





- Do you believe that this forgiveness is found only in Christ, and is offered by Christ in the Lord's Supper? Do you believe that Christ's body and blood are truly present in, with, and under the bread and wine as Christ
- promised?
- Do you believe in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior, as taught at Grace, and by your participation in the sacrament, give testimony to the faith we share?
- Do you desire by the power of the Holy Spirit and the instruction of God's Word to live a life pleasing to Him? Before communing for the first time at Grace, you are asked to please speak with one of the pastors. Children are welcomed at the Lord's Table to receive a blessing, but should not partake of the Sacrament prior to Communion instruction. God's richest blessings to all who come to His table!
