Annual Large Group Festival: Camas musicians get high praise for wrangling challenging music!

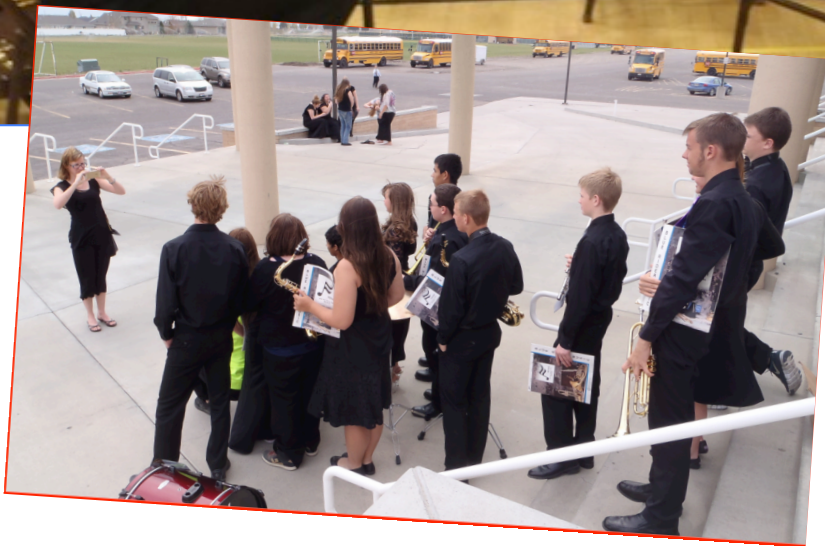

Box Canyon Nature Excursion! Take a Hike with CSI!

Saturday, May 2, 9 a.m. to noon! Box Canyon Nature Preserve! Walk! Only \$12!

Join CSI Biology Professor, Sarah Harris, and Idaho State Parks Ranger, Eric Whittekiend, on an educational exploration of one of Idaho’s most beautiful spots, the Earl M Hardy Box Canyon Springs Nature Preserve. Still in development as a state park, it is co-managed by The Nature Conservancy and the State of Idaho. The area offers great views of the springs, a platform overlooking the waterfall and the opportunity to see many species of wildlife. Feel free to bring your camera. This easy out-and-back hike is a great way to explore one of Idaho’s many hidden gems. Directions: *Take I-84 to Exit #155 in Wendell and go west 3 miles to County Road 1500 East.
