Regalia

The use of academic regalia dates to the 12th century at the formation of early universities in Europe. Universities lacked buildings of their own and studies were conducted at churches. The standard gown is black. The master's gown is distinguished by tippet sleeves, and the doctor's gown by velvet panels which adorn the sleeves. The standard cap is a mortarboard. The doctor's cap may be a soft tam. The tassel indicates the field of study; however, the doctor's tassel is metallic gold. The color of the cowl and the outside velvet of the hood indicates the field of study and the degree respectively. The inside colors of the hood are the school colors.

HOOD COLORS

The hood is a triangular fold of cloth worn over the back of the gown, and it is faced with colors which denote the field of study represented by the wearer's degree. The colors of the lining indicate the college or academic discipline in which the degree is granted. The various colleges and academic disciplines of PIU are represented by these hood and tassel colors.
