




Welcome to Rosen Professional Internships

Internship I differs from Internship II & III as it **does not require** you to work or intern while in the course.

The course is going to prepare you to apply, interview and obtain a position for Internship II and beyond. This is accomplished by creating or updating a resume, preparing and recording an Elevator Pitch, and identifying Companies, Associations, and Organizations that align with your career aspirations.
