WHAT WE HAVE TO OFFER!

Quality Staff

Our camp staff are highly experienced and enthusiastic. The majority of our staff works with children year-round in our School Age Programs, which provide continuity for our campers and families. We have additional summer staff who are teachers or college students with child related experiences. Staff receives training in first aid, CPR, water safety, as well as thorough training on camp procedures and the most up to date health and safety policies.

Health and Safety Protocols

- Curbside Drop off and Pick Up
- Daily quick health checks prior to entering camp for all staff and campers
- All staff are required to be fully vaccinated, including boostered.
- Submission of COVID Vaccination cards for those campers vaccinated
- At this time, facemasks required for all staff and children inside at all times except when eating
- Frequent handwashing and sanitizer use
- Small group size with at least 2 staff
- Enhanced cleaning standards in accordance with CDC and IDPH guidelines
- Frequent communication with parents and staff
- Detailed guidelines to come in May



Camp Groups

Campers are placed in small groups with at least 2 camp counselors. Groups are divided by the grade campers just recently completed. During group time, campers participate in age appropriate arts & crafts, sports, and various creative & enrichment activities. Camp calendars, weekly lesson plans, and newsletters will be emailed to families.



Swimming WELCOME BACK!!!

Campers will attend Glenview Park District pools for public swim time on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday mornings from 10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. Tuition and registration fee covers swimming fees for our camp. To ensure your child's safety, counselors receive basic water safety training. Campers are tested by Glenview Park District Lifeguards and the Wesley Director &/or Site Directors to evaluate their swimming ability. Each camper will be given designated pool areas to play in and around. Campers who are non-swimmers or those who do not pass the swim test will be required to wear life vests (provided by Wesley and/or Glenview Park District) and play in water no more than waist deep and within arm's length of their counselor. Our counselors and lifeguards are strategically placed in and around the pools and the campers.

<u>Swim lessons are available and optional</u>. Wesley Campers are provided an opportunity to register for the Glenview Park District group swim lessons. Wesley will bus campers to and from swim lessons. **Swim lessons will be held on Monday and Wednesday mornings for six weeks.** More details on swim lessons will be sent out in the spring.



Fieldtrips <u>WELCOME BACK!!!</u>

Campers will attend weekly fun-filled fieldtrips. We are excited to bring back fieldtrips as we can safely do so. The ever changing environment and status will dictate what field trips we will go on, nevertheless, we WILL be going on fieldtrips!



Theme Days

Wednesdays are Theme Days! Campers participate in activities geared towards a theme. Campers can look forward to such themes as Sports Day, USA Day, Olympic Day and other original themes.



Afternoon Adventures

Campers participate in afternoon adventures from 3:45-5:15 PM. Campers will be engaged in a variety of age appropriate sports, art, and challenging theme activities. Activities may include art, sport, cooking, multi-cultural, language arts, drama, team building, science, and much, more!





Inclement Weather

At times when the weather doesn't allow the campers to go out, whether it is the heat, cold, or rain, our counselors have planned a variety of fun-filled alternate activities for the children inside our campsite.



Meals

Nutritious peanut/tree nut free breakfast, lunch, and afternoon snack provided daily and included with your tuition. Delicious lunches will be provided from Quality Catering. We also offer allergy, gluten free & vegetarian lunch options.



Family Night

Parents are treated to a show performed by the campers recorded ahead of time. Family Night will be held on Thursday Evening on August 4, 2022. Mark your calendars and stay tuned for more information!



Counselors in Training

The CIT volunteer program is reserved for students who have completed 7th & 8th grade. This program is strictly reserved for previous long-time Wesley campers who possess the knowledge, skill, and maturity level of becoming a role model. CITS will be assigned to a specific camp group to assist the counselors.



Cost

Invoices emailed to families each Monday. Tuition payment is due weekly by Wednesday 6 pm. **5, 4, 3, or 2 days per week attendance are available options. Your registration and tuition fee includes all camp activities, daily breakfast, lunch, and pm snack, and a camp t-shirt.** Siblings receive a second child 10% per week tuition discount. For those who have three or more children enrolled in Wesley, all children will receive a 10% weekly discount. Families signing up for <u>all</u> 10 full weeks of camp (June 6 - Aug 12), may take 1 vacation week and pay ½ tuition for that week if your child is absent one full week. *To be eligible for the vacation rate, the children must be off one full week of regular attendance and the days off must be within the same week. Days/weeks may not be split up or combined with other weeks.* **Checks, credit cards, and advance payment is accepted.**

TO REGISTER:

- Complete the enclosed registration form
 - Registration form needs to be completely filled out
- MUST Submit completed registration form with fees TOGETHER
 - Fees per camper = \$100 non-refundable registration fee & last's week's tuition to serve as a deposit
 - Checks should be made out to Wesley Child Care Center
 - To pay by credit card, pay on-line on our website at http://wesleychildcarecenter.com
 - Submit your receipt of payment and your camp registration form TOGETHER
- If submitting by email, forms and receipt of credit card payment must be e-mailed TOGETHER to jquintas@wesleyccc.com
 - Please scan documents and email them (No photos please)
- OR Drop off or Mail registration & fees to Wesley Child Care Center at 727 Harlem Ave., Glenview, IL 60025
- The registration fee of \$100 is non-refundable
- The deposit fee is refundable until April 1, 2022
- If withdrawing after April 1st, your deposit may not be used towards other children or future Wesley tuition
- Once registered, enrollment packets will be sent out in spring which will include emergency forms, permission slips, camp procedures, camp calendar and health and safety information

- 2) Click online payment button at the top of the Wesley home page
- 3) Select Fee category button
 - a. Online Payments, VIEW ALL
- 4) Select a product to purchase
 - a. TO REGISTER FOR CAMP, CHOOSE CAMP SUMMER DAYZ
 - i. Camp Summer Dayz 2022
- 5) Click on the first choice, Camp Registration
 - a. Enter child's last and first name
 - b. Add to cart
- 6) Click continue shopping on far right side of cart
- 7) Click on the choice for the number of days attending camp
- 8) To subtract the additional child discount, select this option from the drop down menu. You will see the adjusted cost in the cart
- 9) Click on the first choice, Camp Registration
 - a. Enter child's last and first name
 - b. Add to cart
- 10) Click continue shopping on far right side of cart if you need to add additional children
