### STUDENTS SICK WITH FLU-LIKE SYMPTOMS

Please protect the health and safety of students and staff.

Parents and carers are reminded NOT to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest flu-like symptoms.

Students who present at school as unwell or have flu-like symptoms will be sent home. Arrangements will need to be made to be tested for COVID-19.

Students and staff with flu-like symptoms will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school.

Alternatively students who are unable to be tested for COVID-19 must be excluded from school for a period of 10 days before returning, and MUST have been symptom free for a period of 3 days before returning.


### **VOLUNTARY SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS**

Please note there are no out-of-pocket expenses for families who are eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Scheme. To be eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Scheme a child must be aged between 2-17 years and their family must receive Family Tax Benefit Part A or a relevant Australian Government payment. If your child is not Medicare eligible, we will do a FREE limited Dental Health screening and tooth strengthening remineralisation.
