

Jim Johnson explained the Construction to Perm Loan. It's a one- time close loan. When construction is complete, the loan will seamlessly roll into a permanent mortgage for the remaining term. This is a fully amortizing loan. Construction to Perm Loans have a term construction phase period based on the size of the loan for a period of 12-24-month period during which interest only on drawn amounts is charged to the borrower. This loan allows a borrower to pay interest for the 12-24 month only on the amount drawn. The draw schedule general parallels the construction stages, and inspections are completed prior to each draw to document completion of work and to verify that the draw request is consistent with the current progress. Upon completion of the home, the loan converts to the permanent loan.

Borrowers are qualified on the full P&I payment. The maximum loan amount is \$2,000,000. No subordinate financing is allowed. Co-borrowers must occupy home. Minimum credit score is 720. The first interest only payment will be due on the first of the month. If a draw is taken within the first 10 days of the month, the interest only payment will be due on the first of the following month. If the draw is taken after the first 10 days, the interest only payment will be due on the 1st of the second month. If the total cost of the construction is less than anticipated, the remaining amount will be applied to the principal and the number of payments will be reduced. The P& I payment amount remains unchanged. If the borrower meets loan servicing recast guidelines, them may request it at the completion of construction and when it transitions to a permanent phase. The loan is considered full documentation. Construction must not be started until after closing. No sweat equity is allowed.

Notable changes have been made. A 2-unit primary residence has been added as an eligible property type. The maximum lot size is 10 acres. Current housing payment may be excluded under certain circumstances. There is an enhanced builder approval process. A rehab option is available. Increases construction and interest only terms are based on loan size. Contingency reserves have been eliminated.

This locks in the rate for the homeowner through processing, building, and the mortgage. Four draws are allowed. Ten percent down or a lot ownership is required.
