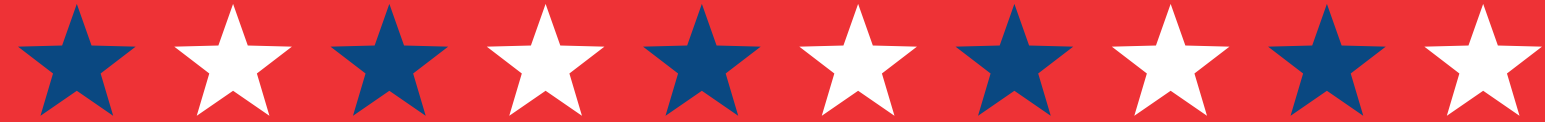

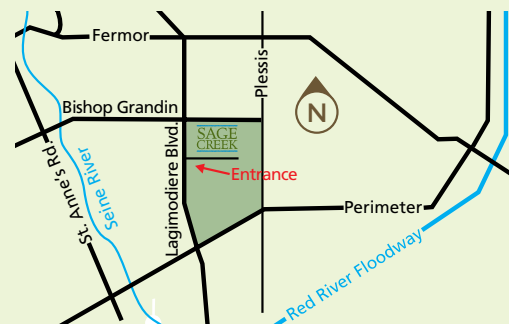

Spring and a new softball season are just around the corner. Hard to believe! The Southdale Softball program is recognized as one of the top community club based softball programs in Winnipeg. The program provides the opportunity for girls ages 5 – 18 years old to play softball at competitive and recreational levels.

There were 17 teams registered with Southdale in 2013. We finished the Bonivial playoffs with U10B (Mite), U10C (Mite) and U18C (Midget) winning gold medals, U14B (Pee Wee) and U18BB (Midget) with silver and U14C (Pee Wee) winning bronze. Ten teams went on to compete at Provincials. Congratulations to the U10B (Mite) and U10C (Mite)

who both captured gold and the U14C (Pee Wee) and U18C (Midget) teams who both won bronze. 2013 was another successful season for Southdale softball.

A special thanks to all the players for their enthusiasm throughout the season and giving us all the opportunity to cheer them on.

Thank you to all the coaches, team managers and parents who volunteered their time and expertise. Volunteers are key to the success of any program. When registering your child for softball this season, please consider volunteering to assist the program in some way.

Winter skills development sessions have been set up for some age levels and will run until mid March. Also check the Softball Manitoba website for additional clinics for both players and coaches.

Evaluations will be conducted for most ages to determine placement at the B or C level and to balance team skill levels where there are multiple teams. Evaluation sessions will take place in late March and early April. To be considered for a B level team you must attend the evaluation.

I assumed the role of Southdale Softball Convener in the spring of 2010. This will be my fifth and final season as Softball Convener. With that being said, I would be interested in co-convening with someone this season so they can learn the ropes and take over as Convener in 2015. Please contact me for more information.

MINI SOCCER 2014

Southdale Mini Soccer is available for children aged 3-8 in the 2014 calendar year. The season will run for 8 weeks from May 4-June 26. Registration from March 1 to 28.

Schedule and fees are as follows:

- U3** (Born 2011) Sundays 4:00-4:45pm \$30
- U4** (Born 2010) Sundays 3:00-3:45pm \$30
- U5** (Born 2009) Mondays and Wednesdays 6:00-7:00pm \$50
- U6** (Born 2008) Tuesdays and Thursdays 6:00-7:00pm \$50
- U7** (Born 2007) Tuesdays and Thursdays 7:00-8:00pm \$75
- U8** (Born 2006) Mondays and Wednesdays 7:00-8:00pm \$75

All games will be played on local fields within Southdale and Island Lakes. The season also includes the 6th Annual Soccer Extravaganza which will take place on Saturday, June 21-Sunday, June 22 at De La Seigneurie Park. All U5-U8 teams will participate.

U7 and U8 age groups will be gender specific with male and female teams. U3-U6 teams will be co-ed. Friend requests will be considered but not guaranteed. There is a maximum of one friend request per player and it must be reciprocated.

Southdale continues to support the Long Term Development Program (LTPD) as outlined by the Manitoba Soccer Association (MSA.) The U5-U8 teams will continue to be smaller than average, with fewer players on the field at a time (allowing more touches on the ball.) Due to the overwhelming number of participants in our program, this creates a demand for numerous coaches.

There is no previous experience necessary and a coaching guide with drill references will be provided. Anyone interested in attending coaching clinics with MSA (www.manitobasoccer.ca/coaching.clinics) will be reimbursed for course expenses. Please indicate if someone in your family is able to coach, as well as their name and email, as part of the registration process. No one will be expected to coach by themselves.

U3 and U4 age groups will be slightly different this year and focus on general activity rather than on sport-specific training. The dynamic will change from a practice/game format to a fun layout that incorporates exercise and learning how the body works. There will still be soccer equipment provided that introduces the sport informally. Numerous coaches/leaders will be required for these age groups as well. A family member will be expected to be involved to work/play with the child.

All registrations received in the registration period will be accepted. Registrations received after the deadline will be



accepted based on availability and be subject to Southdale's late fee policy - no exceptions.

If you have any questions about the mini soccer program, please email. There will be age convenors assigned to each grouping of ages (U3/4; U5/6 and U7/8) that will organize each group and be the point of contact. Thank you to those that have offered assistance.

OUTDOOR SOCCER 2014

Outdoor soccer is offered to players ages 9-18 (born in 1996-2005). Children who are 9-12 in age will play in a Bonivital league. The older ages play in city-wide league which is organized by Winnipeg Youth Soccer Association. Registration is from March 1st to March 12th.

The regular season starts at the beginning of May and continues until the end of June. Playoffs will start in September and finish with the championships at the end of that month. Teams usually play 1-2 games per a week. The games will either start at 6:00 or 7:15 pm. The times will vary throughout the season. The U9, U11, U13, U15 and U17 teams will generally play their games on Tuesdays, Thursdays and/or Sundays. The U10, U12, U14, U16 and U18 teams will generally play on Mondays, Wednesdays and/or Fridays. The practice schedule will be decided by individual coaches. There is no formal practice schedule and location.

There are times when Southdale has too many or not enough players to fulfill a team. If this should happen, Southdale will either pick up some players from other community clubs or the Southdale players will be transferred to play with another club. This will be determined once the registration process has been completed.

Last year, Southdale had over 90 coaches. Special thanks to all the volunteers who offered their time, energy and patience. We continue to need your support to keep the program growing in our community. If you are willing to assist this current season in any capacity, please leave your contact information on the registration form. If you haven't coached before, there are numerous coach's clinics offered before the start of the season. The clinics are free of charge. Please check the Manitoba Soccer Association website for more information.

Registration fees have not been determined as of yet. Please check the Southdale website for the exact fees which will be posted closer to registration:

BASKETBALL 2014

Registration - March 1 to 12th. Are you looking for an activity that combines fun, physical activity and teamwork? If so, our Southdale basketball program may be just what you are looking for!!

- Basketball is a sport that can be enjoyed for a lifetime and we have found that once people give it a try they are often hooked on the sport.
- Basketball is one of the most popular sports in schools and by participating at the community club level you develop the skills to help you succeed within the school setting.
- The equipment and participation costs for basketball are very affordable compared to many other sports.
- Cheering on your child as they participate with their teammates in a climate controlled gymnasium is a wonderful experience to share with friends and family.

With all these benefits it is not surprising that basketball is the fastest growing youth team sport in Canada (with more participants than soccer and hockey in the 12-17 age range). Why not come out and give it a try for yourself (and bring along some friends)?

The Southdale basketball program is part of the Winnipeg Minor Basketball Association (WMBA) and is open to all boys and girls ages 7-18 for the Spring season. With the WMBA fair/equal play policy, all children are given an equal opportunity to learn, play and develop. Jerseys are provided to the players for their use during the season and the only equipment required is non-marking sneakers, blue shorts

(without pockets) and a non-spilling water bottle (knee pads and mouth guards are optional but recommended).

Southdale teams are entered into the WMBA Community Club League and play against teams from other community centres across the city. Games are played once per week (Saturdays for children 7-12 and Sundays for children 13+).

Some weekends require double header games to be scheduled to make up for missed games due to long weekends and other schedule conflicts. Teams typically practice once per week in a school gym located in our community. Practice times and days will be determined after teams have been formed.

The Spring season runs from April to June with registration through the Southdale website starting March 1. The Spring season consists of 8 regular season games and two playoff games.

The game schedule is published at the beginning of the season to help everyone plan their schedules accordingly. The cost to participate in the Spring season is \$130 plus Laker fee.

Parents are encouraged to volunteer as coaches on their child's team. Coaches are always needed and without a coach a team will not be able to play. Coaching takes very little time (the role can be shared with other parents) and is extremely rewarding. Please indicate your willingness to coach when you register for the program so the children will have a chance to play.



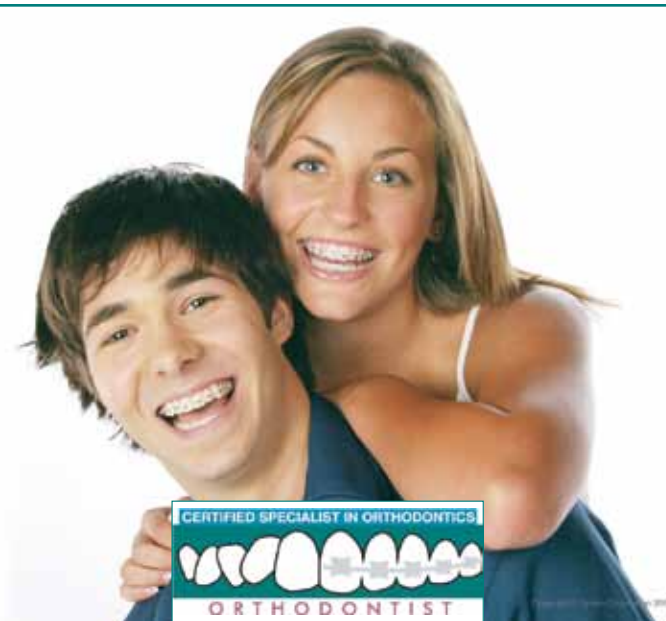
