

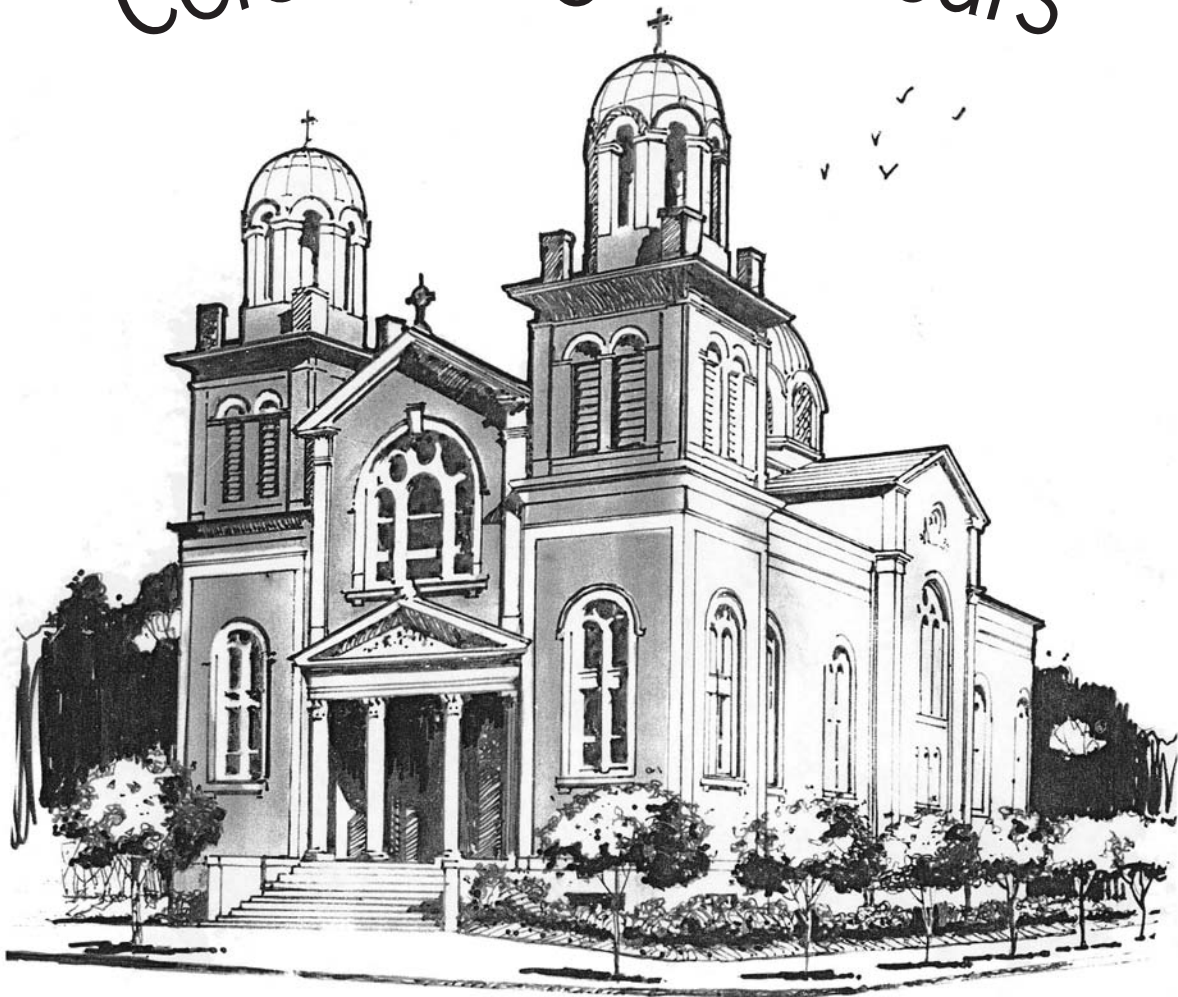

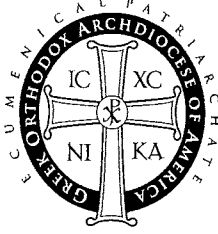

philanthropic projects, preserve and promote participation in the activities of the Greek Orthodox Community.

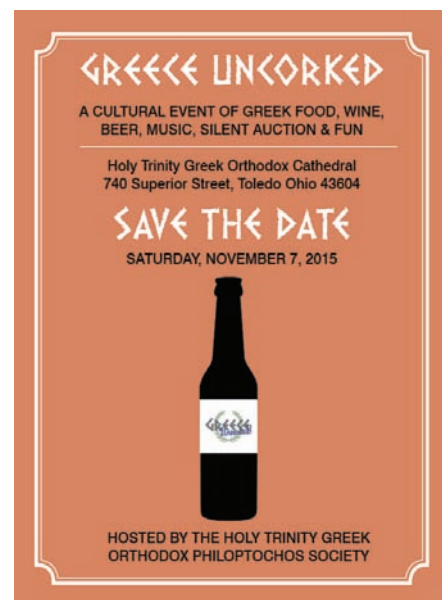

On August 9th, 25 members went to Sauder's Mill and Museum, lunched, and enjoyed a beautiful day of fun and fellowship.

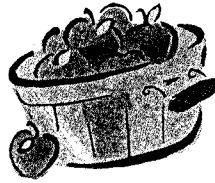

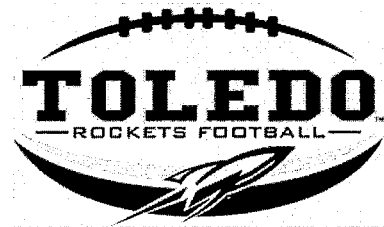

This is the final update letter from your Mortgage Campaign Committee and we are pleased to share with you the results of our mortgage campaign. We met our goal to retire the Community Center mortgage in honor

of our parish's 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary and "burned the mortgage" as we celebrated that event June 27, 2015.

During the 18 month campaign, we received over \$445,000 in gifts - which was more than enough to pay off our mortgage. The gifts we received that were not used to pay off the mortgage (approximately \$20,000) were transferred to the Capital Improvement Fund and will be used exclusively for maintenance and repair of our Cathedral and Community Center.

We will recognize those who provided a gift to the mortgage campaign by publishing a list of donors in our 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Album which will be published next year. We humbly thank those of you who have responded to the needs of our Parish.

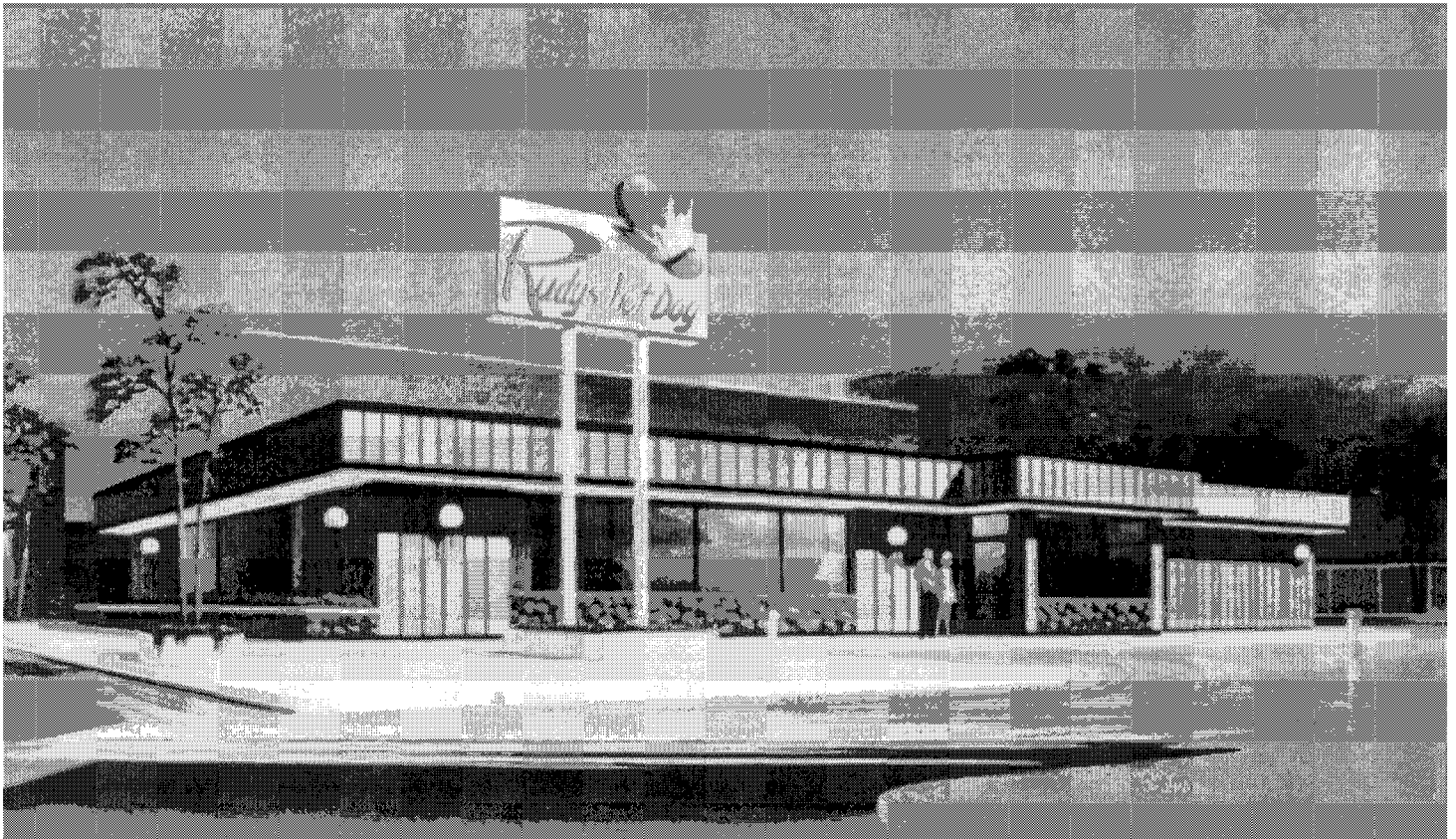
