## Pastor's Corner

Today the Church celebrates Catechetical Sunday. The theme for this year is *"Say the word and my soul will be healed."* Jesus was amazed at the faith of the Roman Centurion who spoke these words. This past week, Fr. Mike received notes from three different parishioners stating they had received text messages on their phones, impersonating him. None of the priests, or staff, will ever reach out to you via text to ask for funds. These are scams. Do not respond!

Scams also impersonate familiar email addresses in an email spoof scam. The unknown party has created fake Gmail address (@gmail.com) using recognizable names and sending requests out for money or gift cards. Please do not respond to the email. The best thing is to delete the message immediately.

**Church of the Nativity staff do not use an address that ends in @gmail.com** and any messages from that account are fraud. Emails from Church of the Nativity or Nativity Parish School will end in @kcnativity.org.

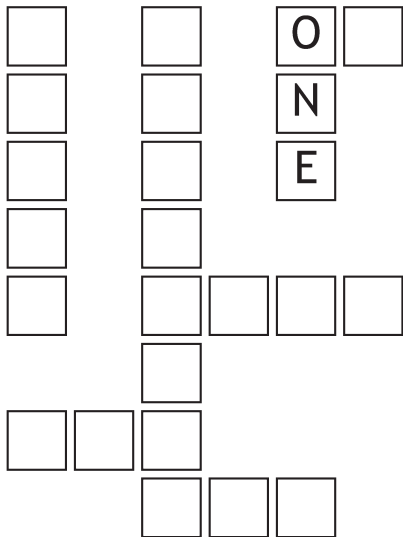

## Part Time Work At NPS

Nativity Parish School is seeking **two part-time Cafeteria Assistants** for the 2021-2022 school year.

The Cafeteria Assistants will be responsible for operating a computer using a meal tracking system by scanning and entering lunch cards at meal time. The positions will be two or three days a week, approximately 12-15 hours per week. The Cafeteria Assistants will also fill in for other cafeteria staff when needed. Additional duties include dishwashing, preparing and serving lunch in a courteous manner, organizing and setting up equipment and workstations, all while following health, food service, government and other guidelines.

Candidates hired will need to pass a criminal background check and attend Virtus training as conditions of employment. We operate on the traditional school schedule. There are no benefits offered.
