



Ålesund, Norway

Ålesund's architecture is known far and wide. Turrets, spires, and other whimsical art nouveau architectural touches give the town its distinctive, fairy-tale-like character. The scenic spectacle of the Geiranger Fjord, one of Norway's best-known attractions, is just a stone's throw from this quaint little town.

Alta, Norway

The city of Alta is a welcome oasis set amid lush, tree-covered hills and valleys in the otherwise harsh and desolate Finnmark landscape. Its favorable climate, friendly inhabitants, and pleasant surroundings are just some of the reasons visitors have been attracted to this community at the head of the Alta Fjord year after year.

Above this line, about 66°N latitude, the summer sun remains above the horizon for at least one 24-hour period, offering a true opportunity to see a "midnight sun." And what a scene it will illuminate — massive fjords encrusted with glacial ice, dramatically sculpted icebergs, and water of the deepest blue.

Belfast, Northern Ireland

This vibrant, fast-moving city includes a fabulous dining scene, an active arts movement, and wonderful sightseeing and shopping — all on a walkable scale. Belfast is also known for its many Victorian and Edwardian buildings, complete with elaborate sculptures and stone-carved heads of gods, poets, scientists, kings, and queens. **SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE:** Belfast – Past, Present & Future, Giant's Causeway, Leisurely Belfast & Panoramic Highlights

Bergen, Norway

Once the seat of medieval Norway, Bergen is a former Viking stronghold girded by deep fjords, towering mountains, and sweeping glaciers. Visit Bryggen Wharf, where you can strike a bargain in one of the many artisans' workshops, or visit the famous Fish Market, climb Mount Fløien, or take in a Troldhaugen concert.

Berlin (Warnemünde), Germany

For so many years a city divided, Berlin is now united, not merely bringing together East and West, but cultures and languages from throughout the world. We'll access this excitingly eclectic city from Warnemünde, a charming old fishing town located at the mouth of the Warnow River.

Copenhagen, Denmark

Whether strolling through a sea of blooming flowers in Tivoli Gardens, witnessing the changing of the guard at Amalienborg Palace, or touring Kronborg Castle — the setting of Shakespeare's Hamlet — it's easy to see why this once-humble fishing village grew to become the capital of Denmark.


Cork, Ireland

Dublin, Ireland

With Dublin Bay to the east and the Dublin Mountains to the south, the capital of Ireland has clearly left quite an impression on the surrounding lands. As you explore the medieval streets around Dublin Castle and duck in for a tasty pint served up at Keating's Pub, you're certain to enjoy many great conversations sprinkled with the famous Irish wit.

Edinburgh (S. Queensferry), **Scotland**

If ever there were a town made for walking, it would be Scotland's capital. Renowned as one of Europe's most attractive cities, Edinburgh's Old Town and New Town are a marvelous mixture of elegant streets, charming squares, and quaint alleyways. Of course, the city's most distinctive landmark is Edinburgh Castle, set high up on a craggy cliff in the center of the city.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Braveheart Country & Stirling Castle, City of Edinburgh & Castle, Da Vinci Trail — Rosslyn Chapel & Edinburgh

Flåm, Norway

The diminutive yet breathtakingly beautiful town of Flåm is nestled deep in a tributary of the world's longest and deepest fjord. Surrounded by steep mountainsides, roaring waterfalls, and deep valleys, visitors here experience a one-of-a-kind encounter with nature.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Overland to Myrdal, Geilo & Flåm, Tiny Undredal Valley Village, Kayaking in Flåm

Gdañsk (Gdynia), Poland

This medieval city's prime location along the Baltic Sea has made it one of the leading ports in central Europe. In Gdañsk, you'll find 1,000-year-old monuments and buildings that have been resurrected from near-ruin and returned to their original splendor. One section of town that never needs reviving, however, is the vibrant and bustling Long Market, the center of historic Gdañsk.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Malbork Castle, Gdañsk & Oliwa Cathedral, Leisurely Gdañsk

Harwich, England

Wander along the narrow streets of this city and you'll get a feel for its seafaring history. Not only was it once the headquarters of the King's Navy, it was also the home of Christopher Jones, who piloted the Mayflower on its voyage to Plymouth. If you're interested in maritime history, visit either the Harwich Maritime Museum or the Harwich Lifeboat Museum.

Helsinki, Finland

Occupying a peninsula and several islands, this capital city's stunning melding of old and new structures rings some of the most spectacular bays you could ever hope to find. Stroll down broad, tree-lined streets, or take in the amazing neoclassically designed architecture in Senate Square.

Honningsvåg, Norway

Located deep within the Land of the Midnight Sun, Honningsvåg is the northernmost town in Europe. And with more than 1,000 cruise ships calling during the summer season, it is also the largest and busiest cruise port in Northern Europe. Be on the lookout for free-roaming reindeer grazing on the tundra on the outskirts of town.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: North Cape Transfer, Bird Safari, Deep Sea Rafting

Inverness/Loch Ness, Scotland

This charming, historic seaport on the banks of the River Ness has many quiet pleasures to offer. Take a delightful walking tour along the riverbanks and explore the local galleries, cafés, and the famous Floral Hall. You'll also want to visit Cawdor Castle, of Macbeth fame. Loch Ness is the largest body of fresh water in Britain — over 22 miles long, a mile and a half wide, and 750 feet deep. It is also the purported home of "Nessie," the Loch Ness Monster.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Cawdor Castle & Culloden, Highland Castles & Loch Ness, Leisurely Scotland

Kirkwall, Scotland

The largest town in, and the capital of, the Orkney Islands, Kirkwall is the center of Orkney in more ways than one. Almost all roads linking the east and west pass through town; it is also the port that provides inter-island ferry links to almost all the northern isles. In addition, it is considered one of the most charming and well-preserved small towns in Scotland, rich in scenic beauty, history, and medieval architecture.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Leisurely North Coastal Drive, Orkney Crafts, Viking Capital Walking Trail

Klaipėda, Lithuania

On the Baltic Sea and the Curonian Lagoon, Klaipėda is Lithuania's third-largest city and the capital of West Lithuania. Stroll past the brightly colored buildings on Market Street and visit the Lithuanian Sea Museum and Aquarium, housed in a 19th-century military fortress.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Best of Neringa, Village Life in Lithuania, Klaipèda Old Town with Beer Tasting, Fairy Tales, Legends of Witches Hill & Amber

Molde, Norway

Acknowledged as one of Norway's major rose-growing centers, it's no surprise that Molde is often referred to as the "city of roses." Warmed by the Gulf Stream and protected by its surrounding hills, Molde is the beneficiary of a moderate climate, which contributes to its lush vegetation. This charming city is also home to the Ramsdal Museum, featuring one of Norway's most impressive collections of folk art.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Atlantic Ocean Road & Fishing Village, Molde City & Folk Museum, Hiking Mt. Varden

Olden, Norway

Much of this picturesque town, located at the tip of the Nordfjord, looks as though it is straight out of the 17th century. Its many historic sites include Olden Old Church, built in 1759 on the site of the original stave church dating back to the 14th century, and the Singer Home, former residence of the famous American painter William Singer.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Briksdal Glacier, Fjaerland & the Norwegian Glacier Center, Cruise on Lake Olden, Kjenndalen Glacier

Oslo, Norway

Sail across the Oslo Fjord and you sail back in time to 1050 A.D. This capital city's lavish history can be uncovered at the Viking Ship Museum and the Kon-Tiki Museum, which serves as home to the Fram, a famous polarexploration ship. Cross the drawbridge to the formerly impenetrable Akershus Castle and meander through the famous Vigeland Sculpture Park before returning to the present day.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Hiking in the Nordmarka Forest, Hadeland Glassworks & Viking Ships, Scenic Oslo by Coach

Paris (Le Havre), France

All that you've heard is true. Paris is simply one of the most beautiful cities in the world. See the Louvre Museum, take a romantic stroll along the Champs Élysées, linger over café au lait, or visit Notre Dame. The gleaming city of Paris is, without question, truly "The City of Light."

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Paris on Your Own, The Louvre & Da Vinci Code, The Beaches of Normandy

Rīga, Latvia

Caught in the middle of hostilities between Germany and the Soviet Union during World War II, Rīga has prospered in more recent times and is now a thriving, cosmopolitan capital that hasn't lost its Old World feel. Visit the city's Central Market, located in abandoned blimp hangers built by the Germans, a profusion of local meats, cheeses, and produce can be found.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Rīga City Tour, Panoramic Rīga, Turaida & Sigulda

St. Peter Port, Channel Islands, UK

Lying just off the north coast of France (the southernmost point in the British Isles), the island of Guernsey is warmed by the temperate waters of the Gulf Stream. St. Peter Port, the island's capital, is a lively harbor town with a rich history, medieval architecture, and stunning natural beauty. It is also the site of the famous Hauteville House, where exiled author Victor Hugo completed Les Misérables.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Guernsey Island Drive, Guernsey Island Cycle, Guernsey Military Occupation

St. Petersburg, Russia

Although reportedly built to resemble such western cities as London, Paris, and Vienna, one look at St. Petersburg's regal palaces and vast public squares is enough to tell you that it is truly in a class of its own. If you're fortunate enough to be in St. Petersburg in June, revel in the city's famous "white nights," when the boundless night sky is never completely dark.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Grand St. Petersburg with Hermitage, St. Petersburg Cathedrals, Suburbs of St. Petersburg: Pushkin & Peterhof

Stockholm, Sweden

No fewer than 50 bridges connect this Swedish capital's 14 islands to its mainland undoubtedly so Swedes can enjoy every inch of this magnificent city. Visit the many parks, museums, and palaces — most famous, the 600-room Royal Palace. Make your way through Gamla Stan, or Old Town, packed with historic buildings, shops, and cafés.

Tallinn, Estonia

Tallinn has remained remarkably unchanged since its founding in 1154 A.D. The preservation of this city's Old World charm enables visitors to enjoy architectural marvels of centuries past, such as the soaring towers of Toompea Castle and the exquisite Russian Orthodox Cathedral. The exception is the delightfully modern pink Parliament building, visible from Palace Square.

SHORE EXCURSIONS INCLUDE: Countryside Cycling & Old Town Walking, Tallinn Walking Tour, Panoramic Tallinn

Tromsø, Norway

Located on an island in northern Norway and surrounded by spectacular fjords, mountains, and a jagged coastline, Tromsø has been called the "Paris of the North." This lively city is home to the world's northernmost university, planetarium, cable car, and brewery. Its most famous landmark, however, is its Arctic Cathedral, whose design is evocative of the region's snow and icebergs.

Many of the coastal fortifications from that era still exist, although instead of guarding the city they provide splendid views of the harbor.
