VILLAGE OF JACKSON

"Your Small Town, with a Big Sense of Community"

The Village of Jackson is located just north of Milwaukee and south of West Bend, at the intersection of US Highway 45 (USH 45) and Wisconsin State Highway 60 (STH 60). Jackson is an ideal place for people to live and work. Jackson enjoys many of the conveniences of a large city, with a small-town atmosphere. We are one of the fastest growing communities in Washington County with a population estimated to be 7,187 by the Wisconsin Department of Administration as a final estimate in January 2019.

A LITTLE HISTORY ABOUT JACKSON

Jackson was named after President Andrew Jackson. Prior to 1872, Jackson was one of three small, unincorporated hamlets located in the towns of Jackson and Polk, none of which appeared to be more important than the other. Once known as Riceville (from the English misspelling of a German name) this little hamlet developed on 400 acres acquired by a German immigrant named Franz Reis.

When the railroad was built from Milwaukee to Fond du Lac, Reis offered the company a site for a depot. The railroad remained a vital force in the development of Jackson for years to come. Trains ran frequently and milk was transported to Milwaukee from the Jackson depot. Many people living in Jackson can recall commuting by train to high school classes in West Bend.

With the railroad passing through his farm and trains stopping at his front door, Reis saw an opportunity to profit from his gift. In 1873, he built a large general store, saloon, and a grain elevator. Then later, he added a second elevator and a store. The community was growing, and before long, they had two blacksmith shops, a carpenter shop, a hardware store, and (according to a county history written in 1881) "a number of neat stone dwellings." The railroad remained a vital force in the development of Jackson.

On March 14, 1912, the hamlet called Jackson was incorporated as a Village. By that time, the Village had added a cheese factory, a post office, and a hotel. In 1918, Gilbert H. Gilbert Company built a blacksmith shop. The building on Main Street is currently the home of Jackson Truck Body, a manufacturer of truck bodies.

In 1920, the Village had a resident population of 230 people. Rockfield Canning Company moved into the Village. Like its predecessors, Rockfield Canning Company chose a location adjacent to the railroad. It was later sold to Seneca Foods, then Northland Cranberries, and is currently the site of Cranberry Creek Condominiums, located behind the current Village Hall. Other early businesses included Held's Feed Mill, Jackson Lumber Yard, Pete Pauley's Race Horses, and Green Valley Dairy.

During the three decades following 1920, little development took place in the Village, with the 1930 census showing a slight decline in resident population. By 1940 the Village's population began to increase again. In 1950, the census reported a population of 361. From 1950 to 1970 the population increased slightly. Two major industries and several small businesses also came to the Village.

In 1955, the cheese factory was purchased by George Bursock Industries, Inc., which manufactured medical supplies. Later, Will Ross, Inc. purchased this plant and constructed the new Badger Laboratories Division building in 1960. Kerry Foods Inc., a large manufacturer of instant food products, became the current owner in 1986. Other industries and businesses moved into the Village, including Kettle Moraine Coatings, Inc., a plastic coating plant, Rex Cabinets, Ozaukee Pattern Company, Inc., and Sundance Photo.

In 1981, Quality Stamping built a new factory in Jackson, and in 1987 Rytec Inc. established a factory to manufacture warehouse doors. Wisconsin Pharmacal was annexed into the Village in 1985. Businesses expanded in the Village. A mobile home development of 231 homes, Green Valley Manufactured Home Community, was also established. In May of 1981 construction of a new Wastewater Treatment Plant was completed. The facilities have been updated for future growth.

Twenty years of industrial and commercial growth established the Village's strong and diversified economic base. Recent years have shown an extraordinary growth in residential and industry development, as well as population. The 1970 census recorded the Village at a population of 561. The 1975 Wisconsin Department of Administration estimated population was 1,895. In 1994 the population was listed at 3,549 residents, and 7,187 in 2019.

The industrial and commercial base of the Village contributes approximately 1/3 of the annual local tax revenues needed to provide the services of the Village, with the residential base providing the remaining local revenues.

MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT

The Village of Jackson has a Village President, chairperson of a seven-person Board of Trustees. There is also a full-time Village Administrator, Clerk, Treasurer and Administrative Assistant at the Village Hall.

The Village Hall addition to the Police Department building was dedicated in 2001. Business hours are Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., except holidays.

The Village of Jackson has a website: www.villageofjackson.com with many current events and information listed on the home page, links to our public works, building permits and requirements, Parks & Recreation/Jackson Area Community Center (JACC), Fire Department, Police Department, and a wealth of other interesting information about the Village.

A weekly update "the Wupdate" is compiled each Friday afternoon and emailed to the Village Board, all committee members, and other interested parties. It is also uploaded to the Village's website under "Publications".

A Village quarterly newsletter "the Jackson Quarterly" and a four-month calendar of events are mailed along with the quarterly utility bills. Copies are also available at the Department of Public Works

building, Community Center, and Village Hall and are also available on the Village's website under "Publications".

MEETING INFORMATION

Meetings are held at the Jackson Village Hall, N168 W20733 Main Street, unless otherwise specified on the agenda, and are open to the public, except those portions advertised as a "Closed Session". Agendas/Minutes are available on the Village website and agendas are posted at the Village Hall, Post Office, and at The Jackson Area Community Center.

<u>Budget & Finance Committee</u> meetings are generally held on the second Tuesday of the month preceding the regular Village Board Meeting.

<u>Budget</u> meetings are held in late September and through October and possibly November, to create the budget for the following year. Other budget meetings may be held when necessary.

<u>Village Board</u> meetings are held the second Tuesday of each month.

<u>Special Village Board</u> meetings are held when considered necessary by the Village Board.

<u>Police & Fire Commission</u> meetings are held when considered necessary.

Board of Public Works meetings are held on the last Tuesday of the month.

<u>Personnel Committee</u> meetings are held when considered necessary.

Plan Commission meetings are held on the last Thursday of the month.

<u>Joint Park & Recreation</u> meetings are generally held on the third Wednesday of the month at the Jackson Area Community Center.

VOTING

The Village has one polling place located at the Village Hall, N168 W20733 Main Street, unless otherwise posted. Election hours are 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. (Parking is behind the building.) You may vote if you are a United States citizen, are 18 years old or older, have lived in the Village of Jackson for 28 days before the election, are a registered voter in the Village or are registering to vote the day as the election. It is recommended that you register to vote before Election Day. To register to vote on-line, please visit myvote.wi.gov. If you are registering in person or mailing a voter registration form, you must provide acceptable proof of residency. Photo ID is required when voting in person on Election Day or voting by absentee prior to the election. In-person Absentee voting takes place at Village Hall two weeks prior to every election. Per State Statute, there is no voting conducted the Monday before an election. To have an absentee ballot mailed, an application for Absentee Ballot must be completed along with a copy of your Photo ID. You may also request an absentee ballot at myvote.wi.gov. JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Jackson Police Department was established in 1912, the same year as the Village's incorporation. The Village is served by 24-hour police protection.

In an emergency, DIAL 911. For all other business or to see an officer call (262) 677-4949 during regular business hours or (262) 335-4411 at any other time.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

No person shall park any vehicle on any village street between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from December 1 to April 1. Additional parking regulations are available in the Village Code: https://library.municode.com/wi/jackson/codes/code.

DOGS & CATS

JACKSON

Est. 1892

All dogs and cats over the age of five (5) months must be licensed annually. Spayed/neutered dogs are \$10.00 per dog and spayed/neutered cats are \$7.00 per cat. Unaltered dogs are \$15.00 per dog and unaltered cats \$10.00 per cat. An additional \$10.00 late fee will be added to the regular license fees for pets not licensed by April 1st. Licenses are for the duration of one year (January – December), and may be purchased at the Village Hall, by mail or by placing the rabies certificate and payment in the drop box located at the rear of the Village Hall Building at N168 W20733 Main Street. Proof of rabies vaccine showing the name of the veterinarian, vaccination manufacturer, serial number and expiration date is required before a license can be issued, per state statute. JACKSON FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Jackson Fire Department was formed in 1892. The original building was built in 1931. In 1976, the Fire Department relocated to the former Seneca Foods maintenance building at W204 N16722 Jackson Drive. The department has a complete inventory of fire fighting equipment and two (2) ambulances/rescue squads. The Department is a combination department with five (5) full-time employees (including a Fire Chief, Training Captain, and three (3) firefighter/paramedics), five (5) part-time and approximately forty paid-on-call employees.

The ambulances are Advanced level that flex up to a paramedic level 99% of the time. The Village Fire Department also protects the Towns of Jackson and Polk. For more information, call the non-emergency number, 262-677-3811 or email at aswaney@jfdwi.com. For emergencies, dial 911.

PUBLIC WORKS & WATER UTILITIES DEPARTMENTS

BURNING

Burning within the Village limits is prohibited.

The Public Works building is located at W194 N16660 Eagle Drive. The building houses the Director of Public Works/Village Engineer, Building Inspection, Water, Sewer and Utility Billing Department. The building is open from 7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. and can be contacted at 262-677-0707. There is a drop box located at the south entrance to the building for your convenience.

WATER & SEWER UTILITY

The Jackson Water Utility was constructed in 1969, eliminating the need of individual wells for each home. Some area residents have wells (remaining only for irrigation purposes,) but regular testing is required. If you have a well, contact the Village Engineer for further testing requirements. The Village owns six (6) municipal wells and two (2) water towers. Water and sewer main service is expanded as new parcels are connected to the Village as developments occur.

WATER & SEWER BILLING

Water and Sewer Utilities invoices are issued on a quarterly basis. The billing schedule is as follows:

- January, February, and March is billed April 15th and due by May 5th
- April, May, and June is billed July 15th and due August 5th
- July, August, and September is billed October 15th and due November 5th
- October, November, and December is billed January 15th and due February 5th

Payments may be mailed to Jackson Utilities, P.O. Box 637, Jackson, WI 53037. Payments may also be made in-person at the Village of Jackson Public Works Building located at N194 W16660 Eagle Drive.

The Village offers ACH (direct transfer from your bank account) for bill payments. You may also pay by credit card (additional fees are charged for credit card payments). Follow the link on the home page of the Village website.

GARBAGE & RECYCLING

Residential garbage and recycling are collected by GFL (Green for Life Environmental). Garbage collection will be as follows: Tuesdays (Main Street and north of STH 60), Wednesdays (south of Main Street and west of Jackson Drive), and Thursday (south of HWY 60 and east of Jackson Drive). The services are paid for by your tax dollars. The 96-gallon container provided must be used for your garbage. Recycling in the Village is mandatory. Place your recyclable materials into the special 96-gallon recycling container provided. Recycling is picked up every other Garbage pickup week on your regular Garbage day. BRUSH PICK UP

Brush will be picked up on scheduled Mondays. Review the monthly calendars sent with the utility bill. Calendars may also be found on the Village's website at: www.villageofjackson.com. Branches may be of any reasonable length but no larger than six (6) inches in diameter. Other yard waste must be placed in brown paper biodegradable bags. The Village also has a new yard waste site that allows Village residents to drop off yard waste (except grass clippings). Please contact the Public Works Building at 262-677-0707 for more information on how to obtain your access card. Information can also be found by clicking the Public Works link on the Village website.

SPRING CLEAN-UP

The Village hosts an annual Spring Clean-up day on the last Saturday of April allowing residents to drop off most unwanted household items. VILLAGE OF JACKSON RULES OF YARD WASTE DROP-OFF SITE

W194 N16660 EAGLE DRIVE

- 1) The yard waste drop-off site at the Public Works facility (W194 N16660 Eagle Drive) is an automated self-serve site for Village of Jackson residents only. For entrance to the site, residents must obtain an access card from the Public Works office 262-677-0707.
- Each Village residence will receive one free card. A fee will be charged for lost or extra cards. Cards can be obtained in person at the Public Works office (W194 N16660 Eagle Drive). Proof of Village residency will be required.
- 3) The yard waste drop-off site will accept yard waste in biodegradable paper bags, and brush. No grass clippings will be allowed. Residents will be allowed to pickup wood chips for their use.
- 4) The yard waste site is to reduce the amount of biodegradable paper bags located in front of single and two-family residences in the Village of Jackson. The yard waste site or curbside pickup is not for properties that contain apartments, commercial, or industrial uses.
- 5) The yard will open starting April 1st and close on December 1st.
- 6) Time of operation is from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- 7) The yard is continuously monitored.
- 8) The cards are issued to a Village resident associated with a Village of Jackson residence. If you are moving out of the Village, please return the card to the Public Works office.

BUILDING INSPECTION DEPARTMENT

BUILDING PERMITS & INSPECTIONS

The Building Inspection Department reviews building plans and issues building, plumbing, electric, HVAC and other permits for various residential, commercial, and industrial projects.

The Department also performs inspections of projects to ensure that the work complies with various State and Locally adopted codes. This also includes Zoning Codes which regulate land use. Enforcement of these codes is intended to project the health, safety and welfare of the public and preserve the aesthetic appeal of the Village.

Permit forms, guidance documents and other general information can be found on the Village website under Building Inspection & Zoning. Direct access to permit forms and guidance documents can be found under the "Permits & Forms" link.

As the property owner, you are ultimately responsible for obtaining permits and ensuring that all work is compliant. Contractors performing work on a 1 or 2 Family home must be properly licensed with the State of WI. Never assume that a contractor will obtain permits on your behalf and always ask to see the permits BEFORE work begins.

Common projects that require permits include but are not limited to: Roofing, Siding, Windows & Door replacement, Appliance installation – new or replacement including furnace, A/C, water heater, dishwasher, water softener, etc.), New Construction, Additions and Interior Alterations or Remodeling, Plumbing and Electrical alterations, Garages, Sheds, Fences, Pools, Sidewalks & Driveways (installation or replacement).

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

The Village has adopted comprehensive property maintenance regulations intended to prevent the deterioration of residential, commercial, and industrial properties in order to preserve the aesthetic character of neighborhoods, protect property values and the environment, and the health, safety and welfare of the public. Owners are solely responsible for maintaining their properties to prevent blight and maintain an attractive appearance.

Common violations include: Overgrown grass, weeds, and other vegetation, deteriorated roofing or siding, general exterior maintenance including paint, storage of abandoned, inoperable, or unlicensed vehicles, parking on lawns or other unapproved/unpaved areas, exterior storage of junk and other debris such as construction material, as well as unapproved uses of a property. Please refer to Village of Jackson Municipal Code - Section 8, Division 4 for additional information.

Property Maintenance issues are handled by the Building Inspection & Zoning Department and may be referred to the Jackson Police Department for further enforcement action including issuance of citations.

GRASS & WEED CONTROL

Property owners are responsible for maintaining the growth of grass, weeds and other vegetation upon their property. Grass and weed height may NOT EXCEED eight (8) inches. Regular maintenance of lawns, trimming of vegetation and eradication of noxious & invasive weeds is required. Please visit the WI-DNR website for more information on <u>noxious and invasive</u> species.

SIDEWALKS - CLEARING OF HAZARDS

Property owners whose lands abut a public sidewalk are required to maintain those sidewalks. This includes removal of weeds & grasses from cracks, trimming overhanging vegetation (minimum 10-foot clear height), removal of snow and ice from the full length and width of the sidewalk **within 24 hours** of a snow or ice storm, and replacing those portions of sidewalk that are cracked, displaced, or otherwise unsafe. Sidewalks, including handicap ramps, must be maintained in a clear and passable manner, free of obstructions and hazards.

Public sidewalks may not be obstructed by signs, vehicles, debris, or other items.

PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT



The Jackson Parks and Recreation Department offers activities for Tots, Youths, Teens, Adults, and Senior Citizens. A Park & Recreation Activity Guide comes out Semi-Annually (in spring and fall). The department website contains information containing the newest Activity Guide, fitness center memberships, program updates, special event information, as well as online registration.

JACKSON AREA COMMUNITY CENTER

The Jackson Area Community Center located at N165 W20330 Hickory Lane, is a 26,000 square foot multi-purpose building operated by the Jackson Parks & Recreation Department. Aside from the many program and activities for all ages and abilities, the JACC also offers a Fitness Center with memberships available to the public. The building also contains a gymnasium, dance studio, art studio, games room/lounge, gathering hall, meeting rooms and an early childhood area. Several rooms are available for rent for small gatherings up to 500 people. JACC rentals are reserved on a rolling calendar by contacting the Jackson Parks & Recreation Department. Several partner groups also utilize the Community Center including, the Boys & Girls Club, Kettlebrook Church, Washington County Aging & Disability Resource Center (ADRC), and the West Bend School District (WBSD).

PARKS

The Village of Jackson has five (5) parks throughout the Village.

<u>Hickory Lane Park</u> (N165 W20290 Hickory Lane) is a Community Park which is home to our award winning "*Splash Park*" and "*Inclusive Playground Structure*". This 14-acre park also has a pavilion & shelter with restrooms. Rentals are available by contacting the Community Center at 262-677-9665. Other activities at this park are basketball, volleyball, soccer and baseball/softball fields. A paved .6-mile walking/bike path surrounds the park.

<u>Jackson Park</u> (W204 N16901 Jackson Drive) is a 23-acre parcel of land located on N. Jackson Drive. This park has two (2) softball diamonds, playground equipment, four (4) volleyball courts, tennis courts,

soccer fields, bandstand stage and dance shelter, kitchen facilities and three (3) picnic shelters. Jackson Park also contains a "Wheel /Skate Park" for those on skateboards, bikes, etc. and a "9 Hole Disc Golf Course". Rentals are available by contacting the Community Center at 262-677-9665.

<u>Meadowview Park</u> (N166 W20900 Parkway Drive) is a 1.9-acre park located on S. Center Street and Parkway Drive. The park contains playground equipment, a play area and green space.

<u>Reis Memorial Park</u> (N169 W19989 Georgetown Drive) is a 1-acre neighborhood park located between Georgetown Drive and Ridgeway. Facilities include a playground and a playfield.

<u>Cedar Run Park</u> (N165 W19550 Hickory Lane) is a 24-acre open nature park with hiking trails, located along Cedar Creek. It is located just past the Wastewater Treatment Plant on Eagle Drive and North of Sherman Road.

**All parks are closed to the general public <u>from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.</u>, except for participants or spectators in an organized event <u>or as part of a park facility rental</u>. All parks shall be closed to said participant's ½ hour after the completion of the organized event <u>or rental</u>. Park shelters may be rented beginning the first business day after January 1st through the Jackson Parks & Recreation Department. Call 262-677-9665 for more information.

Non-perishable food items are collected at the Jackson Area Community Center for local food pantries.

LAKES

Hasmer Lake is a natural spring-fed lake located on the corner of STH 60 and CTH P. The Department of Natural Resources owns the public access on CTH P. The park area contains two floating docks for fishing and kayaking/canoeing. Please note the majority of land that surrounds the lake is privately owned. There is no trespassing onto their property.

VILLAGE-WIDE RUMMAGE SALE

The Village of Jackson holds a Village-Wide Rummage Sale on the Saturday after Mother's Day each year. It is a well-received event, with shoppers coming from all over to take advantage of the sales.

HALLOWEEN HOURS

Trick or Treat will always take place on the Sunday before the 31st of October, from 5:30 p.m. until 7:30 p.m., unless Halloween falls on a Saturday or a Sunday. Prior to Trick or Treating, the popular *"Ghoul Gala"* is held at the Community Center. Call 262-677-9665 for details.
