
Southwest Passage

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 2 We're planning to assemble at newly-renovated La Fonda, a 1922 luxury hotel located on the historic 1610 Plaza in downtown Santa Fe. Overnight at La Fonda, dinner at the best restaurant in Santa Fe. Santa Fe is easily reached from I-40 or I-25, and we can safely leave tow rigs for the week. If you're flying in, we'll pick you up at Santa Fe Airport or Albuquerque International Sunport. Jean will book rooms starting Friday night, and we urge you to arrive early to walk around the captivating Santa Fe Historic District. Secret Tip: The Bell Tower Lounge at La Fonda is the best place in Santa Fe to watch the sunset. Try a Bell Ringer Margarita!

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 6






