Re-Opening Wrightsville

The title above is a little misleading. Wrightsville UMC has not closed during this pandemic. Our church has been extremely active in worship, study, and service. As you know, all those things have looked different than normal; but we have not ceased, for even one minute, being the church. I am very proud of the way our members and staff adapted so quickly to the challenges placed upon us by COVID-19. Thank you for being so flexible in these unprecedented times.

Nevertheless, we are all eager to get back in the building again, especially to worship together in our sacred space with our sisters and brothers in Christ. Our staff and Administrative Council are busy making plans that will facilitate our ability to gather together without compromising the health and safety of the people who worship and work here. We have been carefully looking at the Governor's Three Phase plans for re-opening North Carolina, Bishop Hope Morgan Ward's guidelines for re-opening United Methodist Churches, data from New Hanover County and the state of North Carolina, as well as recommendations from members of our church who work in the medical field.

Our hope is to begin in-person public worship again in mid-July with one option being services outside by the stage at the Wrightsville Beach Park. People will need to bring their own lawn chairs to sit in and masks to wear. Obviously, we will need to maintain proper etiquette when it comes to social distancing. Parking is free for up to two hours and the bathrooms will be open to the public. We will also be using a FM transmitter for those who would like to come; but remain in their cars. This would be one service on Sunday morning and the time has still not been determined. Online worship will continue to be made available every week.

Meanwhile, Sundays at Six will take a similar approach with outdoor worship. That service is exploring two options: one would be at the park overlooking the water on South Channel Drive and the other is in the parking lot underneath the fellowship hall.

Adult small groups would be allowed to meet in person in the building once the state's Phase 3 begins; however, those meetings will be restricted to the Fellowship Hall where we have the most room to spread out. Youth and children's gatherings would take place outside for the time being.

There are several reasons why we are taking a very cautious approach to reuniting in person.

- 1) While the rate of infection is starting to decline nationwide it has not subsided in North Carolina or New Hanover County. As I write this, the six zip codes where the majority of our church members live have actually seen a larger number of cases in the last few weeks than we did in the first weeks of the pandemic. Some of that is probably due to more available testing; but it is too early to say that the virus is actually declining in our area.

- 2) Our sanctuary and fellowship hall were designed to seat a lot of people in relatively small spaces. Additionally, we have very narrow hallways, narrow entrances, and small bathrooms. Not only is it difficult to remain six feet apart from other people; but there are so many places and items where a person could unknowingly leave germs behind that another person could touch a few minutes later.
- 3) We could leave it up to each person or family to decide for themselves; but we worship a God who tells us time and time again to care for the most vulnerable members of our community. Even though many individuals will choose to continue virtual worship, we want to make reasonable accommodations to include as many people as possible. Being outside has been shown to be safer than being in a confined space, so we're going to try that first.

John Wesley's first rule for the people called Methodists was "Do no harm." And Jesus himself taught us to "Love your neighbor as yourself." We all want to worship together, every single one of us does, even those who are planning not to join in-person worship until a vaccine is invented. But, we also want to have some assurance that our congregating will not put others in harm's way. These are tricky times. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we strive together to best love the Lord our God and love our neighbors as ourselves. I look forward to continuing to worship with you online and to seeing you in person when we gather in July.

May the Peace of Christ be with you.

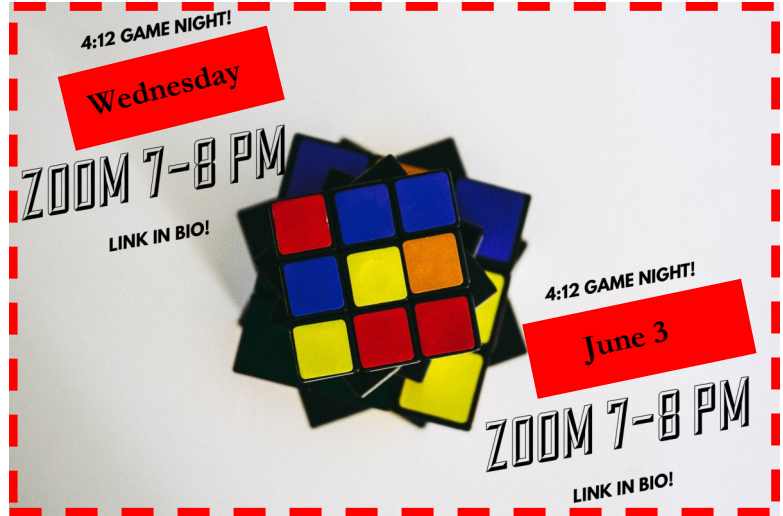


