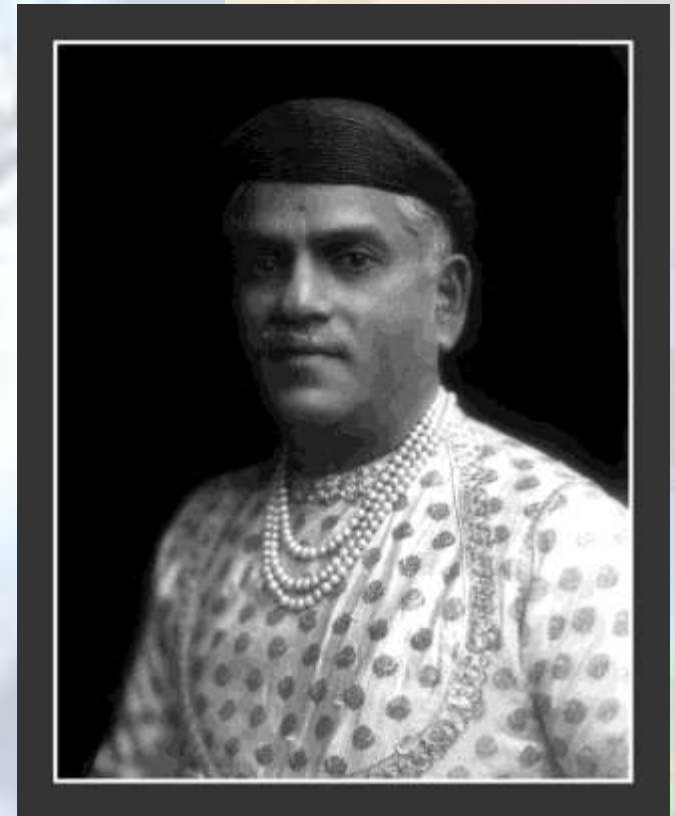

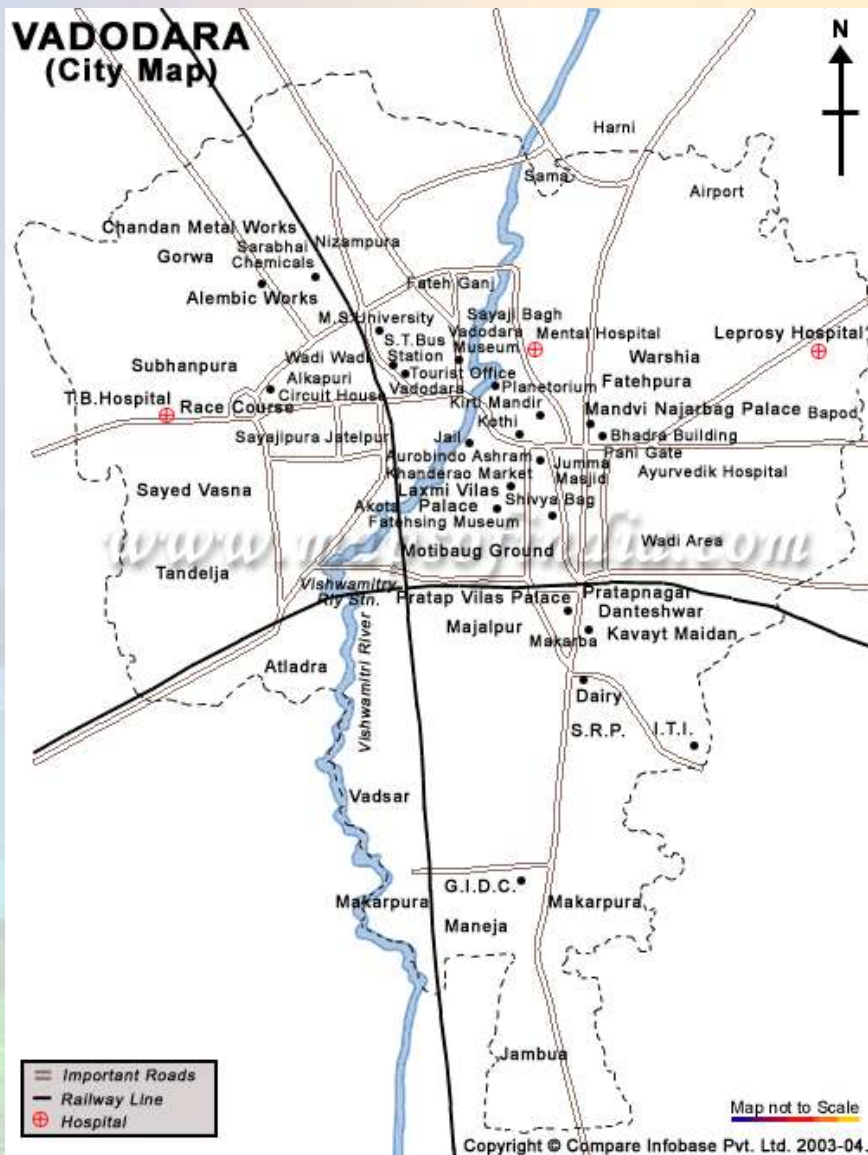

# Habitat

Vadodara lies in the eastern part of Gujarat and in western India.

A medium sized, pleasant city, it was established on the banks of the River Vishwamitri by its earliest inhabitants as far back as 812AD.

The entire Vadodara district sprawls some 7794 sq.kms. and has almost 40% cosmopolitan population; the River Narmada forms a natural boundary to the south and the River Mahi to the north.

Vadodara city still retains its princely, old world charm. Once, the capital of the Gaekwad state, it owes much to Sayajirao Gaekwad III, who ruled in the late 18th and early 19th centuries and developed the city as an educational, commercial and industrial centre.



# Climate

- The climate of Vadodara is pretty much akin to that of central India.
- Summers - fairly warm with average temperatures of around 24°C to 42°C (max- 46° C) in the months of March, April, May and June.
- End June finds the temperatures easing a bit with the onset of the monsoons. The months of June, July and August receive as much as 900 mm of rainfall but average temperatures remain at around 15°C to 28°C.
- Winters - more pleasant with temperatures in the range of 9°C to 31°C ( min - 1°C) in the months of November, December, January and February.





# Culture

- A unique blend of various cultures led to its title of “Sanskari Nagri”
- Festivals of Navratri, Diwali, Ganesh Chaturthi, Eid, Christmas, New Year, Uttarayan/ Makarsakranti, Holi, etc. are celebrated with equal passion and joy.
- Navratri-festival celebrated for 9 nights is a spectacular event organised every year with fanfare and enthusiasm.
- Garba is the most popular women folk dance of Gujarat and Vadodara is famous for the celebration of Navratri.
- NRG’s and NRI’s along with foreign tourists flock to Vadodara to enjoy the revelry and grandeur of this festival.
- The Laxmi Vilas palace, rated among the 5 grandest palaces of India, is the site for folk dances organised by the royal family of this princely city.





# Education

- Vadodara is synonymous with education. The patronage of education started with Maharaja Sayajirao and the city has been built further on the academic infrastructure established by him.
- Over 20 public schools and over 100 private schools.
- Maharaja Sayajirao University, the jewel in the Baroda crown, is the 1st university in Gujarat with English as the medium of instruction. It has 13 faculties and 17 residential hostels, 4 of them for women students. The university caters to over 1,00,000 students.
- The fine Arts faculty is famous worldwide for its contribution in arts. The faculty of performing arts is also a very reputed institution teaching music, drama, dancing, etc.

# Major Infrastructure - Sardar Sarovar Dam

Sardar Sarovar Project, located just within 85 kms. of Vadodara is a multipurpose Interstate Project of 4 States (Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Rajasthan) being implemented by Govt. of Gujarat to appropriate major portion of the water of the Narmada for domestic and industrial use in Gujarat as well as for generating hydro-electric power in the Narmada basin.
