## GAME 3

The Winnipeg Jets meet the Calgary Flames Tuesday afternoon in the pivotal Game 3 of their best-of-five Stanley Cup Qualifier Series...The Jets defeated the Flames 3-2 in Game 2 on Monday afternoon to even the series at a win apiece...Game 4 of the series is slated for Thursday, with the time not yet determined.

**Recap:** Nikolaj Ehlers deflected a puck past Cam Talbot on the power play in the third period to give the Jets a 3-2 Game 2 win...Adam Lowry had goal and an assist for the Jets, while Jack Roslovic also had two points with a pair of assists...Connor Hellebuyck earned the win with 28 saves.

## EVEN IT UP

The Jets evened a series for the first time when losing Game 1 with Monday's win...As a franchise, the Jets are now 2-5 all-time in Game 2s...Winnipeg's only other Game 2 win was a 4-1 win against the Minnesota Wild in Game 2 of their best-of-seven First Round Stanley Cup Playoff Series in 2018.

## HOME TURF

The Jets are the home team in the series for Game 3 and 4...The Jets are 5-11 all-time as the home team in the playoffs, having dropped their past five home playoff contests and losing four of the games by one goal...The Jets went 20-14-3 as the home team during the regular season, which was tied for 11th best in the NHL.

## NO SWEEP FOR YOU

After being swept in the first two playoff series in franchise history, Monday's win guaranteed the Jets won't be swept for a third time in this series...Winnipeg's past four playoff series have gone past the series minimum...The Jets Game 7 win against the Nashville Predators in the second round of the 2018 Stanley Cup Playoffs is the only series in franchise history that has gone the distance.

## QUICK TURNAROUND

The Jets were 4-5-0 when playing their second game in as many nights during the regular season...The Jets swept two back-to-back sets during the regular season (Nov. 1 at SJS 3-2 W and Nov. 2 at VGK 4-3 OTW; Feb. 8 vs. OTT 5-2 W and Feb. 9 vs. CHI 5-2 W).

## BACK IN THE DANCE

The Jets are back in the Stanley Cup Playoffs for the third consecutive season...It's the first time in franchise history that the Jets have reached the playoffs in three consecutive seasons and fifth time overall.

## ROAD TEAM

The Jets don't have home ice in a series for the second time in their five playoff series during the past three seasons...The Jets defeated the Nashville Predators in seven games in their second round playoff series in 2018... In that series, the road team won five of the seven games in that series... The road team has won six of Winnipeg's past eight playoff games...Both of Winnipeg's wins in last season's first round series against the St. Louis Blues came on the road...During the regular season, the Jets were 17-14-3 on the road, including winning eight of their first 11 games away from Bell MTS Place.

## ANOTHER NEW PLAYOFF FOE

This is the seventh playoff series in franchise history and the seventh time the Jets face a different opponent...The then-Atlanta Thrashers played the New York Rangers in 2006...The Jets made the playoffs for the first time after relocation in 2015 and met the Anaheim Ducks in the first round...During its run to the 2018 Western Conference Final, Winnipeg played the Minnesota Wild, Nashville Predators and Vegas Golden Knights...Last season the Jets faced the St. Louis Blues in the first round.

## MARCHING TO VICTORY

The Jets ended the regular season by winning all four of their games in March...Winnipeg outscored their opponents 15-5 in the quartet of contests... Kyle Connor (5G, 1A), Nikolaj Ehlers (2G, 4A), and Blake Wheeler (1G, 5A) each had six points in the four games... The Jets won three games in a row on four other occasions...Winnipeg earned points in a season-high five games twice - Nov. 1-10 and Feb. 1-9...The Jets were supposed to put their four-game winning streak on the line against Calgary when the regular season ended abruptly.

## HERITAGE CLASSIC

The Jets defeated the Flames 2-1 in overtime at the 2019 Tim Hortons Heritage Classic in Regina in October...It was the only meeting between the two clubs in the regular season, as the other two meetings were supposed to occur after the NHL paused the regular season due to the COVID-19 pandemic...Josh Morrissey forced overtime by scoring with 4:11 remaining in the third period on the power play, while Bryan Little netted the overtime-winner 3:04 into the extra session...Winnipeg outshot Calgary 45-30 in the contest.

## ALBERTA CONTENT

Jets defenceman Josh Morrissey was born and raised in Calgary, while forward Adam Lowry grew up in Calgary after being born in St. Louis...Morrissey played minor hockey for the Calgary Royals, while Lowry played for the Calgary Bisons...Forward Mark Letestu hails from Elk River.

## FANNING THE FLAMES

The Jets have won their past two regular season games against the Flames...Winnipeg's last four wins against Calgary have come by a 2-1 score...The Jets are 4-4-0 against the Flames in the past eight regular season meetings and the losing side has been limited to one goal or less in six of the eight contests.

## AGAINST CALGARY

Blake Wheeler leads the Jets in career scoring against the Flames with 19 points (7G, 19A) in 21 games...Three of Mark Letestu's five goals against Calgary are shorthanded goals.

## NEUTRAL SITE

The Jets are 2-2-0 all-time in neutral site games...Two of the games were outdoors - 2016 Heritage Classic vs. Edmonton (3-0 L) and 2019 Heritage Classic (2-1 OTW)...The other two games took place in Finland at Hartwell Arena against the Florida Panthers during the 2018-2019 regular season.

## ATLANTA ROOTS

The Jets and Flames franchise both originated in Atlanta...Calgary played as the Atlanta Flames from 1972-79, while the Jets were the Atlanta Thrashers from 2000-2011...Neither franchise won a playoff series while being based in Atlanta.

## FEARLESS LEADER

Jets head coach Paul Maurice is coaching in the postseason for the eighth time in his career...Maurice is 37-45 behind the bench in playoff games, with the highlight of his postseason success coming in 2002 when he coached the Carolina Hurricanes to the Stanley Cup final...The nine playoff wins the Jets posted in 2018 is the second most Maurice has had in a playoff run, next to the 2002 season.

## CLUTCH KC

Kyle Connor scored at 6:02 of the first overtime period in Game 4 of last season's first round series against the St. Louis Blues...It's the only playoff overtime winner in franchise history...Cody Eakin is the only other player on the Jets roster that has scored an overtime goal in the playoffs, doing so May 5/16 at STL when he was a member of the Dallas Stars.

## VEZINA FINALIST

Goaltender Connor Hellebuyck is one of three finalists for the Vezina Trophy, which is awarded to the NHL goaltender that is adjudged to be the best at his position... Hellebuyck led all NHL goaltenders in games (t-58), shots faced (1,796), saves (1,656), and shutouts (6)...The Commerce, Michigan native ranked second overall in starts (56), wins (31), and minutes (3,268:33)... Hellebuyck recorded 31 of the 37 Jets wins (83.8%), the second-highest percentage among goaltenders on the 24 teams set to resume play...Hellebuyck faced 37-or-more shots on 13 occasions and posted a 10-1-2 record, 2.08 goals-against average, and a .949 save percentage in those contests...He is the only member of the Jets that is the finalist for any of the NHL's year-end awards, though captain Blake Wheeler has been announced as one of the 31 nominees for the King Clancy Memorial Trophy.

## LEADING LOWRY

Adam Lowry had an goal and an assist on Monday to increase his playoff point total to three (1G, 2A)...He has been in on all three of Winnipeg's even strength goals during the first two games of the series...Lowry had three points - all assists - in his final 18 games of the regular season.

## FIRST TALLY

Jansen Harkins opened the scoring on Monday to register his first career playoff goal in his NHL playoff debut...He joins Adam Lowry (Apr. 16/15 at ANA) and Patrik Laine (Apr. 11/18 vs. MIN) as Jets that have accomplished that feat...It took Harkins 15 games during the regular season to notch his first career NHL goal during his rookie campaign.

# Winnipeg Jets: Head Coach and Player Bios

## Head Coach: Paul Maurice

Paul Maurice, 52, is in his seventh season as head coach of the Winnipeg Jets after being appointed to the position on January 12, 2014. Under Maurice, the Jets have gone 272-190-54, for a .579 points percentage. He has the most wins by a head coach in franchise history. Maurice became the second-youngest NHL coach to earn 500 wins after a 8-2 victory over Florida on January 13, 2015. He became the youngest head coach to reach 1,500 games on February 5, 2019 in a 3-2 overtime loss to the San Jose Sharks. Maurice won his 700th game October 20, 2019 vs. Edmonton (1-0 SOW).

Maurice, who coached in his 1,500th NHL game on February 5, 2019, has earned a career NHL coaching record of 731-646-221 in 22 seasons with the Carolina Hurricanes/Hartford Whalers, Toronto Maple Leafs and Jets. He won his 600th career NHL game when the Jets defeated the Minnesota Wild on Oct. 20, 2017. On Nov. 28, 2010, he became the 19th coach, and the youngest in history, to coach 1,000 NHL games.

### Head Coach: Geoff Ward

On November 29, 2019, Geoff Ward was named the Flames Interim Head Coach for the remainder of the 2019-20 season. Ward was originally hired by the Flames as an associate coach on May 31, 2018 after previously being an assistant coach with the New Jersey Devils.

Ward began his coaching career as an assistant coach at the U. of Waterloo from 1989-91. He then moved onto junior hockey, first as an assistant coach with the Niagara Falls Thunder (1991-92) of the OHL, then head coach of the Waterloo Siskins (1992-93), the Kitchener Rangers (1993-98) and Guelph Storm (1998-99). He made the jump to the AHL in 2001-02 as both an assistant coach and head coach of the Hamilton Bulldogs until 2002-03 then moved with the Oilers AHL affiliate to Toronto in 2003-04. Ward first entered the NHL in 2007 as an assistant coach with the Boston Bruins.

Ward also has three coaching stints in Germany, winning the DEL Championship in 2015. He was also an assistant for the German National Team from 2015-2018.
