Five fields of emphasis:

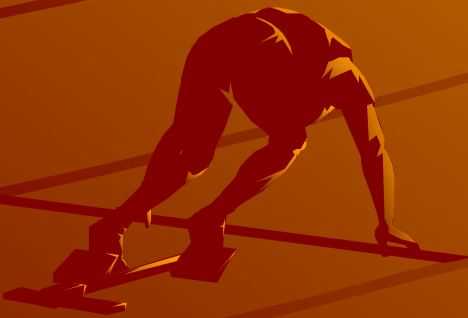
1. Advancement

5. Special Programs and Events.





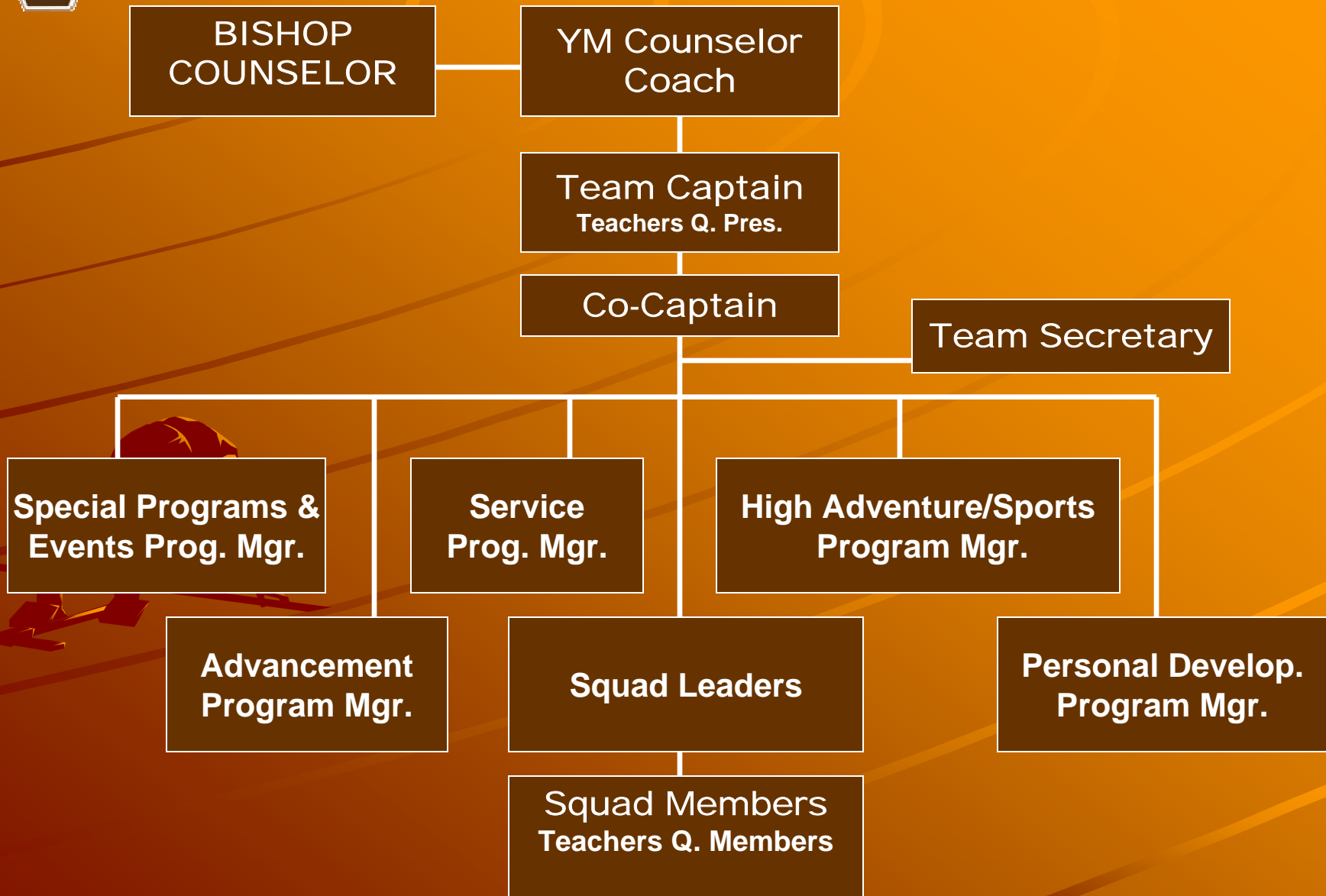
Varsity Lingo

- Boys are organized into "squads"



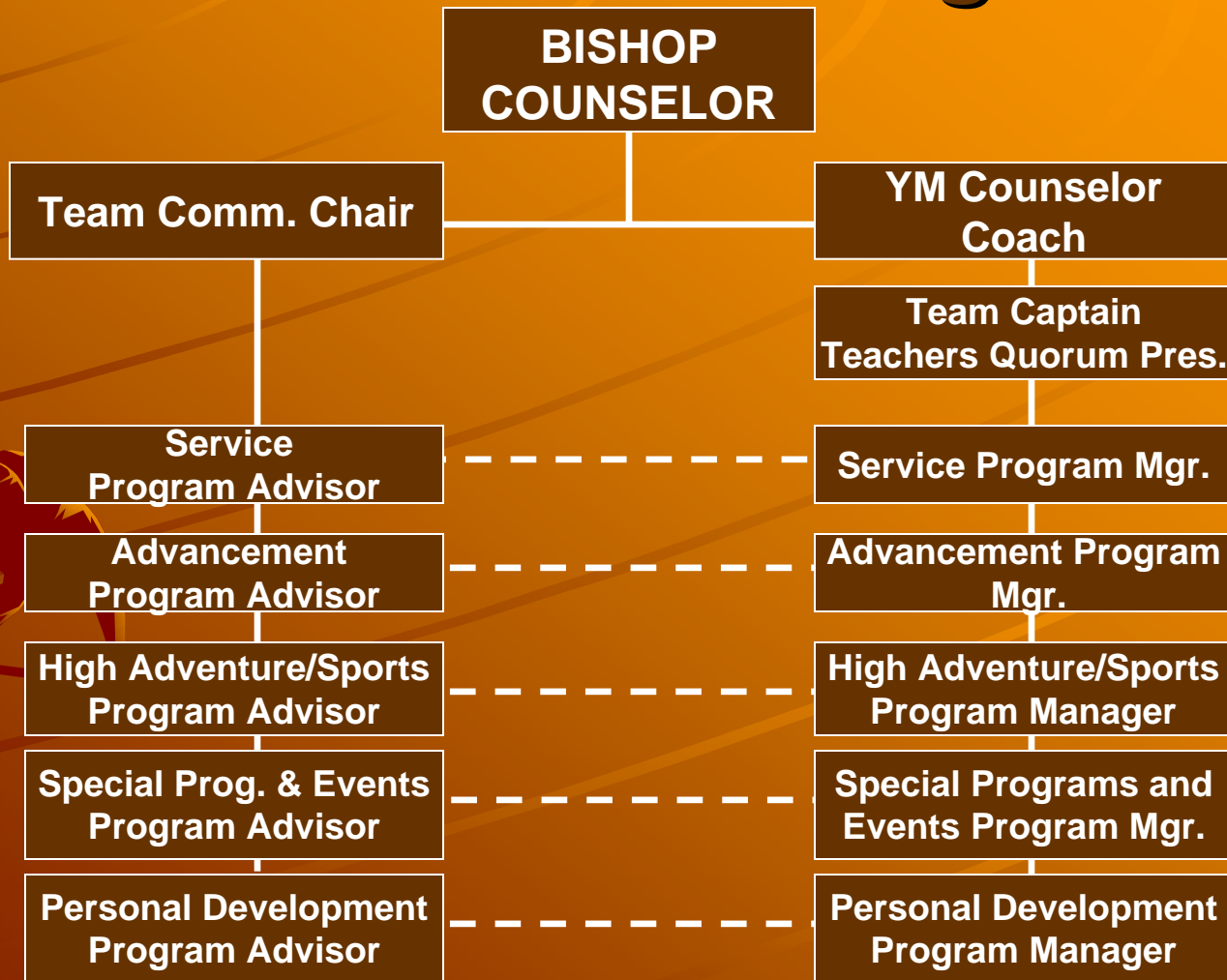


Varsity Team Organization



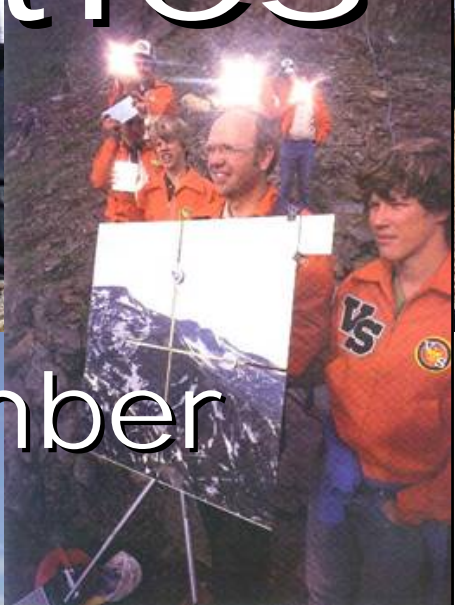

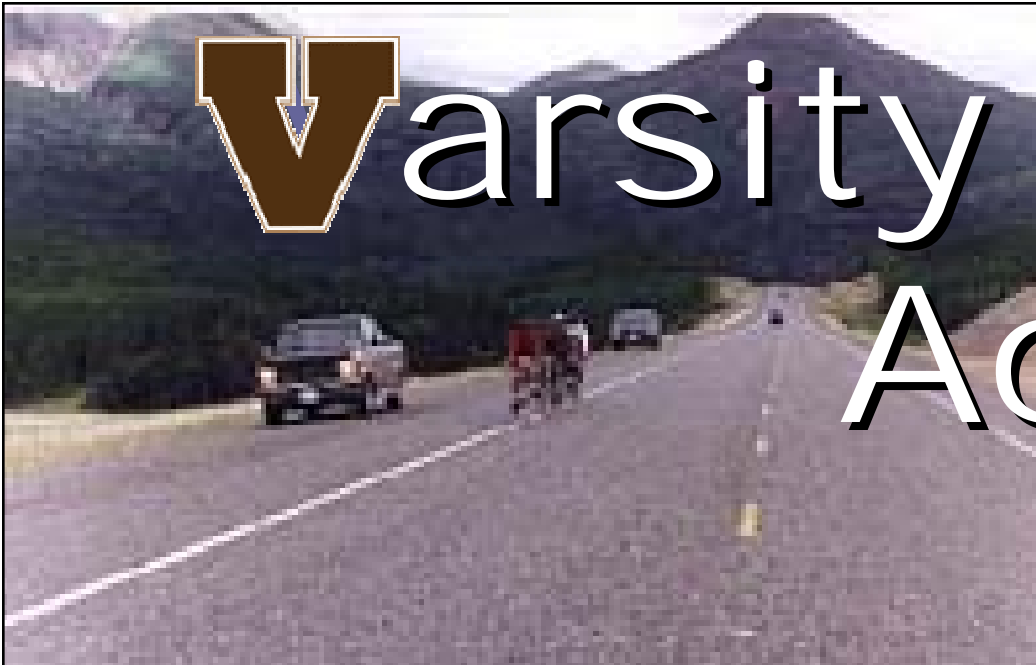
