8:30-10:15

Incoming Kindergarten Art with Mrs. Slater and Mrs. Renn

Incoming kindergarteners come and enjoy the fun becoming familiar with your new school, while creating beautiful works of art. Spend a week using different mediums of art. You will create projects that your parents will cherish forever.

Cooking with Mrs. Gripp grades 1-5

Let's get ready to use our "hands" for cooking this week. We will make some of our old favorites like pickles, salsa, meatballs, and rolled cookies, and try some new recipes to eat and take home. Come hungry and with an apron.




