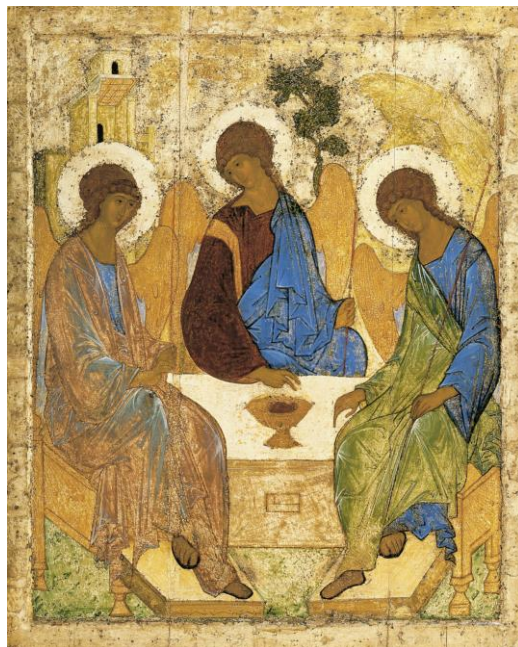

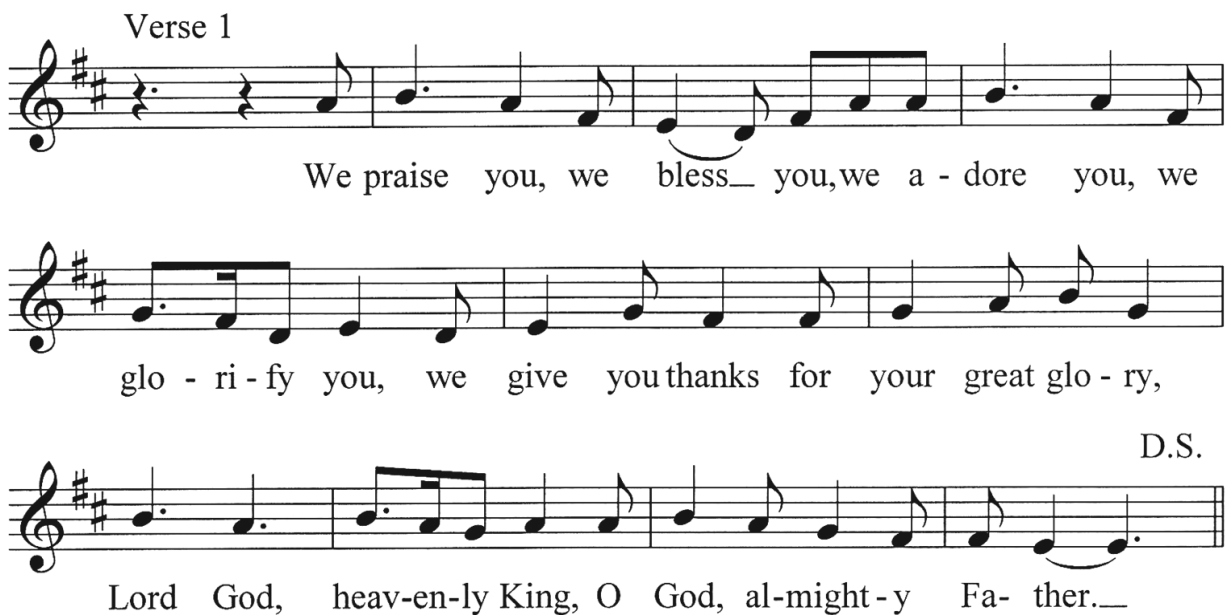

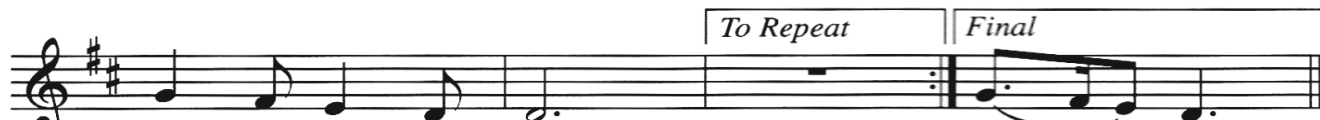

and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures.

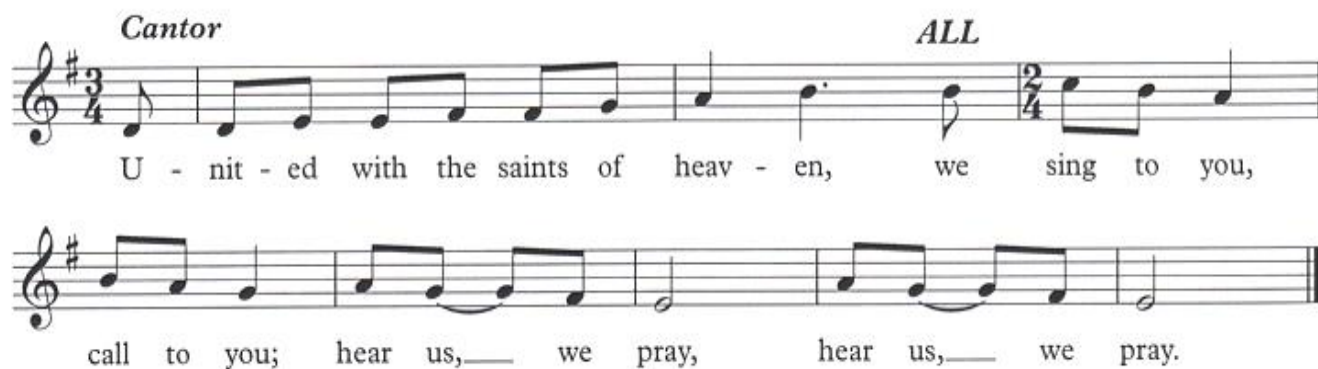
He ascended into heaven

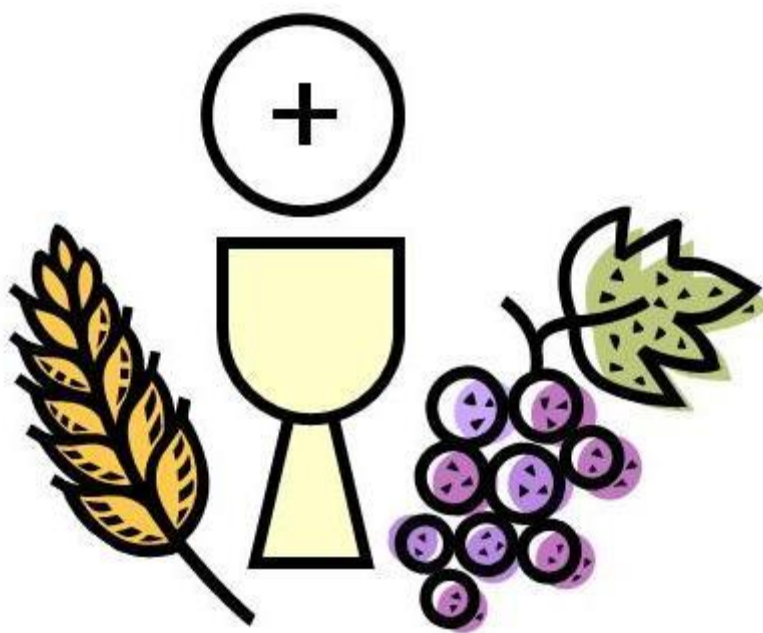
