Floyd Hale introduced guests and visiting Rotarians while conducting the GRSP raffle.



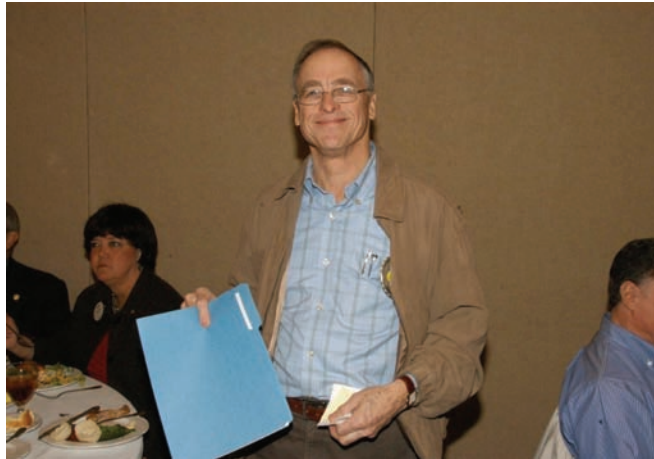
Michelle Miller greeted members and guests at the door.
