



SCHEDULING

- Most students spend about half a day at Career Center

- Students may take a combination of AP, CTE and/or Honors/Regular/Specialty curriculum courses

SCHEDULING QUESTIONS


- Can I take both AP and CTE classes?

How do I sign up for CC?

- Make your choice Is Career Center for you?
- Register at home schools during regular registration period – choose Career Center selections in online system
- Dually offered AP courses Tell your counselor where you want to take courses such as English, US History, etc.
- Need bus transportation? Tell your counselor
 sign up for at least 3 credits



TRANSPORTATION Buses

- •Free
- Serves all home schools
- Buses run 5 times per day
 - Early Morning from Home School to CC
 - Morning
 - ·Midday (2)
 - Afternoon
- Afternoon run will arrive back at home school in time for buses & after school activities
- IF you think you may need the bus make sure you alert your counselor when you register for classes!



- Parking is assigned in specific lots based on your
 Career Center schedule
 - Your lot assignment is based on when you LEAVE CC.
 - Morning demand may cause us to limit the number of parking stickers sold.
 - Currently we have enough space for all students
- Parking stickers are available at Open House in August
 - Students must have purchased a Home School sticker
 FIRST before purchasing a CC sticker.
 - Currently CC stickers are \$10 in addition to the Home
 School fee.
