

- Every student should be practicing multiplication math facts at least 10 minutes each night.

Below you will find the new grading scale for our revised report cards.

Level of Mastery Learning Key:

Students have mastered grade level expectations M = Mastered

without teacher support.

P = Progressing Students are progressing toward grade level

expectations and require minimal support

from the teacher.

B = Basic Students have a basic foundation of the grade level

skill and require moderate support from the teacher.

L = Limited Students are not meeting grade level expectations

and demonstrate limited knowledge of the skill.

- Assignments will be assigned on Mondays by 9:00am and due the following Monday by 9:00am.
- Assignments will be graded within a week of the due date.
- Students with IEPs have 1 additional week to complete any online assignments.
- Any missing assignments will be communicated to the parents leading to and after their due date.
- Any missing assignments will be docked from attendance by how much time that daily task was assigned. For example: If a child does not complete the Eureka worksheet and the grade level teacher said it should take 30 minutes, then 30 minutes would be deducted from that child's attendance.





Report Cards

Please note that the elementary report cards have been revised for the 2020-2021 school year. This year you will see more details related to each academic area. These details will be presented in "I Can" statements based on priority skills taught in each nine weeks grading period. The next slide contains the new grading scale for standards. At the 1-5 grade levels we will no longer be using a traditional letter grading scale (A, B, C, D, and F). When you see your child's revised progress report you may see shaded out areas next to a skill. This indicates that the skill has not been taught yet. If you have specific questions, please email your child's homeroom teacher. More details regarding this revised progress report system will come home from Mrs. Marshall and Mrs. Wills.







Communication

The ClassDojo App and email are the best ways to get in touch with me. You can also call the school to leave a voicemail. Any pertinent/time-sensitive information should be sent to me via the ClassDojo App, email, or by leaving a message with the office. I use the ClassDojo App frequently to communicate with families, and the newsletter/Google Classroom is the best place to look first for information. I can also communicate through Google Meet by appointment.
