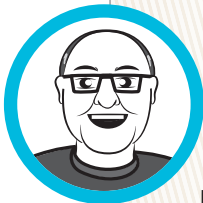

■ Mad About “Manifest”! Waiting For “Outlander”!

Can you please tell me what happened to *Manifest* and why it was canceled? Also, when is *Outlander* Season 6 coming? – Diane

Just hours before options for the stars of “Manifest” were due, NBC canceled the series. Reportedly the series was sold to NBC with a six-season story arc. Fans have taken to social media to lobby for another network or streamer like Netflix to bring it back. “I am devastated by NBC’s decision to cancel us,” creator Jeff Rake said on Twitter. “That we’ve been shut down in the middle is a gut punch to say the least. Hoping to find a new home. You the fans deserve an ending to your

story. Thanks for the love shown to me, cast and crew.” We think it’s optimistic the series will find a new home. As for “Outlander,” you’re going to need to wait until early 2022 to see the eight-episode Season 6. Showrunner Matthew B. Roberts said: “We are excited to get into the editing room to work on bringing the fans one step closer to reuniting with the family back on Fraser’s Ridge. Filming in 2021 has presented an unprecedented set of challenges, which led us to the decision to truncate the season in order to bring the fans the most vibrant and dynamic season as soon as possible. We will then film an extended Season 7 with 16 episodes next year as life returns to normalcy.”

■ Stop Censoring TV-MA Movies

I wish TV-MA ratings would be taken seriously from the networks when it comes to movies played on TV. If it is meant for “mature” audiences, it should be aired as such. Every time a movie airs on a network like FX or FXM with an MA rating, the viewer is warned of such content: Strong Language, Graphic Violence, Sexual Content and Nudity. The announcer even says, “Viewer discretion is advised,” meaning that the film about to be played may be offensive to the eyes and ears of some people. Yet this is not how TV-MA movies are aired. Scenes are cut, language is muted along with nudity (even butt shots). Take *Atomic Blonde*: I watched it with a TV-14 and a TV-MA rating. No difference from one another. That is on FX and FXM. Mature adults should be able to watch TV-MA rated films full length, uncut and uncensored. Otherwise, what is the point of an MA rating? – Ryan

FOLLOW THE MONEY

IT'S A STEAL!

Pulling off a multimillion-dollar robbery from a high-security stash is a frequent Hollywood plot, but CNBC is looking back at history's most notorious, real-life, *Ocean's 11*-style heists in the six-episode, true-crime series *Super Heists* (Mondays beginning Aug. 9). The stories of some of the biggest, most brazen burglaries are told from the perspectives of the perpetrators and the law-enforcement sleuths who nabbed them. Among the *Super Heists* capers are:

United California Bank Heist (1972) Thieves plotted to steal millions from a California bank vault rumored to contain a slush fund for President Richard Nixon.

Carnegie Library Caper (1992-2017) An archivist stole \$8 million worth of rare books, maps and manuscripts from Pittsburgh's Carnegie Library over 25 years.

Loomis Fargo Bank Robbery (1997) The theft of more than \$17 million from an armored-car company's vault in Charlotte, North Carolina, inspired the 2016 comedy film *Masterminds*.

Banco Central Burglary (2005) Thieves tunneled into the vault at Banco Central in Fortaleza, Brazil, and stole nearly four tons of uninsured cash.

Picasso Pinch (2011) New Jersey man Mark Lugo walked into a San Francisco art gallery and walked out with a drawing by Pablo Picasso worth \$200,000. — *Ryan A. Berenz*

"Mr. Wonderful" Wields The Gavel Of Financial Fairness. By Ryan A. Berenz

Entrepreneur, investor and *Shark Tank*'s "Mr. Wonderful" Kevin O'Leary is the Judge Wapner of Business in CNBC's six-episode *Money Court* (Wednesdays beginning Aug. 11). O'Leary, aided by trial attorney Katie Phang and former Judge Ada Pozo, resolves business disputes involving high stakes and often high emotions. There's real money on the line, and the opposing parties have agreed to be bound by O'Leary's decisions. *Money Court* gives litigants the chance to sidestep the backlogged court system, settle their differences and get back to making money. "Getting to resolution can be gut-wrenching and emotional, but absolutely necessary," O'Leary says. "It makes for incredible television, and the outcomes are most often a complete surprise. I think America is going to be very engaged!"

5 Questions

With **GAIL SIMMONS** Of
Bravo's "Top Chef Amateurs" By Holly Friedel

After 18 seasons of *Top Chef*, 24 longtime superfans are competing head-to-head with assistance from fan-favorite *Top Chef* alums in Bravo's *Top Chef Amateurs* (airing Thursdays). Host and judge Gail Simmons revealed the emotions behind this particular season, her favorite dishes and some fun facts about herself when she answered our "5 Questions."

1 We read you burst into tears while shooting. Could you tell us about the emotional side of this experience?

Most of those times were joyful. It wasn't bursting into tears because I was angry or sad. There's a sadness to this year, and I think the crew was kind of getting teary-eyed on a number of occasions because the stories of these amateurs were so powerful.

2 If you were to pick three of your favorite dishes, what would they be?

If I could choose, regardless of how ridiculous they are, sea urchin pasta with chilies. Sort of a Sicilian classic. Or even just clam pasta, like pasta vongole. Butterscotch pudding is my ultimate comfort dessert. Also, corn grilled lightly on the cob and just a giant watermelon in peak summer. I don't really need anything else.

3 Can you tell us about a time you were starstruck?

I've been starstruck a lot. Part of the journey of *Top Chef* has been seeing how many people it resonates with, and we've been lucky enough to be nominated for an Emmy I think 14 years of the 15. Every year at the Emmys there's always a moment where someone comes up to talk to me about food. Peter Dinklage was a moment I remember. Both Sterling K. Brown and Regina King at different times the same year walked past me at the Emmys and said, "Anytime I see you, it makes me hungry." They were like, "When I see you, I just associate you with food and it makes me want to eat something."

4 What were your three favorite shows as a kid?

Some of my favorite shows were *The Facts of Life*, *Family Ties* and *The Cosby Show*. I know that these days *The Cosby Show* doesn't necessarily translate how it used to, but it was a beautiful show when it was on the air. I'll give a different one now. I just saw that this show is making a reboot: *Punky Brewster*. Michael J. Fox in every single stage of his career, including now, has been an idol of mine, and so anything he touches turns to gold pretty much.

5 What is a movie you never get tired of watching?

Oh my goodness. So many. *Back to the Future* and *Back to the Future Part II*. They are my two favorite movies of all time, but also, I love *The Princess Bride*.

CBS' daytime talk show **The Talk** will be back for Season 12, sans Sharon Osbourne. ... and executive produced by R.J. Cutler. The series will track the massive growth of the Juul company from a small business to the huge multibillion-dollar entity it is now. ... Amazon Prime Video cast ③ **Jack Huston** as a male lead in its upcoming drama series

Lifetime is updating the classic Michael Landon series *Highway to Heaven* with an event movie series starring Jill Scott in the gender-flipped lead role as Angela, a new angel who visits Earth to assist people in crisis. Also starring is Barry Watson, who plays a junior high school principal and someone to whom Angela reveals who she really is. The movies are inspired by the original '80s series that ran for five seasons.

SNAKES IN THE THRONE ROOM

Starz is getting royal in its upcoming drama series *The Serpent Queen*, based on the book *Catherine de Medici: Renaissance Queen of France* by Leonie Frieda. As you can probably tell by that book title, the series will center on Catherine de Medici (played by ④ **Samantha Morton**), who enters the French court as a teenager soon to be queen expected to have many children and bring riches to the crown, but instead finds herself infertile and without a dowry. Despite this, she becomes a commanding force and rules France for 50 years.

A MEMORABLE WEDDING

NBC has introduced an intense drama pilot – *Getaway*. The series focuses on a group of guests at a destination wedding at a luxury resort whose lives are thrown into chaos when the island is taken over by a band of dangerous criminals. Luckily, one of the guests is a fierce Army veteran (played by ⑤ **Annie Ilonze**), but everyone must band together to stay alive.

Watch Football On DISH!

The football season is almost underway – finally! Make sure you don't miss your favorite teams play by using your receiver to find and record your games. DISH also has a variety of sports channels to give you more access to the games and teams you love. Check out all of the resources below!

Sports Channels

As a general reference, you will find games on the following channels:

- Local networks (Channels 2-70)
- National sports channels (Channels 140-159)
- Regional sports channels (Channels 404-412 on your Hopper, Joey or Wally; Channels 407-439 on your ViP-model receiver)
 - Note: You may see a "+" sign next to some channels. This indicates that there are various channels within the network. Press "Select" on your remote to expand the list.

ESPN (Channel 140) is included in the base AT120 package. NFL Network (Channel 154) and a variety of regional sports channels (Channels 404-412), including Pac-12 Network and SEC Network, are included in AT120 Plus. DISH also offers the Multi-Sport Pack with RedZone. This package includes college sports networks like SEC, Big Ten, Pac-12, Big XII and ACC – and with RedZone, you can see every touchdown from every game from every Sunday afternoon NFL game during the regular season. You must subscribe to AT120 Plus or higher in order to add the Multi-Sport Pack. Change and/or add packages in your mydish.com account or the MyDISH app.





How To Find Your Game

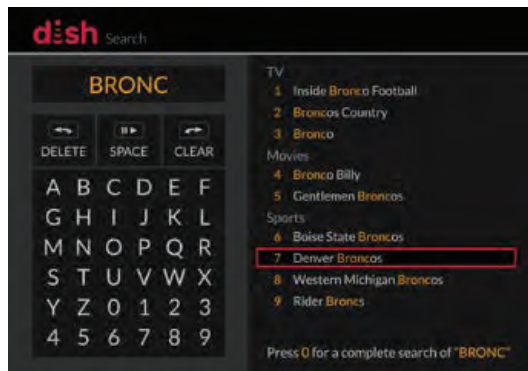
Search

The fastest way to find your game is to use the Search feature on your receiver.

If you have a Hopper, Wally or Joey and a voice remote:

- Press and hold the microphone button, and then say:
 - Your team's name
 - Choose your team from the results
 - Record their games, favorite them to get notifications as to when they are playing and more
 - "Football" to see a schedule of upcoming games

If you have a Hopper, Wally or Joey and a non-voice remote:



- Press the Search button on your remote
- Football will top the list of prepopulated results on the right
 - Select that option to be directed to a schedule of upcoming games
- Enter your team's name to record their games, get notifications as to when they are playing and more

If you have a ViP-model receiver:

- Press the Search button on your remote
- Enter a keyword, like your team's name
- Select your desired theme, and then "Get Results"

Game Finder

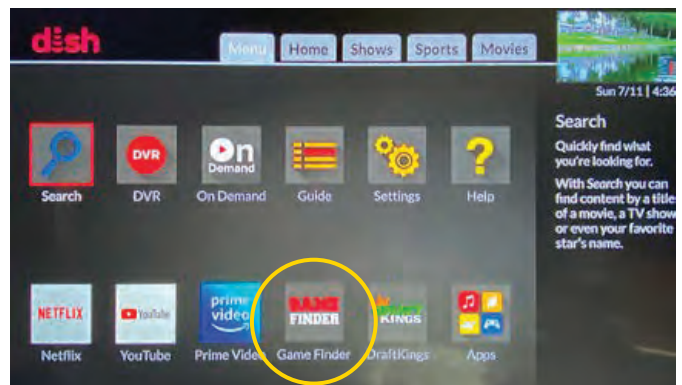
Use the Game Finder app on your receiver to see games in progress, as well as upcoming games today and for the rest of the week. You can see scores across all games, even if you can't view the game in your specific area.

If you have a Hopper, Wally or Joey and a voice remote:

- Press and hold the microphone button and say "Game Finder"

If you have a Hopper, Wally or Joey and a non-voice remote:

- Press the Home button twice or the Menu button once, depending on your remote
- Scroll down and select the Apps tile
- Select the Game Finder tile to load the app



If you have a ViP-model receiver:

- Enter Channel 100 on your remote to load DishHOME
- Select the Game Finder icon from the Sports section

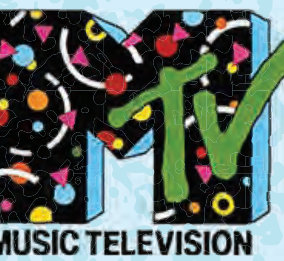

1980s



Aug. 1, 1981: "Ladies and gentlemen, rock and roll." With these words,

MTV: Music Television launches just after midnight Eastern time, accompanied by footage of a rocket blasting off and the 1969 *Apollo 11* moon landing –

with an astronaut planting the MTV flag on the surface.

1982: Pete Townshend, Stevie Nicks, Mick Jagger, Adam Ant, Pat Benatar, the Police and David Bowie declare "I Want My MTV!" in an advertising campaign.

1983: The world premiere of Michael Jackson's 13-minute-long "Thriller" video was as hyped and anticipated as any blockbuster movie opening, and it helped solidify MTV as a pop-culture force.



1984: MTV's **Video Music Awards** touched viewers for the very first time when Madonna performed "Like a Virgin" while wearing a bustier/wedding gown combo, with her infamous "Boy Toy" belt buckle.



1985: MTV spearheads a safe-sex **PSA initiative** in response to the AIDS epidemic. • MTV broadcasts 16 hours of coverage of **Live Aid** concerts to raise funds for famine relief in Ethiopia.

1986: **Dial MTV**, a video countdown show with a toll-free request line, begins. • MTV starts **Spring Break** coverage, broadcasting live from Daytona Beach for eight hours a day for a week. • **120 Minutes**, MTV's first genre program, premieres, introducing a wider audience to alternative acts.

1987: The MTV News division launches with the series **The Week in Rock**, hosted by the network's first official news correspondent, Kurt Loder. • **Headbangers Ball** debuts, focusing on heavy metal videos. • Popular VJ Downtown Julie Brown begins hosting the new *American Bandstand*-like dance show **Club MTV**. • MTV enters the game show arena with **Remote Control**, which introduces comedian/actor Colin Quinn to many viewers.

1988: The launch of **Yo! MTV Raps** brings hip-hop videos to mainstream America.

1989: **House of Style**, one of the first shows to capitalize on the popular interest in fashion and supermodels' lives, begins, with original host Cindy Crawford. • **MTV Unplugged**, a concert showcase for musical artists usually playing acoustic instruments, premieres with Squeeze, Syd Straw and Elliot Easton.

1990s

1992: Reality TV is changed forever when the first season of **The Real World** hits television, following seven strangers living in a SoHo loft in New York City. • The inaugural **MTV Movie Awards** (later renamed the MTV Movie & TV Awards), hosted by Dennis Miller, names *Terminator 2: Judgment Day* its Best Movie.



1993: Mike Judge's **Beavis and Butt-Head** animated series debuts, making fun of just about everything airing on MTV. • Howard Stern is the first guest on the inaugural edition of MTV's first talk show, **The Jon Stewart Show**.

1995: The first season of the docu-adventure series **Road Rules** debuts, centering on five strangers who travel around the country in an RV trying to complete various missions.

1997: The weekly live performance series **Live From the 10 Spot** launches with a performance from David Bowie.

1998: The Emmy Award-winning documentary series **True Life** premieres with an investigation into heroin use among young people in Plano, Texas. • Carson Daly is unleashed on the world in the new live daily top 10 countdown show **Total Request Live**.

1999: Heavily promoted and covered by MTV, the infamous **Woodstock '99** music festival in July was an unusual experience. I made the trip to the venue in Rome, New York, with four friends who never left their tents. They paid a lot of money to attend a three-day music festival without witnessing any of the music. Flying solo, I remember walking between the two main stages, which were on opposite ends of a large field in the middle of nowhere. Everclear put on a great show. The Offspring's lead singer, Dexter Holland, was the only musician to discourage unruly behavior from the crowd. It got pretty rambunctious in those seas of people. Limp Bizkit was very noisy and wild. It was extremely hot all weekend and bottled water was exorbitantly expensive and in short supply. I was a hot, sweaty mess for 72 hours. Mainly what I remember is the heat, the walking and people sliding through human waste after the portable toilets were pushed over on Sunday. Sheryl Crow once said it was her single worst gig, and that is easy to believe. (Fun fact: My future wife was also there, many years before we met.) – PD

2000s

2000: Prank and stunt show **Jackass** begins its wildly successful run of warning kids to not try this at home. • **MTV Cribs** opens the doors to celebrities' houses that are – Redman's house excepted – way better than yours.

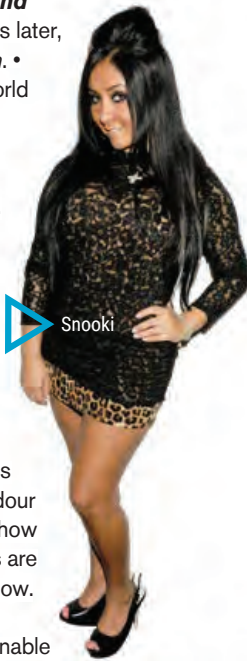

2004: **Pimp My Ride** and host Xzibit begin America's vehicular-pimpin' craze. • Lauren Conrad and pals star in docudrama **Laguna Beach: The Real Orange County**, which would later be spun off into *The Hills*.

2009: Documentary series **16 and Pregnant** is born. A few months later, it spawns the spinoff *Teen Mom*. • All MTV channels around the world broadcast **Michael Jackson's memorial service** live. • Kanye West interrupts Taylor Swift's award acceptance at the VMAs. **"Imma let you finish, but ..."** enters the vernacular. • The world is introduced to Snooki, Pauly D, the Situation and the rest of the **Jersey Shore** cast.



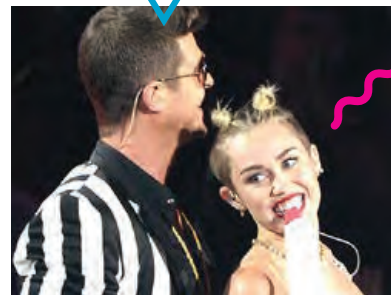

Twelve actors will be spotlighted in SUTS (Summer Under the Stars) celebrations for the first time this year. Below are this year's first-timers, along with movies making their TCM debuts during this celebration. First-Time Stars



Richard Burton (Aug. 2) – The acclaimed Welsh actor finally gets his SUTS due this month. Burton's day includes three of the films he made with then-wife Elizabeth Taylor – *The Sandpiper* (1965), *The Comedians* (1967) and *The Taming of the Shrew* (1967).



Abbott and Costello (Aug. 7) – Legendary comedy duo Bud Abbott and Lou Costello – whose humor successfully transitioned from burlesque and radio to films and television – make their SUTS debut with a day of laugh-riot movies, including *Abbott and Costello Meet Frankenstein* (1948).



George Segal (Aug. 10) – The first-time SUTS lineup of George Segal films also serves as a tribute to star, who passed away March 23 at age 87. It includes Segal's roles in dramas like *Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?* (1966) as well as comedies like *Fun With Dick and Jane* (1977).



Robert Redford (Aug. 18) – Amazingly, this month marks the first time that quintessential movie star Robert Redford has been spotlighted with his own day of films during SUTS. Fittingly, it airs on the actor's 85th birthday (he was born Charles Robert Redford Jr. on Aug. 18, 1936).



Eve Arden (Aug. 23) – The first SUTS lineup devoted to famed actress Eve Arden includes many of the feature films she made over her six-decade career, such as *Mildred Pierce* (1945), *Our Miss Brooks* (1956), *Tea for Two* (1950) and *Anatomy of a Murder* (1959).



Tony Randall (Aug. 26) – Actor/comedian/singer Tony Randall's first SUTS lineup includes the romantic comedies in which he famously costarred with Doris Day and Rock Hudson – *Pillow Talk* (1959), *Lover Come Back* (1961) and *Send Me No Flowers* (1964).

Must-Watch Drama!

HEELS

TV Superstars Stephen Amell And Alexander Ludwig Wrestle With Their Emotions, Loyalties And Egos In Starz's New Heartfelt Drama.

It was Saturday morning in the late '80s, and for a young Stephen Amell growing up in Toronto that meant it was time to turn on the TV and devour the day's WWE matchups.

Never did he dream that his boyish fascination would eventually find him in the ring pitted against Cody Rhodes in a WWE SummerSlam or that he'd be headlining a series where he was the heel (in wrestling talk that's the villain). But he also never realized he'd fall so in love with a story that was so heartfelt, so complex and so thrilling.

"Frankly, I hadn't really thought about what was going to be next after *Arrow*," Amell tells. "I read the scripts [for *Heels*], and I fell in love with the project, not just because I grew up a huge wrestling fan and then was lucky enough to live out that childhood dream, but just the family dynamic and the richness of the story."

Despite being told not to "kiss the first girl that looks at you at the bar," Amell knew he had something extraordinary and made Starz's *Heels* his first TV project to follow his nearly 10-year run as Oliver Queen on *Arrow*. A wise move, indeed.

AND ALONG CAME "VIKINGS" GREAT ALEXANDER LUDWIG

For nearly seven years, on the other side of the world, Alexander Ludwig spent his time as the brutal but beloved Viking warrior Bjorn Ironside on the global hit series *Vikings*. Ludwig had plenty of box office successes prior to his role as Bjorn (including playing Cato in *The Hunger Games*), and was approached by *Heels*' creator and showrunner, respectively, Michael Waldron and Mike O'Malley.

"I was just blown away by the material. I just thought it was so up my alley and it's just so well written," Ludwig shares.

His only hesitation was on casting, as this was a drama about two very different brothers – Jack and Ace Spade – who clash over their dreams of wrestling fame and running their

deceased father's small-town Duffy Wrestling League (DWL). "I thought this would be a great thing to be a part of. But so much of this is going to depend on who they get for the brother, so I kind of kept a distance from it. ... Finally, when Stephen signed on, I was like, 'Wow, this is going to be great.'"

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THE BROS: JACK AND ACE SPADE

The Spade brothers are from the small, close-knit community of Duffy, Georgia. Jack (Amell) is the older brother; and you know how oldest kids can be – controlling, selfish at times, bossy and impatient. In their family-owned wrestling business, he's the heel – the villain of the show – and also the writer. Jack controls the storylines.

"One of the things that we learned about Jack pretty early on is that he's not above making a decision for selfish purposes," Amell admits. "It's all about what will Jack do? What is the cost of the DWL? At what point does it become too expensive, personally, professionally, spiritually? Because if he hangs on too tight to one thing, then he's going to be left with nothing."

Ace (Ludwig) is the superstar, the fun-loving, hunky hero of the DWL. Outside of the ring he's also the wild card – brash, self-destructive, very unpredictable – but charming, as well.

"You love to love him, and you love to hate him," Ludwig adds. "Ace is an absolute tornado inside of himself. I think he's a complete mess. All these external things in his life impact him in ways he doesn't know how to deal with, especially with his father's death looming over this family and casting a dark shadow from which he's trying to crawl out.

"He truly is trying to find his place in the world. I think that's why I connected so much with the character. He's trying to please everybody and be the man that he thought his dad wanted him to be and all these things," Ludwig continues. "I do think that in his core Ace is a good person. ... He's kind of this roller-coaster character where he

acts like a rock star, but inside he's a really, really tormented child."

GETTING READY TO RUMBLE

Amell went through a bit of a physical transformation for the role, putting on some extra weight. Jack works as a lawnmower salesman during the day and he's main-eventing the DWL every Saturday night, along with booking the matches, doing yardwork and trying to be a good husband and father. "I don't think that he's spending two and a half hours in the gym," Amell laughs. "So I want to make myself more rough and tumble. ... It was like all the work that I did for Oliver Queen, except I'd eat a giant bowl of pasta and steak at the end of the day. And just try to keep on calories. I got myself to a point with work where the fight was actually keeping on the weight."

As for Ludwig, a self-described adrenaline junkie, he was all in on the training and learned how to do a backflip off the top turnbuckle. "*Vikings* was exhausting ... but the hardest thing was the elements – the weather, the mud, the cold, like that was its own type of beast. But when you're in a wrestling match against somebody else ... Stephen and I both almost passed out and like threw up. It was just vicious ... wrestling is certainly more painful."

YOU DON'T NEED TO KNOW WRESTLING TO ENJOY "HEELS"

This is a deep drama that is filled with relatable and very complex characters. While wrestling serves as the backdrop to the storyline, the series is all about the relationships between the family and their small community.

"This is about hardworking small-town people who want more out of life," Ludwig concludes. "And so much of their life is determined by the external. The more they look within themselves, the closer they get to what they're actually looking for, which I would say is real peace and happiness."

A feeling everyone can relate to.

For seven seasons fans enjoyed seeing dreams come true for the many unpredictable guests. But guests did live to regret some requests, which made the series all the more compelling. FOX returns to Fantasy Island this month with a contemporary reboot, where Roselyn Sanchez stars as Elena Roarke, a descendant of Mr. Roarke, ultimately fulfilling his role on the island. Previously, we have seen Sanchez as Carmen Luna in *Devious Maids* and Gigi Mendoza in *Grand Hotel*. Here Sanchez took a break from filming in her native Puerto Rico and shared what lies ahead for the uncanny series.

Your character, Elena Roarke, shares the same last name as the original overseer, Mr. Roarke. Could you explain the relationship there? Who exactly is your character?

Roselyn Sanchez: My character is the grand-niece of Mr. Roarke. I have become a steward of the island the way he was. When there, every generation needs a new host from the family and this time it's Elena's turn.

How familiar were you with the series' history when you were given the script, and what were your initial thoughts? Did you go back and watch the original?

I was very young, but in Puerto Rico the show was actually huge. When you heard "The plane!" everyone knew we were talking about *Fantasy Island*. I watched many original episodes to make sure that I was going to be right in the pocket and understood the genre. I had a lot of talks with Adam Kane, who

directed the first two episodes. He was telling me, "Use Montalban as inspiration, but we want you to be able to do your own take and be yourself."

What excited you about playing this character and leading the series for a new generation?

It's been really wonderful to be able to explore a new take, and as a woman this time. She's fierce and it was very important to me to bring some humor to the whole thing. She needs to be light, funny and likable. I think that's what the writing entails and I'm super pleased. I'm falling in love with her every single day, which is a great thing as an actress.

Give us some insight on some of the storylines we can look forward to.

The premise is pretty much the same. People come to the island, there is the want-versus-need type of dilemma. They come to the island

wanting one thing, but of course, Elena comes in as a steward, as a host, and she becomes like a conduit and tries to make people understand that what they think they need might not be it. ... A lot of times it is challenging. It could be scary. It could be funny. There's different ways that the island goes about it, but it's always intriguing and mysterious, and people are going to laugh and people are going to cry. If you want a specific example, let me see, somebody is terminally ill and they want to just have three days of feeling healthy and vibrant, almost like find the fountain of youth. Like that kind of situation, and Elena is there to teach

them that there's more to life than what they actually believe they need to be happy.

What's it been like working on set in Puerto Rico — your homeland? Have you been able to enjoy family and friends during off days?

It's amazing. I'm able to see my brothers, and my parents are here. So it's fantastic for me. And to be able to bring my kids. My daughter is 9, my son is 3 and we live in Los Angeles, so being here for three months and for them to be able to spend time with us is so valuable and priceless. ... I've been traveling and working since November and I haven't been home. To be able to spend time with my family in Puerto Rico has been great. We were at the beach, and I was looking around and thought about how amazing it is that I'm here in Puerto Rico, my homeland. I was born and raised here, and we have a slogan that

says, "We live where you vacation." One of the locations, and there are many locations, is this beautiful beach resort in Puerto Rico. And I used to produce a triathlon for my foundation. And the third edition of the triathlon was at this location and they have a beautiful clubhouse and I baptized my daughter at that clubhouse. So every time I go to work, every single day, I just drive by this place that is so meaningful to me because that's where my daughter got baptized. It's really incredible how life works.

UFO Watch The Skies! Remove The Foil Hat. UFOs Are Now Up For Serious Debate.

In April, the Pentagon declassified three videos captured by U.S. Navy pilots that appear to show encounters with UFOs — high-speed objects flying with unexpected trajectories. After years of relegating UFO research to the domain of sci-fi nerds or crackpots, the government is at least acknowledging that there are mysterious things flying around.

The new four-part Showtime documentary series *UFO*, from producer Glen Zipper (*Challenger: The Final Flight*) and J.J. Abrams' *Bad Robot*, examines our decades-long fascination with UFOs. The series looks at the phenomenon through cultural and political touchpoints to reveal what the military, government agencies and corporate entities might already know but aren't making public.

The UFO evidence has become credible enough in recent years that lawmakers and bureaucrats are officially looking into the subject. A year ago, the U.S. Department of Defense established the Unidentified Aerial Phenomena (UAP) Task Force "to improve its understanding of, and gain insight into, the nature and origins of UAPs" and to determine if they pose a potential threat to national security.

As for the existence of extraterrestrial visitors, don't expect an official confirmation — or denial — on that topic.

CHAPELWAITE

New Series Is One Of The Most Effectively Horrific Stephen King Adaptations. By Jeff Pfeiffer

Among the fictional Maine communities that author Stephen King has created for his stories, the town of Jerusalem's Lot stands out with an evil energy that has long made it a magnet for malevolent forces like the vampire who arrives in King's 1975 novel *'Salem's Lot*.

A few years after that book, King published a sort of prequel, the short story "Jerusalem's Lot," which takes place mostly in the 19th century and offers a glimpse of the hamlet's infamous past. That story serves as the inspiration for the new EPIX series *Chapelwaite*, a 10-episode hourlong drama that is one of the most effectively horrific adaptations of a King work.

Oscar winner Adrien Brody (also an executive producer) and Emily Hampshire (*Schitt's Creek*) lead this grim and gothic tale. Set in the 1850s, it follows Capt. Charles Boone (Brody), who relocates his family of three children to his ancestral home of Chapelwaite in the small town of Preacher's Corners, Maine, after his wife dies at sea. However, Charles will soon have to confront the secrets of his family's sordid history and fight to end the darkness that has plagued the Boones for generations.

It's especially impressive that King's story has been adapted so compellingly here given that "Jerusalem's Lot" is an epistolary tale — its action is related through characters' letters and journal entries, a challenging technique to effectively write, let alone adapt.

Much of the credit goes to *Chapelwaite* showrunners Peter and Jason Filardi, brothers and screenwriters/producers who are teaming for their first project together here. While Jason has mostly worked with comedy projects prior to this, Peter has written a couple of cult horror films — *Flatliners* (1990) and *The Craft* (1996) — and is no stranger to the world of Stephen King, having written two episodes of the 2004 *Salem's Lot* miniseries.

"We're both lifelong fans [of King]," Peter says. "[After] reading ["Jerusalem's Lot"], it was a matter of tapping into the theme of it all, and the world of it all, and then sort of building it out from there."

With their creative team, the Filardis have indeed built out a world in *Chapelwaite* that not only captures the atmosphere of King's story, but also incorporates imagery and tropes of classic gothic tales. Those range from the old dark house of the title itself to the governess (Hampshire) who comes to work for its owner, a brooding man with dark secrets — and perhaps madness, given his tendency to hear what he thinks are rats scratching behind the walls, and the grotesque visions he has involving lots of squirming earthworms.

It's a world that unfolds with enough of a slow burn to create a persistent and increasing sense of dread, and even fans knowledgeable with King's works will find shocks as the secrets of Chapelwaite, Preacher's Corners and the nearby Jerusalem's Lot are revealed.

Peter explains that “King has carved out such a giant place for himself in the haunted house genre with *The Shining*, that when you combine gothic horror [with something like that,] it’s a fun mashup. The original story, a lot of it is Stephen King’s nod to [H.P.] Lovecraft. And so, it’s almost like the series [blends together] a long lineage of gothic horror.”

It isn’t only the Chapelwaite house that holds terrors. Shot in Nova Scotia as a stand-in for Maine, the series uses terrific cinematography to vividly re-create just how frightening the outdoors and the nighttime could be for people living in what was basically still a wilderness in the days before electricity.

“We wanted the show to look and feel like real life of that time,” Jason says of the series’ naturalistic feel that enhances its scariness even in daylight. “A big discussion we had was, let’s use natural lighting as much as we can. And when there’s lighting, let’s use the lamplight. Back then, it would’ve been probably oil lamps, so that figures into our story.”

“We also spoke,” adds Peter, “about light as a character in this story. Charles Boone was a whaler, and he would bring back whale oil, which was used in lamps to create light and push back against the shadows. Metaphorically, he’s pushing back against superstition and fear and prejudice and a lot of other things. ... The idea of light and shadow and ignorance and knowledge and all that Charles is bringing to this small town was a big thematic element that we wanted.”

ASYLUM (2012) Critics and fans obsessed over Season 2, which earned 17 Primetime Emmy nominations. Returning cast members included Sarah Paulson, Evan Peters, Lily Rabe, Jessica Lange, Dylan McDermott and Frances Conroy. Performances by Lange and Paulson were praised, and the feature of aliens stands unique to this particular season, leaving the fate of Peters' character, Kit Walker, unknown.



COVEN (2013) Jessica Lange and Sarah Paulson were both nominated for Emmys for Outstanding Lead Actress in a Miniseries or a Movie, with Lange winning. The season takes place in 2013 but flashes back to the 1692 Salem witch trials. It starred Kathy Bates as Delphine LaLaurie, who abused her slaves. Eye transplants, bizarre heads, Angela Bassett and a scene of the cast in front of the LaLaurie mansion in New Orleans are beyond chilling, and many today refuse to step near the home where this season was set.



FREAK SHOW (2014) Set in 1952 Jupiter, Florida, this season took us to one of the last standing freak shows in the country and received 20 Emmy nominations for doing so, surpassing

nominations in previous seasons. Conjoined twins, a boy with lobster hands, a three-breasted woman and the world's smallest woman make the season unforgettable. Sarah Paulson won Best Supporting Actress in a Movie or Limited Series at the Critics' Choice Television Awards for her impeccable performance as Bettie and Dot Tattler, the conjoined twins.



HOTEL (2015) Lady Gaga was the standout this season as the Countess, a bloodsucking vampire who oversees the fictional Hotel Cortez (inspired by the creepy Cecil Hotel in Los Angeles). Despite her iconic role, this was the first season the series was not nominated for Outstanding Limited Series.



ROANOKE (2016) Interestingly, this was the first season that did not debut in October; instead it began in September. Kathy Bates, Sarah Paulson, Angela Bassett, Evan Peters and Lady Gaga returned, and it features a performance from Bates as "The Butcher." Brad Falchuk and Ryan Murphy took a different approach, essentially making it a show within a show as we listened to the "real-life" story but watched reenactments of the horrors from the Lost Colony of Roanoke.



CULT (2017) Sarah Paulson, Evan Peters, Adina Porter and new cast member Billie Lourd starred. The controversial season told a political story of Donald Trump winning the 2016 U.S. election, with a cult disrupting a fictional Michigan suburb. Paulson's character, Ally Mayfair-Richards, is engulfed in fear after the election; the season surprised fans with a remarkably twisted ending.



APOCALYPSE (2018) This season took place in the future after a nuclear fallout destroyed a large amount of the human population. Sarah Paulson, Evan Peters, Billie Lourd and Cody Fern starred. A guest appearance by Jessica Lange excited fans, along with a vastly improved plotline, earning the series five Emmy nominations. Many loved how the season was a crossover, connected to *Murder House* and *Coven*.



1984 (2019) Emma Roberts, Billie Lourd, Cody Fern and *Glee* star Matthew Morrison headlined. Fans were upset with the first-time absences of Sarah Paulson and Evan Peters. The storyline followed a group of summer-camp counselors who were being hunted by multiple serial killers. The season embodied slasher films similar to *Friday the 13th*.

With Only 24 Episodes Left In The Series, We Catch Up With Josh McDermitt (Eugene!), Who Shares How He's Prepping For The End.

If you're not a threat, you have nothing to worry about.

Yah, right. After 10 seasons, fans of *The Walking Dead* know better.

But as we start the final season of the postapocalyptic megahit, that's what's facing Eugene, Ezekiel, Yumiko and Princess as the Commonwealth continues to process (or more like interrogate) the group. Meanwhile, back at Alexandria, Maggie, Carol, Daryl and the rest of the survivors are barely surviving and go on a food hunt that drastically goes wrong (note to self: It's a bad idea to seek safety in an underground subway tunnel). We tracked down the series' master thinker, Eugene himself – well, actually, Josh McDermitt – to reflect on the series' final season and walk us through these remaining episodes. (The final season consists of 24 episodes, divided into three parts, which will most likely play out as eight this summer/fall, eight in early 2022 and the final eight next fall.)

Where do we pick up with Eugene and the Commonwealth?

Josh McDermitt: They've been surrounded by these white-armored soldiers, and Eugene is kind of thinking, "OK, we're here for the Commonwealth, and I expected a checkpoint, and I expected there to be some vetting. This is not what I expected. You guys look organized, you guys look like you are mean and intimidating." But the fact is he's on this mission to not just save his town, his community of Alexandria and Hilltop and everybody who was back home fighting and are literally hanging by a thread, but he's trying to reach out to this person [Stephanie] that he's made a connection with on the radio, just trying to build this bigger world.

Survivor Status: A Lot Has Changed Since Season 5!



How long do we have to wait until we actually get to meet the mysterious Stephanie?

I want to say we'll probably see her sooner than later. I don't know if I can give specifics of when, but it seems like it's been forever. It's coming up a lot sooner than we realize.

Do you miss not being with the rest of the group — as the group is so divided now?

It's hard, especially coming into our final episodes. It's not just the cast, it's the crew, too. We truly are a family. And it is a physically, mentally and emotionally taxing show to shoot. And we're now doing that without the help of our friends and family nearby. Lauren [Cohan, who plays Maggie] and I chat on the phone or text all the time, but I don't know the last time I saw her. I saw her when I went to set to get a COVID test, and she was being whisked away to go shoot some scene. And we just waved from about 100 yards apart, and that was the last time I saw Lauren. ... It does make it harder when there's this whole other group of people that are having their own experiences. And I know that they feel the same way, because we do talk about it on text and the phone and stuff like that. But it's hard.

Now, if you could write the ending for Eugene, not paying attention to any of the comics or anything, do you have an idea how you would love to see his story conclude?

I mean, I think I have to go with what we saw in the comics. I've always wanted

Eugene to die of old age, because he's a guy who's figured out a way to live. He's a bit of a cockroach. He doesn't go away. You just step on him, and he just keeps moving. When you first see him, you're like, "How have you made it this far?" But he's resilient, and he's found a way. In my mind, I've always thought this is a guy who needs to be standing at the end, because he deserves it. He's worked his butt off.

What character's death impacted you the most — as a friend and as a character?

Michael Cudlitz and Steven Yeun. I mean, definitely. I think that shook everybody. It's never easy saying goodbye to someone on set. I mean, we've lost a lot of people that we're very close with, and some people we're genuinely excited for what's next in their lives. And so, it's sad that we're not going to be able to work with them anymore, but we're super pumped for the next chapter in their lives and careers.

... We were super bummed that Cudlitz, who's a big papa bear to us, and Steven, who is one of the greatest human beings and greatest friends you could ask for, weren't going to be with us anymore. They weren't going to be with us playing games and going to dinner and goofing off and just hanging out and having barbecues and that sort of thing. That's tough. I mean, those moments are what made the show for us, and those were two huge pillars that we're going to be missing holding the roof up.

In the Class of 2021 are players Alan Faneca, Calvin Johnson, John Lynch, Peyton Manning, Drew Pearson and Charles Woodson, coach Tom Flores and scout Bill Nunn.

The regular season kicks off Thursday, Sept. 9, with the Cowboys on the road to face ageless QB Tom Brady and the Super Bowl LV champion Tampa Bay Buccaneers. The extended season means a later start to the playoffs, with wild-card weekend scheduled for Jan. 15-16 and Super Bowl LVI in Los Angeles Feb. 13.

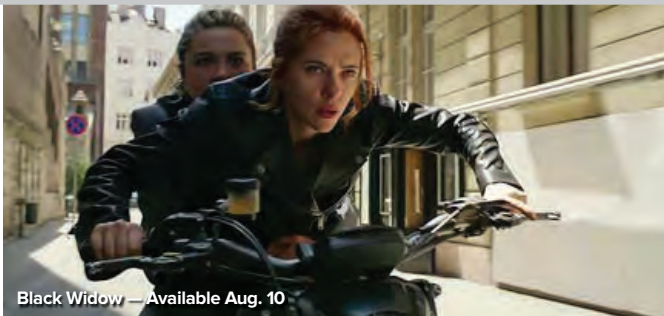

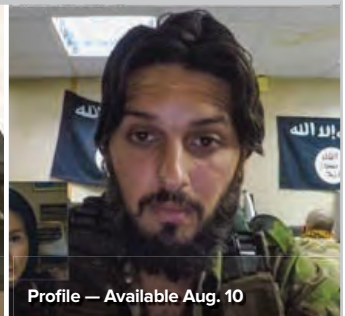
