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2. OPTIONAL SERVICES

DHL offers a variety of Optional Services designed to help meet your shipping needs.

We offer a range of DHL Optional Services designed to complement our international delivery services – while providing you flexibility and peace of mind.

OPTIONAL SERVICES*

Shipment Value Protection	Add some extra security for your goods. Cover physical loss or damage of goods, subject to specific limitations and exclusions as described in our Terms & Conditions.
Extended Liability	Get extra protection for valuable documents, such as passports and visa applications. Increase the DHL standard liability, resulting in added coverage and compensation in the event of a full or partial loss.
Saturday Pickup/Delivery	Request Saturday pickup or delivery for shipments up to 300 kg, and for pieces up to 30 kg. Services are available only in select DHL service areas.
Dedicated Pickup/Delivery	Available for urgent or non-routine pickup/delivery requiring special attention (i.e., specific vehicle type or multiple couriers).
Shipment Preparation	We can help you physically prepare a shipment or any non-Customs-related transport documentation - including waybill preparation, content selection, labeling and paperwork.
Duties and Taxes Paid (DTP)	DHL will clear a shipment as normal but can then charge duties, taxes or other regulatory fees to either a nominated third party other than the recipient, or to a duty tax account specified on the waybill.
Change of Billing	If you need to quickly reassign transportation charges to a different account, we can charge a different DHL account than the one originally specified on the DHL Waybill.

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3. CUSTOMS SERVICES

Personalized Customs solutions to help keep your shipments moving.

Some shipments may require Customs clearance. DHL provides a selection of individualized Customs Services to meet Customs clearance requirements.

CUSTOMS SERVICES*

Advance Payment	We will cover any duties, taxes or regulatory charges on shipments imported by a receiver not contracted with DHL. For this, an administrative fee will be applied to offset the financial risk of non-repayment. That amount is based on the credit advanced, subject to a standard minimum.
Bonded Storage	Often we can store a shipment in transit without requiring duty payment – if the items are registered and held in a Customs-bonded facility (DHL or non-DHL) for more than three calendar days after arriving. Bonded Storage is useful, for example, while items await documentation from the receiver/importer, or while clearance is assigned to a third party.
Bonded Transit Documents	A bonded shipment occurs when DHL is requested to move non-document foreign-origin goods to a location other than the regular DHL gateway at destination. Bonded Transit applies to both export and import shipments whenever DHL is required to open, manage or report any form of transfer under bond using our own guarantee.
Disbursements	To expedite faster Customs clearance, account holders may use the DHL bond or credit line on a regular basis to automatically cover import duties, taxes or regulatory charges levied on their inbound shipment. DHL will cover those costs and later invoice the charges after delivery.
Export Declaration	If your shipment exceeds a particular value or is sent to a certain destination, DHL can file an export declaration for you. This service is useful in countries that demand an export declaration for shipments that contain controlled commodities or exceed a certain value or weight threshold.
Broker Notification	Upon request, we can provide all necessary paperwork to a designated broker, who can then finalize import clearance, allowing for delivery to the final destination.
Multi-line Entry	All shipment elements must be properly identified and classified under separate Harmonized Tariff Codes. DHL will process item entries with more than five lines filled, such as one shipment with multiple products or invoices. For a shipment with multiple commodities or origins of manufacture, charges apply when five or more lines are completed.
Preferential Origin	Upon request, or when the documentation is missing at origin, DHL will attach the required certification documents to authenticate the country of origin of certain commodities.
Single Clearance	Non-restricted merchandise based on value and/or commodity is usually cleared on a consolidated manifest for more cost and time efficient processing. DHL will apply a charge if the Importer requests a formal entry when the shipment actually qualifies for an informal or de minimis entry on the consolidated manifest.




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4. TRANSIT TIMES

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5. VOLUMETRIC WEIGHT

Understand how volumetric weight impacts your shipment cost.


The cost of a shipment can be affected by the amount of space that it occupies on an aircraft, rather than its actual weight. This is the volumetric (or dimensional) weight. The volumetric weight of a shipment is a calculation that reflects the density of a package. A less dense item generally occupies more volume of space, in comparison to its actual weight.

How to Calculate Volumetric Weight

The volumetric weight is calculated and compared with the actual weight of the shipment to determine which is greater. Then the higher weight is used to calculate the shipment cost.

Volumetric Division for inches:

Length x Width x Height
139



The volumetric divisor is 139 for inches/pounds or 5,000 for centimeters/kilograms.



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7. SHIPMENT PREPARATION

Pack it right for the express journey.

At DHL, we do everything we can to ensure that your packages are always delivered on time and in perfect condition. To reach their destinations, parcels can travel many thousands of miles through the sophisticated and wide-ranging DHL global network.

HOW TO BEST PACK A SHIPMENT

STEP 1: ASSESS

Consider the weight & fragility

Determine the monetary value

Review packing requirements

STEP 2: PACK



- Use quality double-wall boxesEnsure there is a 2.5-inch
- Ensure there is a 2.5-inch distance between shipment contents and all walls of the box
- Fill all void space with packing materials to prevent contents from shifting. Be sure to place fragile goods in the center of the box and clearly mark the package "FRAGILE" on the outside of the box

STEP 3: SEAL



- Use pressure-sensitive tape that is at least 2 inches in width
- Adopt H-taping method to seal all edge and seams
- Avoid over-sealing your package - Customs staff can open any shipment
- Don't use masking tape, duct tape, wrapping paper, string, rope or cellophane tape on the outside of your packages
- If reusing an old container, be sure it's in good shape, and remove or conceal old shipping labels

STEP 4: LABEL



- Apply shipment label to the top surface of your package
- Clearly display shipment label on a single surface

Multi-Piece Shipments

When shipping multiple express packages under one waybill, affix the original waybill and shipment paperwork to one package. Then affix copies of the waybill to the other packages. Label each box with the total number of boxes in the shipment, such as "1 of 3". "2 of 3" or "3 of 3".




