Christian Education Opportunities for Adults—Fall 2013



Experience scripture like never before!

The Story is God's unfolding story from the Bible, presented as one sweeping narrative, arranged chronologically from Genesis to Revelation. If you have never read the whole Bible (or if it has been a while) The Story makes it easy, as well as helping participants understand how their stories intersect with God's story.

This will be a powerful church-wide experience. Pastor John will be preaching from these stories on Sundays, children and youth will read/hear the same stories in age-appropriate Sunday School lessons, and adults may participate in additional ways as interested - Bible Study groups, small groups, reading individually, or guiding family discussions.

Books will be available to purchase after church beginning September 1st. Small group sign-ups begin that day as well.

Listen to the author's dramatic reading of this novel that uses a fact-based fiction-



al narrative to follow six first-century Romans who come together to discuss the gospel as Mark is writing it. The diverse characters each have their own dramatic storylines steeped in the history and culture of the time.

The sessions are an entertaining, edgy, and unique opportunity to "go deep" in the study of the Gospel of Mark. There are approximately three segments each meeting--20-minute reading followed by a 10-minute break for "Q & A" (x 3.)
