New 2018-2019 St. Gabriel School Year Calendar at a Glance!




2018 - 2019 School Year Calendar at a glance

This link will take you to the new 2018-19 St. Gabriel school year basic calendar at a glance. It has school start and end dates, no-school dates (holidays, teacher in-services), MAP testing dates, and Kdg Orientation and Screening dates.

PLEASE NOTE: The first day of school is a regular full day of school on August 21. Buses will be running on this day and all days forward, hot lunch will be served, and students must be in uniform. There is no pre-set-up day.

Kindergarten, Jr Kindergarten and new transfer students will have their special orientation on Monday August 20, as noted on above Calendar at a Glance link.




Mission Movie with Fr. Jeremy for Mission Trip
