#### ST ANNES OLD LINKS

Is justly proud of its 6941 yard Par 72 Championship links course and welcomes the opportunity to share it with golfers from around the world. Founded in 1901, St Annes Old Links is one of the fine championship links of England's north west coast and hosted the Local Final Qualifying for The Open in July 2012 held at nearby Royal Lytham & St Annes.

Other forthcoming major events include the Boys' Home Internationals in early August 2017, the UK Seniors Golf Association North West Championship at the end of August 2017 and last but not least - we are proud to be selected by the R&A to host Final Open Qualifying July 2018 and for the following 3 years until 2021.

The signature 9th hole was voted by Golf World in the May 2010 issue as the Top 9th Hole in Great Britain and Ireland. The great Bobby Jones is quoted as saying "it's difficult to see how you could improve on this". Enough said!


#### **ROYAL LYTHAM & ST ANNES**

Royal Lytham & St Annes Golf Club was founded in 1886 and the present Course constructed in 1897. The Clubhouse celebrated its Centenary in 1998. It is one of the premier links courses in the world, host to eleven Open Championships, two Ryder Cups and numerous other major tournaments including the Women's and Seniors Open Championships and the Walker Cup in 2015. Northern hospitality has always been famous and Royal Lytham leads the way.

The layout of Royal Lytham & St Annes has remained faithful to the original created by the Club's first Professional, George Lowe, over a century ago. The only significant changes were made in 1919 when the club asked Harry Colt, the pre-eminent Course Designer of the time to make recommendations for improvement.

Over the next four years he repositioned some of the Greens and Tees added numerous bunkers and lengthened the course.

It is not a conventionally beautiful golf course, surrounded as it is by suburban housing and flanked by a railway line, but it has a charm all of its own. It is a Links Course that is a long way from the sea yet close enough for the sea breeze to have an effect on one's game and was aptly described by Bernard Darwin, the leading golf writer of the thirties, as 'a beast of a Course, but a just beast'. He went on to say that 'no one could fail to be impressed by its difficulties, which sets a golfer just about as ruthless as an examination as any Course of my acquaintance'.

An evening of jewellery making at The Beaderie in Cambridge will give us the chance to see the colleges and bridges over the river Cam by twilight.


#### **60 Million Trebles Challenge**



# Member Reviews

The Buzzcocks

York 6th October

After some interesting pre-gig chat we were running a bit late, so I'm afraid I have no information on whoever was supporting the band. In fact, it was only after about five minutes that they ambled onto stage and cracked on with Boredom (I have a recording of one of their early gigs where Pete Shelley sneers to some unfortunate spectator "If you'd shut up, you'd hear that this next song is about you ...").

Apparently a previous gig by Chelsea was very poorly attended, but there were no issues with that – it may not have been completely sold out but if it hadn't reached legal capacity it was pretty full.

The band ran through almost all of their best-known songs (except, unfortunately, What Do I Get? which is one of my favourites). They always had a bit of pop sensibility to go with the usual punk ethos of play fast, play loud but I'm not sure that the sound system did them any favours. It wasn't terrible, but Steve Diggle (who did most of the lead vocals) seemed to be mixed down a bit low, as was the bass.

I have written before about the need to have a sensible mix between too much banter and none at all – it must be said that the Buzzcocks erred very much on the side of hardly anything at all by way of chat. So they finished at half ten with a show that was probably a six out of then – I've seen them better but still good value.

#### Sex P\*\*\*ed Dolls, Brudenell Social Club Hyde Park 8<sup>th</sup> October

I have had to asterisk some of the name of this allgirl band, but if you can't work it out, it is a bad pun of the Sex Pistols name. They essential play cover versions of some of punk's anthemic songs, although they do also play some of their own, which sounded fine but everyone had come to listen to their covers.

I know, I know, it sounds awful and I generally avoid cover bands but I had been told by people that have seen them before that they are fantastically entertaining and well worth seeing. Also, it was in what is generally reckoned to be Leeds's best small music venue. Attached to, er, a social club in the middle of student land, it is perfectly set up for smaller gigs (with maybe about 400 capacity), and seemed to be nearly full. The support act was a local band, Apollo Junction, who were actually fantastic. They were wandering around the audience at the start of the evening handing out flyers and were saying that they've recently been given some airtime on Radio 2 and I can see why. Energetic but melodic songs, very capable playing, and a charismatic lead singer. Leeds has always punched below its weight in terms of bands but perhaps these lads might buck the trend.

The main attraction was indeed great fun. A few snarled words to the crowd and it was one three minute classic after another – "Pretty Vacant" "Should I Stay Or Should I Go?" "Teenage Kicks" "Alternative Ulster," you name it. But they refused to play "White Riot" because somebody requested it. "We're not DJs," Dolly Rotten retorted. True punk girls. And great fun.

## BOOKING TERMS AND CONDITIONS HASSRA TRIPS AND EVENTS

The following terms and conditions will apply to all events to ensure that every member has a fair opportunity to participate in events. The terms and conditions should be read in conjunction with the relevant booking form.

- 1. Wherever possible events will be advertised with a closing date for applications that is at least 4 weeks from the date first advertised, including proposed events where expressions of interest are being requested.
- 2. Persons wishing to travel together should complete one application form per room, submit their applications together, and determine a lead person who will be responsible for forwarding payments due and act as the contact on behalf of the group via a signed disclaimer agreeing to these terms and conditions.
- 3. A booking will not be accepted or entered in a draw without the correct deposit and signed disclaimer.
- 4. Once the closing date is reached, the number of applicants wishing to travel will be determined. Where there are sufficient places for all applicants, then deposit cheques will be banked and places confirmed.
- 5. Members should be aware that once deposit cheques have been banked they are not returnable and travellers will be liable to pay full price of the trip (unless the place is subsequently filled). Full price means the un discounted "non-member" price. Where necessary, HASSRA (Leeds) will provide an invoice for the full price for insurance purposes but travellers need to be aware that the cost of insurance, (if purchased), is non-refundable.
- 6. Travel operators will be asked to date insurance cover from the date on which they receive notification of the persons travelling. It is therefore essential to obtain adequate travel insurance before booking if you do not purchase the insurance offered.
- 7. Single supplements. There will be no member discount on supplements for travellers wishing to secure a single room. Where members indicate on the application form that they are willing to share a room with someone of the same sex, the organiser will arrange for pairing. If an individual has indicated that they are willing to share, they will not have to pay a single supplement even if no pair is available.
- 8. Where the number of applicants exceeds the places available, a random draw of application forms will determine those successful in receiving a place, subject to Clause 8. Cheques accompanying these applications will then be processed. Remaining applications will continue to be drawn at random to determine the order of the reserve list.
- 9. The trip organiser will be granted up to two places on that trip without entry into the ballot. An organiser is the person who arranges the trip on behalf of the HASSRA Events Committee, whether or not s/he is a member of the Committee.
- 10. Where expressions of interest have been sought for a proposed trip, if that trip is subsequently confirmed, applications received from those expressing interest prior to the closing date will be given priority to book before any unfilled places on the trip are advertised. On these occasions, once the closing date is reached, remaining places will be filled on a first come first served basis.
- 11. Members who have been unsuccessful in a ballot for a trip may record this on their application for the next trip, to the same destination, and will be given priority for available spaces.
- 12. Applications from solely non-member groups, i.e. not accompanying a full HASSRA member, wishing to participate in an event will be considered only in the event of places remaining after the closing date has passed.
- 13. The priority order will be: a) Organiser +1, b) Previously unsuccessful on similar trip (ballot if necessary), c) Prior registered interest (ballot if necessary), d) Other Members, e) Non Member groups.
- 14. Non-members may apply to travel at the discounted rate on an event provided that they satisfy the criterion for associate membership and send a completed application for membership together with the appropriate payment, on or before the closing date for the trip. Associate Membership will last for 12 months from the date of processing the application. The Committee reserves the right to determine specific criteria for prior membership on certain trips. Any such requirements will be notified in the advertisement. Participants are reminded to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner while attending HASSRA sponsored trips and events. Formal complaints may prejudice an individual's eligibility for future trips.
