

- At least one Individuals & Society subject (group 3)
- At least one Science subject (group 4)
- One mathematics subject (group 5)
- A sixth subject: Arts or an additional subject in group 3 or 4

ELEMENTS OF THE eASSESSMENT

Coursework	ePortfolio Performing Arts <u>or</u> Music <i>Internally marked, externally moderated, dynamic sampling</i>
Personal Project	<i>Internally marked, externally moderated, dynamic sampling</i>
On-screen	Biology, Dutch LL <u>or</u> LA, English LL, History, Interdisciplinary, Math Standard, Spanish LA <i>Externally marked</i>

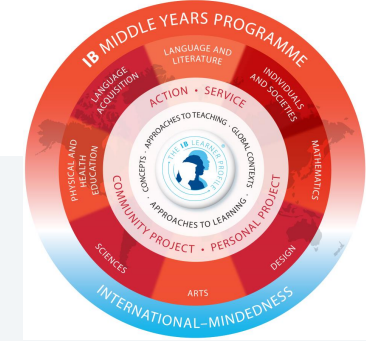




CERTIFICATE

- In order to receive the IB MYP certificate, students must achieve a total of at least 28 points, with a grade of '3' or higher in 8 eAssessment components.
- The maximum total score for the IB MYP certificate is 56, with a grade from 1-7 assigned to each required eAssessment.
- Is not a requirement for the promotion to DP 1.

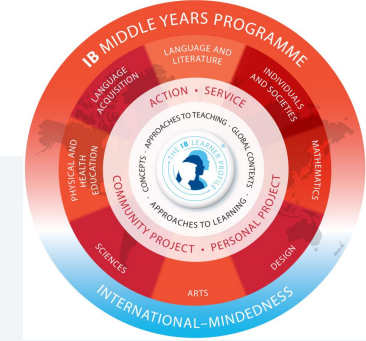




TIMELINE/IMPORTANT DATES
