True Discipleship Involves Suffering

The liturgy this weekend invites us to reflect on two themes we often avoid thinking about: suffering and self-denial. As much as today's fast and easy culture makes us think we can run away from these two realities, Jesus tells us that the path to true discipleship is laden with tribulations and trials. If we are to be true disciples, we must deny ourselves, take up our crosses and follow Him. The cross Jesus asks us to take up is not the actual cross He died upon. The cross he talks about today are the trials and tribulations of our everyday lives. They are our health challenges, disappointments, losses of family members, financial challenges, etc. These are often the sources of frustrations in our lives. When we are hit by these harsh challenges, instead of complaining and walking away from God, let us offer them to the Lord in prayer.

In the First Reading, the prophet Isaiah shares with us his own experience of suffering. As God's spokesman, he lived through a period of suffering and pain. He used his "suffering servant" oracle to encourage the Israelites to stay strong during their time of captivity in Babylon.

In the Gospel, Peter is willing to follow "Jesus the Anointed One (Christ)," but not a Jesus who would be crucified. Jesus' condemnation of Peter is based on the fact that in denying the cross, Peter became an obstacle to the mission of Jesus. The word **Satan** is used the one who acts as an **adversary** to the plan of Jesus. Jesus commands him to get behind Him, because the place of the disciple is not in front of the Master, but behind him. As Jesus carried His own cross, the disciple too must learn to carry his and not run away from it.

"Lord, when the crosses of life rise against us, help us not to run away from them. Grant us courage and patience to know that you are always there with us. Through the mystery of your sorrowful passion, you remind us that the cross ultimately leads to the glory of the resurrection."

Can You Walk the Walk?

I've met and talked with enough people to feel confident that if you polled 100 fallen-away Catholics about why they didn't want anything to do with the Church, the term "accountability" would pop up in almost all of their answers.

And to be fair, a lack of accountability isn't just a Catholic problem. Talking the talk but not walking the walk has been a shortcoming handed down throughout the ages, across all creeds and nationalities.

Loving our neighbor, welcoming the stranger, clothing the naked, feeding the poor — it all sounds fantastic, especially when we're the ones saying it. But the doing — well, that's a different story, isn't it? We would do well to remember that Christ calls one of his best friends "Satan" when Peter tries to convince Jesus to stray from his destiny.

Have you ever been called Satan by one of your good buddies? I'll bet it's not a great feeling. But think about what Peter was doing. He had just said, "You are the Christ." And now, mere moments later, he's saying: "Don't say these things. Don't say you're going to suffer. Don't say you'll be killed."

He was telling Christ to squander what the Lord had given him. He was telling him that having faith was fine, but being faithful? It's just a little too hard. God has a destiny for you, too, and He's asking you to be open to it. Maybe it's not in your comfort zone. Maybe you don't think you can do it.

Lord, give us faith — but help us, also, to do the work.

Weekly Gospel Reflection for Families

The Good News

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus begins his journey to the Cross and Resurrection. The disciples are beginning to understand that Jesus is the Christ, but they cannot reconcile their understanding with Jesus' own foretelling that he will suffer, be killed, and rise after three days. Peter rebukes Jesus. But Jesus makes it clear that all who follow him will lose their lives for his sake.

Reflect

As a parent you want what is best for your child. You make sacrifices to provide opportunities for your daughters and sons. Those sacrifices might include sacrificing a career in order to be home with your children or taking on an extra job to save for your child's college tuition. Those sacrifices are everyday examples of what it means to "deny [yourself], take up [your] cross, and follow me" (Mark 8:34).

Today, take time to rest in God's love. Remember those who made sacrifices so that you would have opportunities in life. Pray about the sacrifices you are making or feel called to make out of love for God and others.

Share

At the dinner table throughout the coming week, ask family members to answer the question posed in today's Gospel: "Who do you say that [Jesus is]?" Also invite family members to share the names of those who have helped them come to know Jesus.
