General Rules

Under 18s will need a parental consent form. 18s and over will need a second form of ID.

AGE

Junior - Competitors to be aged 17 or under on 1 September 2020 born on or after 1 September 2003.

Intermediate - Competitors to be aged 22 or under on 1 September 2020 born on or after 1 September 1998.

Senior - Competitors to be aged 27 or under on 1 September 2020 born on or after 1 September 1993.

OPEN/SENIOR COMPETITIONS

Both these competitions can be entered by anyone, unless a restriction is stated, however it is only the competitions classed as "senior" that will go towards the Senior Trophy.

ENTRIES

All entries should be sent by club secretaries directly to County Office. Members are allowed to move up age categories unless otherwise stated. Anybody who enters these competitions must be a fully signed up member with membership card before the closing date.

STOCKJUDGING COMPETITIONS

A member can compete in more than one stock judging competition but can only qualify in ONE of the competitions from class 3-11 & 15 and will have to choose which one you will do at Northern Area.

NORTHERN AREA ELIMINATORS

The first three placed competitors in the Northern Area Eliminators will be required to go forward to represent the County at the 2021 Northern Area Field Day to be held on Saturday 26th June 2021 virtually via Zoom.

JUDGING - THE JUDGES AND STEWARDS DECISION IS FINAL.

The President's Choice Award will be awarded to the exhibit that the President of YFYFC deems a worthy winner – the President's decision is final.

POINTS

1 point will be given for every member who enters a competition and sends in their entry.

Virtual County Rally Rules

Class 1. Northern Area's Got Talent (NA)

The team will consist of between two and six competitors, all of whom must be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Procedure

- Teams are required to record themselves performing a specific talent. This could be Musical, Singing, Instrumental, Dancing or a Comedy Sketch for example. Props are permitted in videos.
- To adhere to Government Guidelines, entries should be from the same household/support bubble. Where entries are not from the same household or bubble, social distancing must be maintained – if current Government Guidelines allow.
- Each performance should begin with an introduction – the club's name and a brief description of the talent.
- Teams are reminded that material considered to be distasteful or inappropriate may result in the loss of marks. All material to be suitable for a family audience. The use of foul language will be penalised with a deduction of marks. All music used must be a Radio Edit – i.e. suitable and passed for radio broadcast to family (pre watershed) audiences.

Video clips to be emailed into County Office no later than Wednesday 19th May 2021 at 5pm. Teams to provide a completed PRS form documenting any music used in their performance. PRS forms can be downloaded from the Competitions section of the NFYFC website. This form should be sent to NFYFC, Competitions Department with the team's entry form.

Timing

- The team will have a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 7 minutes. This time limit includes setting up and tidying up.
- Time faults will be imposed for timings above or below the time limits at a rate of 2 marks deducted per 15 seconds or part thereof.

Class 2. Cube Exhibit (NA)

Competitors to be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Competitors will be required to produce an exhibit to the theme "National Sporting Event". 5 craft items are to be judged:

Craft 1 - Floral Art (Any item using cut flowers and accessories in a suitable container)

Craft 2 – Cookery/Baking (This will be judged on appearance).

Craft 3 – Textile Handicraft (Patchwork Quilt)

Craft 4 – Recycled Handicraft (A piece of sports equipment made from recycled plastic material)

Craft 5 – Art Handicraft (Collage of photography).

The five (5) crafts need to be clearly marked 1-5 together with the heading that the craft comes under. For example, 1- Floral Art, 2 – Cookery, 3- Textile Handicraft, 4- Recycled Handicraft, 5- Art Handicraft.

Each whole Exhibit to have a MAXIMUM WIDTH of 1 metre, a MAXIMUM DEPTH of 1 metre and MAXIMUM HEIGHT of 1 metre. **Any exhibit exceeding the maximum measurements will be disqualified.** The measurement will be from the outside edges of the external walls of the exhibit. Any accessories or drapes used on the outside of the external walls of the cube will be included in the overall measurement of the exhibit. The external walls will be taken into account for the attractiveness of the exhibit marks and so should be covered to complement the overall exhibit. The exhibit must have 3 walls and be displayed straight on.

A total of 9 photos are required to be emailed into County Office no later than Wednesday 19th May 2021 at 5pm. A photo of each individual craft, 1 photo of the overall exhibit that includes the club's number and 3 further photos that clearly show the width, depth and height of the exhibit (tape measure must be included)

All items should be newly made in the 12 months up to May 2021 and must be the unaided work of the named competitor.

Classes 3, 4 and 5. Beef Stock Judging (NA)

Junior: The competitor must be 17 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Intermediate: The competitor must be 22 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Senior: The competitor must be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Procedure

- Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on a ring of 4 store cattle. Animals will be designated A, B, X & Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which will be worn during the period of competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area.
- Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes to watch videos and stills of the 4 beef cattle. After 15 minutes, each competitor will be required to submit their placings via Microsoft Forms. Each competitor will then have 24 hours to email their reasons to County Office.

Timing

Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for judging of the stock and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.

Classes 6, 7 and 8. Dairy Stock Judging (NA/NFYFC)

Junior: The competitor must be 17 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Intermediate: The competitor must be 22 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Senior: The competitor must be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Procedure

- Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on a ring of 4 dairy cattle. Animals will be designated A, B, X & Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which will be worn during the period of competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area.
- Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes to watch videos and stills of the 4 dairy cattle. After 15 minutes, each competitor will be required to submit their placings via Microsoft Forms. Each competitor will then have 24 hours to email their reasons to County Office.

Timing

Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for judging of the stock and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.

- Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on a ring of 4 breeding sheep. Animals will be designated A, B, X & Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which will be worn during the period of competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate

directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area.

- Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes to watch videos and stills of the 4 breeding sheep. After 15 minutes, each competitor will be required to submit their placings via Microsoft Forms. Each competitor will then have 24 hours to email their reasons to County Office.

A video of the outfit being worn, and photos of the outfit are required to be emailed into County Office no later than Wednesday 19th May 2021 at 5pm. A photo of the template the outfit was made from is also required. The photos should also include the club's number.

- Male: To make a hand tied bouquet of flowers for the winner of a National Sporting Event. To be viewed from all angles. Maximum space allowed: 50cm wide x 50cm deep x unlimited height.
- Female: To make a hand tied bouquet of flowers for the winner of a National Sporting Event. To be judged from the front. Maximum space allowed: 75cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height.

- Pre-cut and pre-soaked oasis are allowed. No pre-cut flowers allowed. All the work of the arranging and assembling of materials must be carried out during the competition. Competitors must wear white coats.

Competitors will be required to send in 4 photos – one of the overall arrangement that includes the club’s number and 3 further photos that clearly show the width, depth and height of the exhibit (tape measure must be included).

All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which will be worn during the period of competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area.
- Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes to watch videos and stills of the 4 mystery items. After 15 minutes, each competitor will be required to submit their placings via Microsoft Forms. Each competitor will then have 24 hours to email their reasons to County Office.

A team of 6 members to include at least 1 member of each sex. All competitors must be 27 years or under on 1st September 2020.

Competitors will be judged on the time taken to drink 6 pints. Pint 1 = Lemonade, Pint 2 = Strawberry Milkshake, Pint 3 = Cold Custard, Pint 4 = Cold Gravy, Pint 5 = Cold Black Tea, Pint 6 = Cold Tomato Soup

Spillages will be taken into account.

To adhere to Government Guidelines, entries should be from the same household/support bubble. Where entries are not from the same household or bubble, social distancing must be maintained – if current Government Guidelines allow

Competitors are required to send in a video of them drinking the 6 pints to County Office via email no later than Wednesday 19th May 2021 at 5pm. At the start of the video, please state your name and the club you are representing.

Class 19. Team Eating Competition (NA)

A team of 3 consisting of one competitor 17 years of age or under on the 1st September 2020, one competitor 22 years of age or under on the 1st September 2020 and one competitor 27 years of age or under on the 1st September 2020.

Competitors will be provided with a plate of food of which they are to eat in the quickest time. Each competitor will be required to eat a small tin of cold baked beans (200g), 5 Ryvita Original Crispbreads, 1 tin of mackerel in tomato sauce (125g)

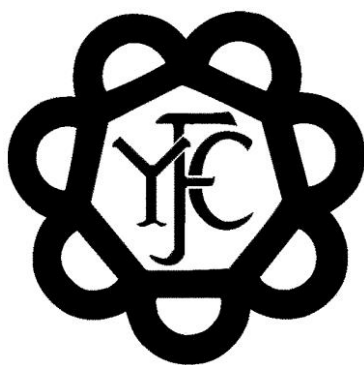
