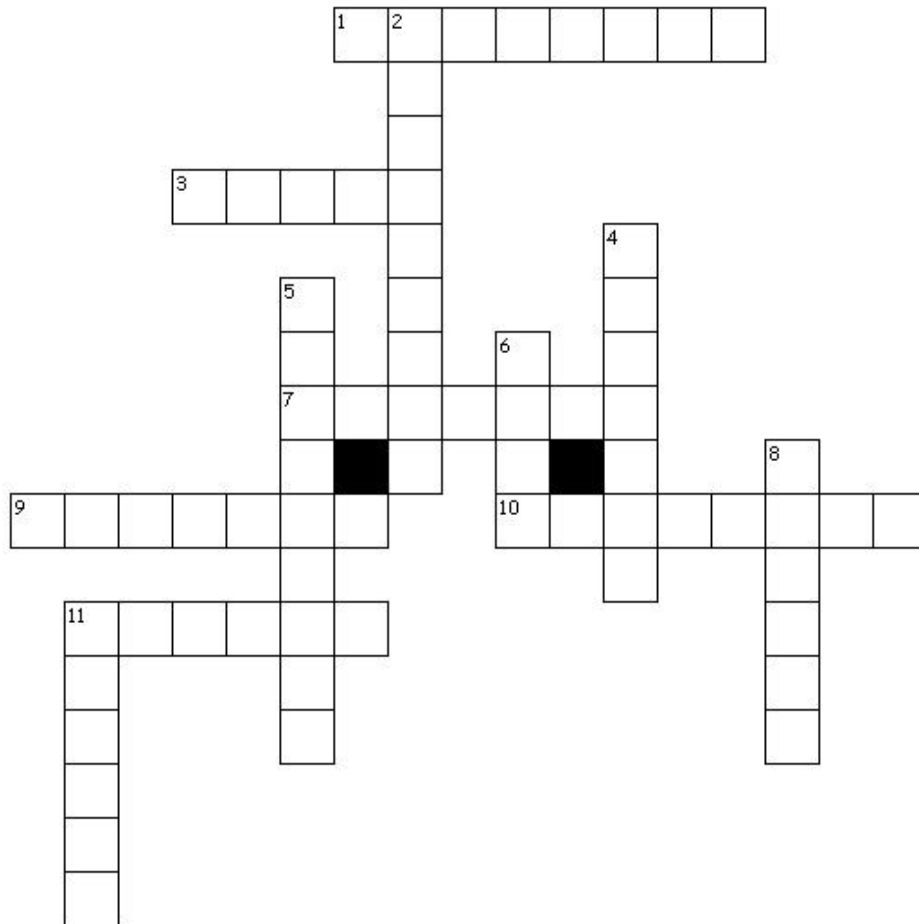

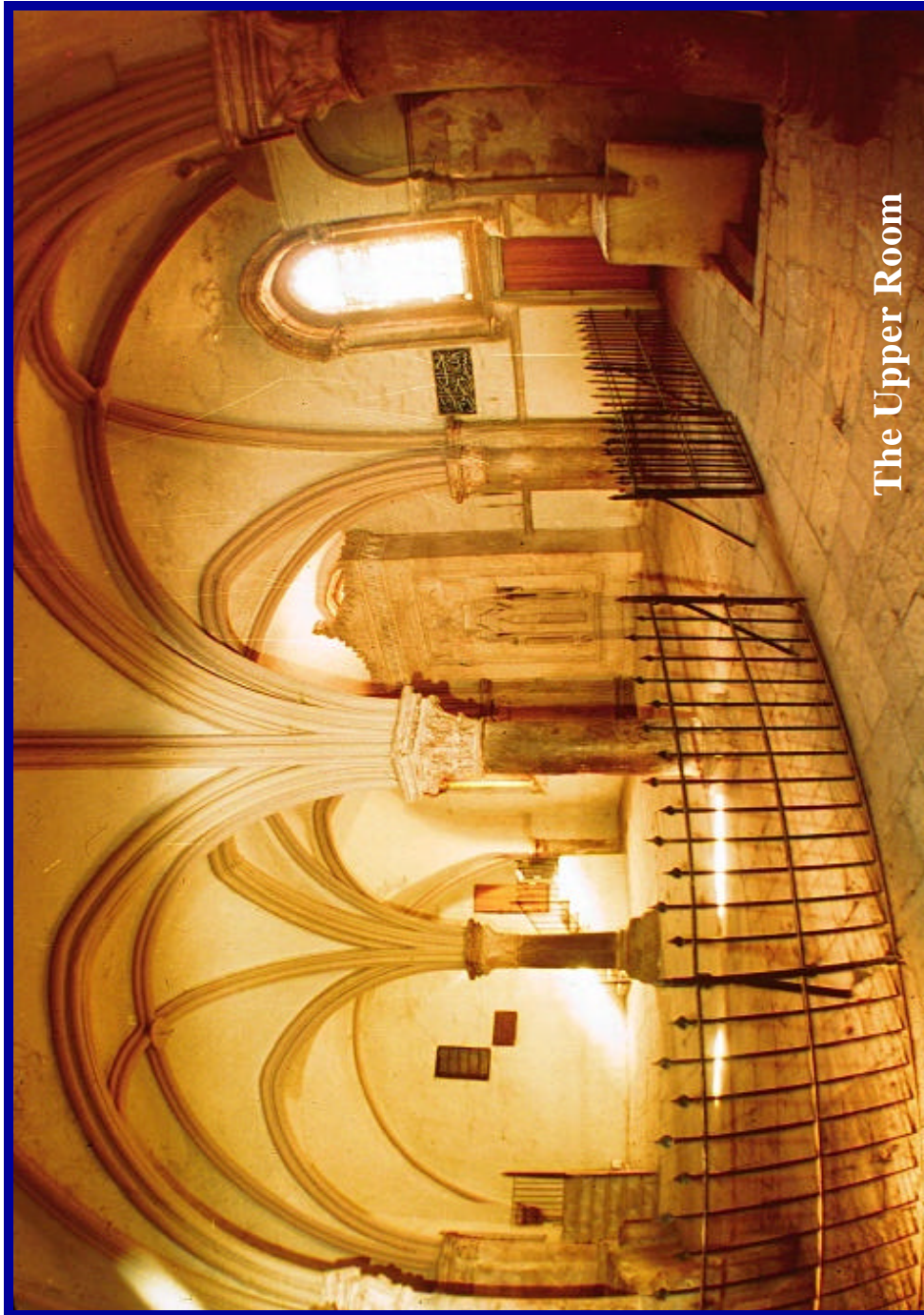

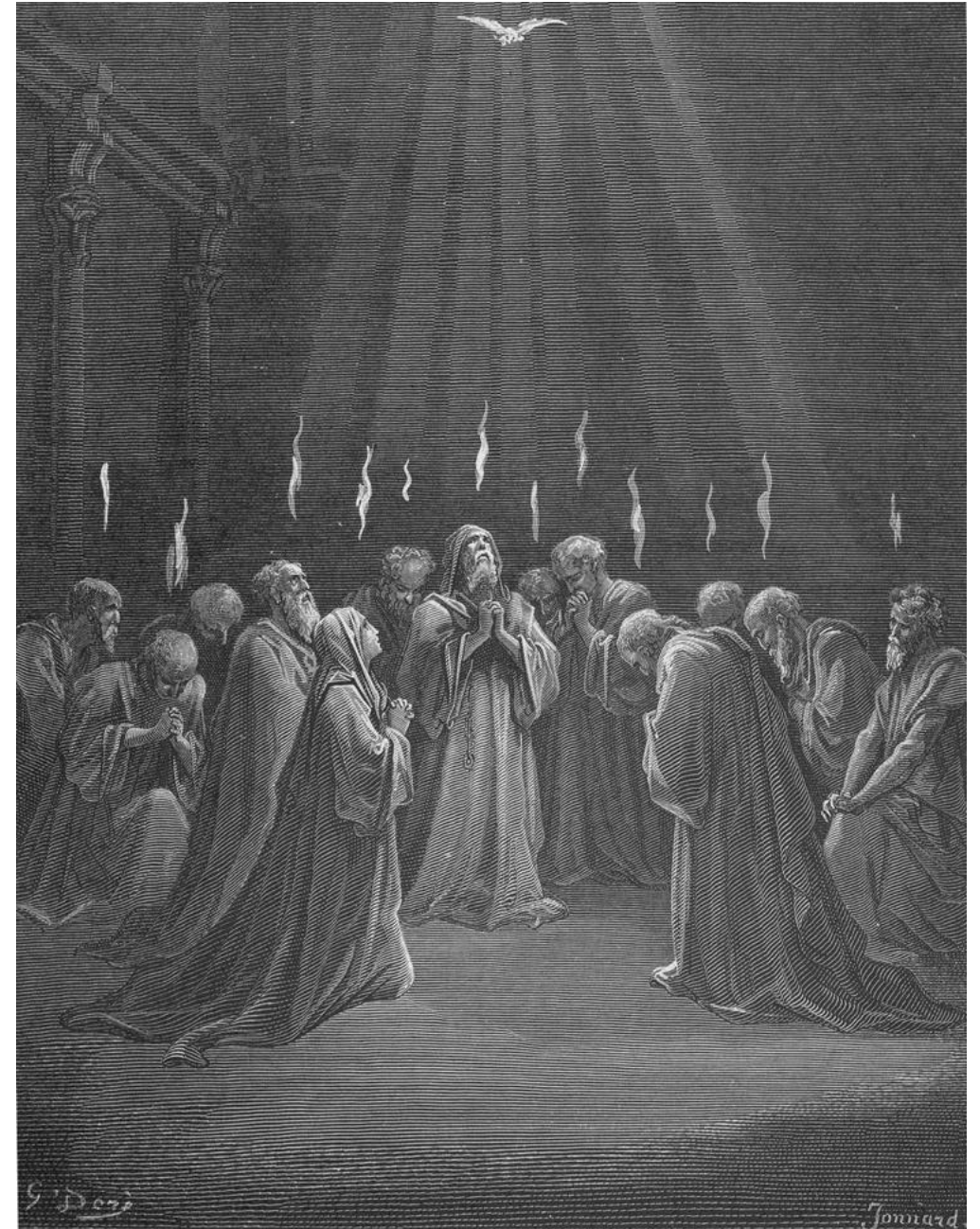

Holy Spirit Baptism

Pentecost was the only time in Acts when the Holy Spirit came in the form and of a wind-like sound and a fire-like appearance. These signs signify the presence of God.

The apostles were given an abundant portion of the Spirit to prepare them for all that God had in store for them as they served Him. They would be the people Jesus had prepared to be the first church, to preach God's Word of repentance for our sins, and to point to Jesus as our Savior and our Lord.

Luke 24:49 **And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.**

The apostles had to tarry for power. There was preparation to be made, like cleansing from sin, and forgiveness, and for everyone to be of one mind and one accord, before the Holy Spirit fell on them with the power enable them to start their task.

The Jews had gathered and heard the Galileans speaking in other languages, they wouldn't know. How could this be? Some were saying that they had to much wine. Peter spoke and said that they were not drunk.

16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel;
17 And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:
Joel 2:28 18 And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy: Joel 2:29

Peter said, Know that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. Repent and be baptized, then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 3000 were baptized that day and shared in teachings by the apostles, fellowshiping with each other, breaking bread together, and praying together.
