**Qualifying Plano ISD sophomores and juniors can apply now through March 1 for the eighth-annual Plano Mayor's Summer Internship Program. Presented by Capital One, the competitive 'learn-and-earn' program connects Plano teens with some of the area's top corporations and nonprofits. The eight-week paid internship program--offering remote and on-site placements, or a combination of both--runs June 7-July 30 (although some start dates are flexible). Students earn a minimum of \$10 per hour working 20-40 hours per week.**

**Only the first 400 applications will be accepted, so students are encouraged to apply early to avoid being waitlisted. To qualify, students must complete an online application, which includes two short essays. Additionally, applicants must be a current Plano ISD sophomore or junior; have at least a cumulative 3.0 GPA and solid attendance record; be 16 years of age by June 7, 2021; be eligible to work in the United States; and be able to work the entire eight weeks of the internship from June 7-July 30 (or dates determined by the employer).**

Over the next several weeks, each junior and their parents will have the opportunity to meet individually with their counselor .

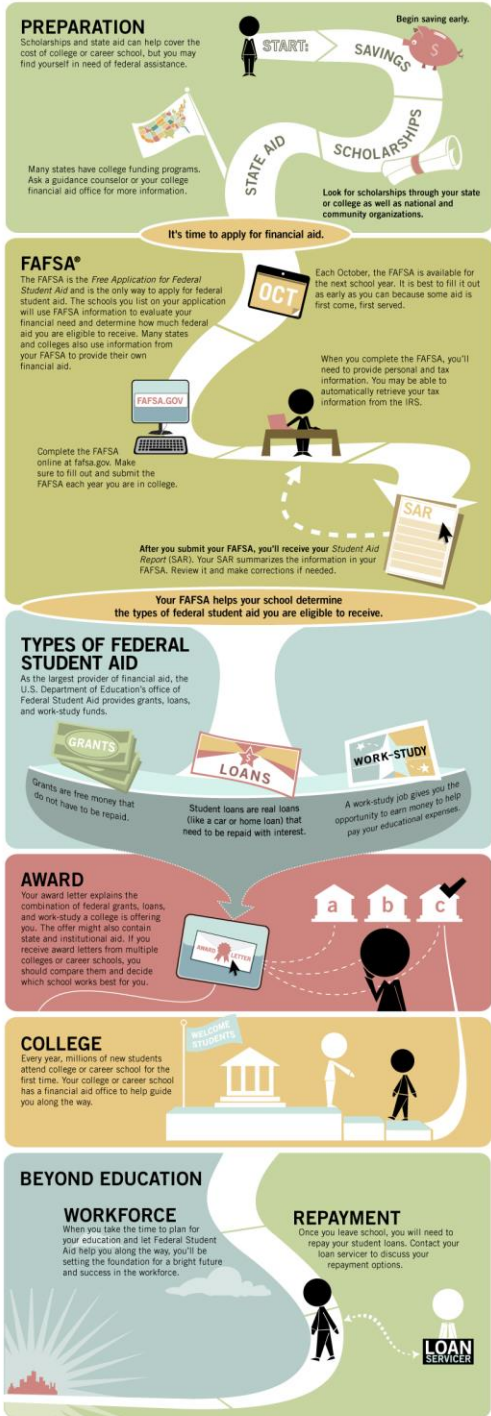
Counselors will help students choose classes for 12th grade and discuss college, career and/or military options for after High School.

### **AP Exam Registration and Payments- Spring 2021 Courses**

- Students enrolled in an AP course that began in the 2nd semester can now register to take the AP exam and pay for it. Payment must be made by February 19<sup>th</sup> 2021.
- Students will log into their College Board website and add their Spring Semester Class's join code in order to register for the exam.
- All payments must be made using the Rycor Student Quick Pay online payment system. <https://www.studentquickpay.com/PISD/>. Fees for 2021 AP exams are \$95 per exam. A reduced fee of \$10 per exam will be available for students enrolled in the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program. Payments made after the deadline will incur an additional \$40 late fee.
- Students enrolled in a year-long or 1st semester AP course should have registered and paid in the fall. If you did not, please contact Melissa Choate at [melissa.choate@pisd.edu](mailto:melissa.choate@pisd.edu).

### **STUDENT PARKING PASSES:**

The cost for student parking permits is **\$30 for the rest of the school year**. To order your parking permit, go to the **Parent Portal** where you did schedule release paperwork. You need to order and pay in the payments section. No cash or checks will be accepted at this time.

You may pick up your parking sticker in **Alpha Student Center** from **7:30 AM – 8:45 AM or your lunch time**. **All drivers MUST have a valid driver's license- no driving permits allowed**. You need to bring your **driver's license and your liability insurance** to be able to pick up your parking permit.
