CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRY: Each animal will carry papers issued by the Canadian Charolais Association. A certificate of registry duly transferred will be furnished to the buyer for each animal after settlement has been made.

DELIVERY: Buyers are responsible for arranging transportation/delivery for their purchases.

BREEDER'S GUARANTEE, BULLS: Should any bull (14) fourteen months of age or over, fail to prove a breeder after being used on cows known to be breeders, the matter shall be reported in writing to the seller within (6) six months following the date of purchase or (6) six months after the bull has reached (14) fourteen months of age. The seller will then have the right and privilege of (6)six months to prove the bull a breeder. No guarantee is given that semen collected from the bull will freeze.
