NEWS FROM BIG QU

(FROM 18 JAN QU BOARD MEETING)

2021-22 Focus/Meetings: In anticipation of the COVID situation improving, the QU Board is looking at how should we merge things (virtual and live) and what will work as we "go back to normal". Decisions on the Fall Event and Annual Meeting are detailed below. Most Chapters have different needs/wants and each Chapter will determine what works for their group.

Fall Event: Based on the success and profitability of the 2020 Fall Event, the QU Board agreed that future Fall Events will feature both virtual classes and lectures. Planning is on-going for the 2021 event.

Annual Meeting: The QU Board decided to separate the Annual Meeting from the QU Quilt Show. The "annual meeting" content will be distributed electronically (email or newsletter) with Voting handled electronically. The Board is also considering offering a Spring "activity" – either a lecture and/or workshops (most likely virtually) or some other creative things.

2021-2021 Membership: We will go back to normal membership signup/renewal process and dates for 2021-2022. Individuals must join/renew to be a QU member. Signups for 2021-2022 begin May 1 and if existing members have not renewed by 1 Oct, they will be dropped from QU roster.

Membership Cards: QU will eliminate hard-copy membership cards. Instead, a membership card template will be emailed to members (by each Chapter) after members join/renew. The template card will confirm receipt of their membership form and payment. Members can print the card (if desired).

QU Officer Positions: The QU Nominating Chair, Iris Salcewicz, is developing the upcoming QU officer slate for 2021-2022. The QU President and Vice President positions are open. If you are interested in fulfilling either of these positions, please contact Iris.

COMMUNITY SERVICE

I can hardly believe it's February already! This month, yet again, I donated a total of 9 quilts to Annabelle from Linus. These were split between Fairfax county foster homes and Sanctuary Food Justice Initiative. Though this month's quilts were made by our friend Ava Neff, the fabrics were donated by Shelia Teague and others. The zig zag one is incredibly creative because the strips are all made from a muted cream and greens! A marriage of traditional and modern! Just saying, I have since received four large buckets of fabric that I've loosely arranged into quilt tops that can be sewn into easy scrap tops, and I now have kits for flannel quilts too that do not require batting! Before our virtual quilt retreat I'd be happy to drop off a kit for you to complete during that weekend. Please call me at 703-346-0094.

I've been searching around for places to distribute quilts and contacted the Katherine Henley Center. Their new coordinator said there was no current need for quilts. I also spoke to Leslie Pfieffer of big QU who IS collecting pillowcases and quilts for distribution. She says," Most of the pillowcases go to Inova Fairfax Pediatric ER and Pediatric Ward. We also make quilts for them and a pediatric oncology ward called the Butterfly Unit. Another recent recipient was a group called Cool Kids which sends care packages to kids with cancer. We gave them 38 quilts and 150 pillowcases." She has offered to distribute our pillowcases and can take our quilts to Inova. I asked her to look for a contact in the NICU so that we will be able to start making NICU quilts as well.

In other community service news, if anyone is interested in donating time to making some simple animal hammocks, the Wildlife Rescue League (a 5013-c) of Northern VA has a need for people to assemble simple animal hammocks that are about 20" and 27" square). The have loops sewn into the corners (and straight quilting,) to create bed hammocks for rescued squirrels, opossums, raccoons, etc. Please see the attached pattern. Alternatively, check out this YouTube video. Contact me for supplies.

As we nearly reach our one year mark of Covid, there is still a need for our lovely quilts! Please keep sewing!

Look forward to seeing everyone's results at our March meeting.






BARGAIN BASEMENT





BONUS RECIPE (yummy!)

Carol Strong's Ribbon Cookies

1 cup butter or oleo 1 1/2 cups sugar 1 beaten egg

1 Tsp vanilla

2 1/2 cups sifted flour 1 1/2 Tsp backing powder 1/2 Tsp salt

Cream butter and sugar, add beaten egg. Add vanilla; gradually add sifted dry ingredients. Divide dough into 3 parts. To first part add 1/4 cup chopped candied cherries. To second part add 2 Tbsp poppy seed. To third part add 1/4 cup chopped nuts and 1 oz. melted milk chocolate. Line a 1 pound bread tin with waxed paper. Pack chocolate mixture into bottom, cherry mixture next, and poppy seed mixture on top. Cover with waxed paper and leave in refrigerator overnight. Turn out of pan, slice very thin and place on greased sheet. Bake at 400 degrees for about 8 minutes or until lightly browned. Watch carefully as cookies burn easily.
