter playing time). If you have not used the speaker for a long time, please charge it before use. We also recommend that you charge the battery once a month, which can protect the battery and extend the battery life.

Shower & suction functions

This unit is IPX4 certified, which means you can enjoy music & phone calls during the shower. The speakers suction cup can stick to any smooth surfaces.

Note: Please do NOT submerge the unit into water, as this will ruin the speaker.

Wireless: With BLUETOOTH V3.0, including A2DP / HFP/AVRCP.

Trouble shooting guide

Should you experience any trouble while using the speaker, please refer to the following chart.

Fault	Reason	Solution
Not Char- ging	The USB power adaptor (not included) is not plugged into a wall outlet or the USB cable (included) is not plugged into the 2.0MM jacket on the side of the speaker.	Plug the USB power adaptor (not included) into a wall outlet and plug the USB cable (included) into the 2.0MM jacket of the speaker.
	Wall outlet is not functioning.	Plug another device into the same outlet to confirm the outlet is working.
	Computer USB port is not function.	Make sure your computer power is turned on and try another USB port.

Fault	Reason	Solution
No Sound	The speaker battery is dead.	Recharge the speaker
	The speaker is not connected to the cell phone.	Go through "Speaker Operations" process to connect the speaker.
	Volume set is too low.	Increase the volume of your device.
Speaker cannot be connec- ted	Pairing does not work	Check whether the audio source supports the A2DP protocol
	Audio source is switched off	Switch on the audio source
	Bluetooth is switched off at the audio source.	Switch on the Bluetooth function in the audio source.
	Bluetooth version is not supported.	Use a different playback unit.

Fault	Reason	Solution
Poor Sound quality from a Blue- tooth device	Bluetooth device is almost out of range of the speaker	Move your Bluetooth device closer to the speaker
