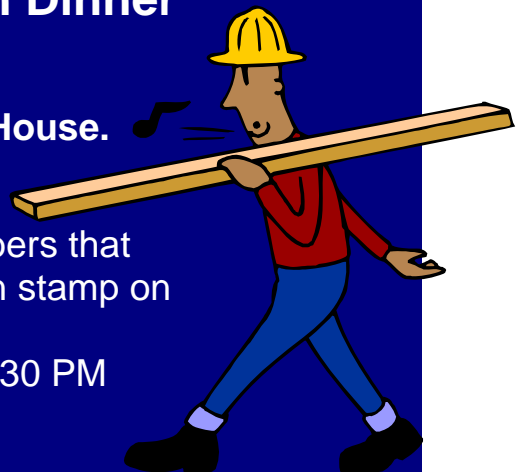

## General Membership Meeting Minutes – November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2011

MLCA President Russ DeVriendt called the meeting to order at 8:12pm. Russ led the members in the Pledge of Allegiance and the Conservation Pledge. **Chris Peltier/Keith Erdman:** Motion to approve the minutes as printed in the Multi-Laker. **Motion Carried Unanimously.**  
**Matt Philippart/ Mick McCanham:** Motion to approve the Treasurers report as printed in the Multi-Laker. **Motion Carried Unanimously.**

### **CHAPLINS REPORT (by Russ)**

**Dick Newton's sister** passed away today, no other information at this time. Keep them in your prayers.

### **PRESIDENTS REPORT**

Russ welcomed everyone and went right to the business at hand. **Mick McCanham/ Sam Lindsay:** Motion to approve the new 15 member Nominating Committee as appointed. (At least 12 required by By-laws) 95 for 1 against. **Motion Carried.**

**Dave Fisher** apologized to the spouses and guest for the delay; however, resolving the current election process (problem(s)) is paramount. We should consider what is best for the organization and fair to all. Several pro and con discussions followed. **Motion Carried. 50 for, 21 against.**
