





DAY 1 WELCOME TO EDINBURGH

Welcome to Scotland - land of legends and romance, from the great cultural cities in the south, to the dramatic mountains and misty lochs of the Highlands. If flying into Edinburgh, join your arrival transfer to be whisked to the hotel (select times).
