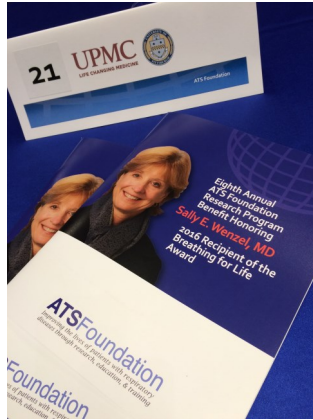

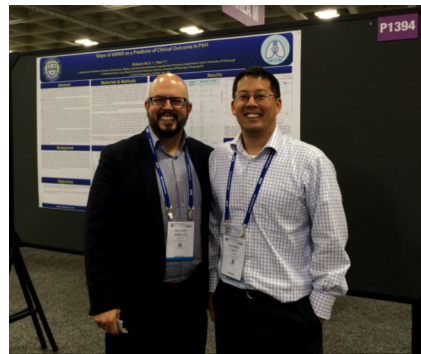

Be sure to mark your calendars for next year: **May 19-24, 2017 in Washington, DC.**



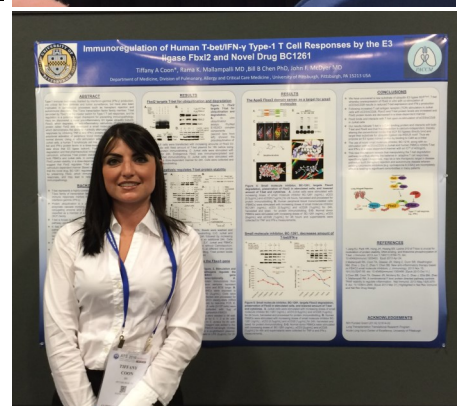

Pitt and UPMC Launch new center on Microbiomes

Dr. Alison Morris:

"We expect our Center for Medicine and the Microbiome to usher in a new era of care, with what we learn leading to therapies for diseases and conditions ranging from obesity to cancer"

On May 13th, the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy in Washington, DC launched the National Microbiome Initiative (NMI).

The NMI, funded by both Federal agencies and private-sector stakeholders, aims to support research to answer fundamental questions about microbiomes, which in turn will help to protect and maintain microbiome function in our health and environment.

Dr. Alison Morris, UPMC Chair for Translational Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine, attended the White House event to announce a collaboration be-

tween the University of Pittsburgh Schools of the Health Sciences and UPMC.

The newly organized Center for Medicine and the Microbiome has several areas of focus, including the creation of a biorepository of clinical samples and engaging the community at large in the upcoming Pittsburgh Biome Project.

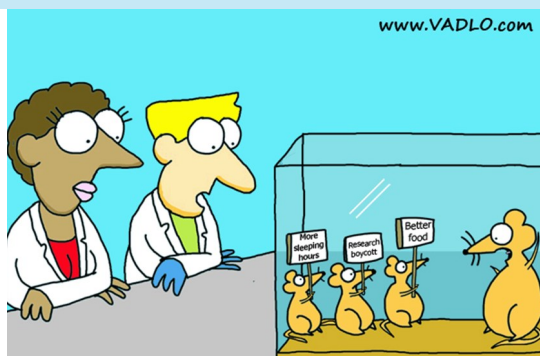
IM Associate Program Director
