## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## BASIC KIT

All you need for each granny square is some crochet hooks and yarn. Some squares require a little stuffing, and you will also need a yarn needle for weaving in ends and adding embroidery details. Always read through the instructions carefully before you start to ensure that you have all of the required items.

## CROCHET HOOKS

Metric sizes have been provided for crochet hooks. Please refer to the following conversion chart if your hooks are labelled with imperial or US sizes instead:

TERMINOLOGY
These patterns have been written using US terms. If you are used to working with UK terms, then please note the following differences in stitch names:

## READING CHARTS

All of the square patterns are accompanied by coloured charts that show each individual layer of crochet to be made. The colours shown on the charts represent the different yarn colours used for the design, and a colour key is provided with each pattern to help you to identify the shades used. To follow the charts, refer to the symbol key (see Chart Symbols).

## CHRISTMAS ELF

The yarn colour names and codes given below refer to the Paintbox Yarns Cotton DK range.

## SQUARE

With a 2.75 mm hook and Light Caramel (409), make a magic ring. Rnd 1: 6sc, slst to close rnd. [6sc] Rnd 2: ch3, 3dc in each of next 5 sts, 2dc in last st, slst to close rnd. 18dc]

Rnd 3: ch3, dc in next st, (dc in
next st, 2dc in next st) 8 times. slst to close rnd. [26dc]

Rnd 4: ch3, (2dc in next 2 sts, dc in next st) 8 times, 3dc in last st, slst to close rnd. [44dc]

Rnd 5: ch3, (2dc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts) 10 times, dc in last 3 sts, slst to close rnd. [64dc
Fasten off Light Caramel (409). Join Champagne White (403) in any Rnd 5 st with a standing tr.

Rnd 6: (ch2, tr) in same st, *tr in next st, dc in next 2 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, dc in next 2 sts, tr in next st, (tr, ch2, tr) in same st**; rep from * to ** 3 times omitting (tr, ch2, tr) in last rep, slst to close rnd. [68, 4ch-2]
Rnd 7: slst in ch-2-sp, ch3, (dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch-2-sp, *dc in next 17 sts, (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in ch-2-sp**; rep from * to ** 3 times omitting (2dc, ch2, 2dc) in last rep, slst to close rnd. [84dc, 4ch-2]

Rnd 8: ch3, dc in next st, * (2dc, ch3 2 dc ) in ch-2-sp, dc in next 21 sts** rep from * to ** 3 times omitting last 2dc in last rep, slst to close rnd. [100dc, 4ch-3]

Rnd 9: ch3, dc in next 3 sts, *(2dc ch3, 2dc) in ch-3-sp, dc in next 25 sts**: rep from * to ** 3 times omitting last 4dc in last rep, slst to close rnd. [116dc, 4ch-3]
Fasten off Champagne White (403).

## NOSE

With Light Caramel (409), make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6sc, slst to close rnd. [6sc]
Rnd 2: sc in each st to end. [6sc]
Rnd 3: sc in each st to end, slst to close rnd. [6sc]

Fasten off Light Caramel (409). Stuff lightly and attach to centre of square
Stitch nose to centre of square. Embroider eyes on either side of nose with Pure Black (402) Embroider mouth along outer edge of Rnd 3 of square with Red Wine (416).

HAT
With Slate Green (427), ch3.
Row 1: hdc in third ch from hook ch. [2hdc]

Row 2: turn, hdc in next st, 2hdc in last st, ch. [3hdc]
Row 3: turn, hdc in each st to last st, 2hdc in last st, ch. [4hdc]
Rows 4-11: Rep Row 3. [12hdc]
Row 12: ch, dc in same st, hdc in next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in next 2 sts, 2dc in last st. [13]

Fasten off Slate Green (427). Join Red Wine (416) in last st of Row 12.

Row 13: ch2, dc in same st, hdc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, slst in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next st, dc in last st. [13]

Fasten off Red Wine (416).
Stitch hat in place on top of elf's head. Fold top of hat down and secure in place as shown.

## EARS

With Light Caramel (409), make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6sc, slst to close rnd. [6sc]
Rnd 2: 2 sc in each st to end. [12sc]
Rnd 3: hdc in next st, (hdc, dc) in next st, (2dc, picot, 2dc) in next st, (dc, hdc) in next st, hdc in next st slst in next st to end rnd. [10, picot] Fasten off Light Caramel (409). Rep to make a total of 2 ears.
Stitch ears on either side of hat.

## BELL

With Mustard Yellow (424), make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6sc, slst to close rnd. [6sc]
Fasten off Mustard Yellow (424). Stitch bell to tip of hat.

## BEARD

With Coffee Bean (411), ch5, slst to make ring
Rnd 1: ch3, 4dc in ring, ch, 5 dc in ring. [1 beard loop]
This rnd sets up posts for next row of beard loops:

Rnd 2: ch3, dc in same st, ch, dc in ring sp from Rnd 1, ch, 2dc in third ch of ch3 from Rnd 1. [2 double posts, 1 single post]

Rnd 3: 5bpdc around first dc-post from Rnd 2, ch, 5dc around next dc-post, slst in single dc-post, 5bpdc around first dc-post, ch, 5dc around next dc-post. [2 beard loops]
Fasten off Coffee Bean (411). Attach beard to bottom of elf's head.

The yarn colour names and codes given below refer to the Paintbox Yarns Cotton DK range.

## SQUARE

With a 2.5 mm hook and Pillar Red (415), make a magic ring.

Rnd 1: ch2, 2hdc (ch2, 3hdc) 3 times, ch2, slst to close rnd. [12hdc 4 ch-2-sp]

Rnd 2: ch2, *hdc in each st to ch-sp, *(2hdc, ch2, 2hdc) in corner sp**; rep from * to ** 3 times, hdc n each st to ch-sp, (2hdc, 2ch hdc) in corner sp, slst to close rnd [28hdc, 4 ch-2-sp]

Rnd 3: rep Rnd 2. [44hdc, 4 ch 2-sp]

Rnd 4: rep Rnd 2. [60hdc, 4 ch-
2-sp]
Rnd 5: rep Rnd 2. [76hdc, 4 ch-2-sp]
Fasten off Pillar Red (415), join Speckled Grey (xxx) in corner h-2-sp.
Rnd 6: ch, *sc in each st to corner sp, [sc, ch2, sc] in corner sp**; rep from * to ** 3 times, slst to close rnd. [84sc, 4 ch-2-sp]

Fasten off Speckled Grey (xxx)

HAT
With Misty Grey (404), make a magic ring
Rnd 1: ch2, (5dc, ch2, slst) in ring. [5dc]
Row 2: join Pillar Red (415), do not turn, (slst, ch3, 2tr) in first dc, 2dc in next 3 sts, (2tr, ch3, slst) in next st. [4tr, 6dc]
Row 3: with Misty Grey (404), do not turn, (slst, ch2, dc) in first tr, dc in each st, ch2, slst in last tr. [10dc]

Row 4: with Pillar Red (415), re Row 3. [10 dc]

Fasten off Pillar Red (415) and Misty Grey (404), join Speckled Grey (xxx)

All sts in this row are made in FLO of Row 4.

Row 5: (slst, ch3, dc) in first dc, dc in each st. [10dc]

All sts in this row are made in BLO of Row 4

Row 6: turn work, dc in each st of Row 4 (adds bulk to rim), slst to join. [10dc]

Row 7: turn work, (ch, slst back and front loops of Rows 5 and 6 tog) in each st

Fasten off Speckled Grey (xxx)

## FINISHING

Make a pompom with scraps of yarn and sew onto top of hat.

Stitch hat onto square as shown


HAT CHARTS

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9 out of 10 people with diabetes have Type 2. People with Type 2 diabetes can improve their health and reduce their risk of heart and circulatory diseases by making simple changes.

## Understanding Type 2 diabetes

After we eat, our bodies break down carbohydrates into glucose. People without diabetes release insulin when they eat, which signals cells to absorb the glucose and use it as fuel for energy.

If you have Type 2 diabetes, your body doesn't make enough insulin, or can't use the insulin it makes. This results in high levels of glucose in your bloodstream which can damage your arteries and increase your risk of heart disease.

## How do I know if I have Type 2 diabetes?

Many people with Type 2 diabetes don't know they have it. You may have diabetes if you're often very thirsty, often very tired, you have blurred vision, lose weight unexpectedly or notice that wounds heal slowly. You're also more likely to develop Type 2 diabetes if you are overweight, especially if you carry weight around your middle. Your doctor can diagnose you and help you manage your condition.

## Make three small changes

- Be more active-aim for 150 minutes of exercise a week
- Look at food labels and opt for foods that are green or amber for sugars
- Get portion sizes right to help manage your weight
