## VOLUNTEER TASK NEEDS:

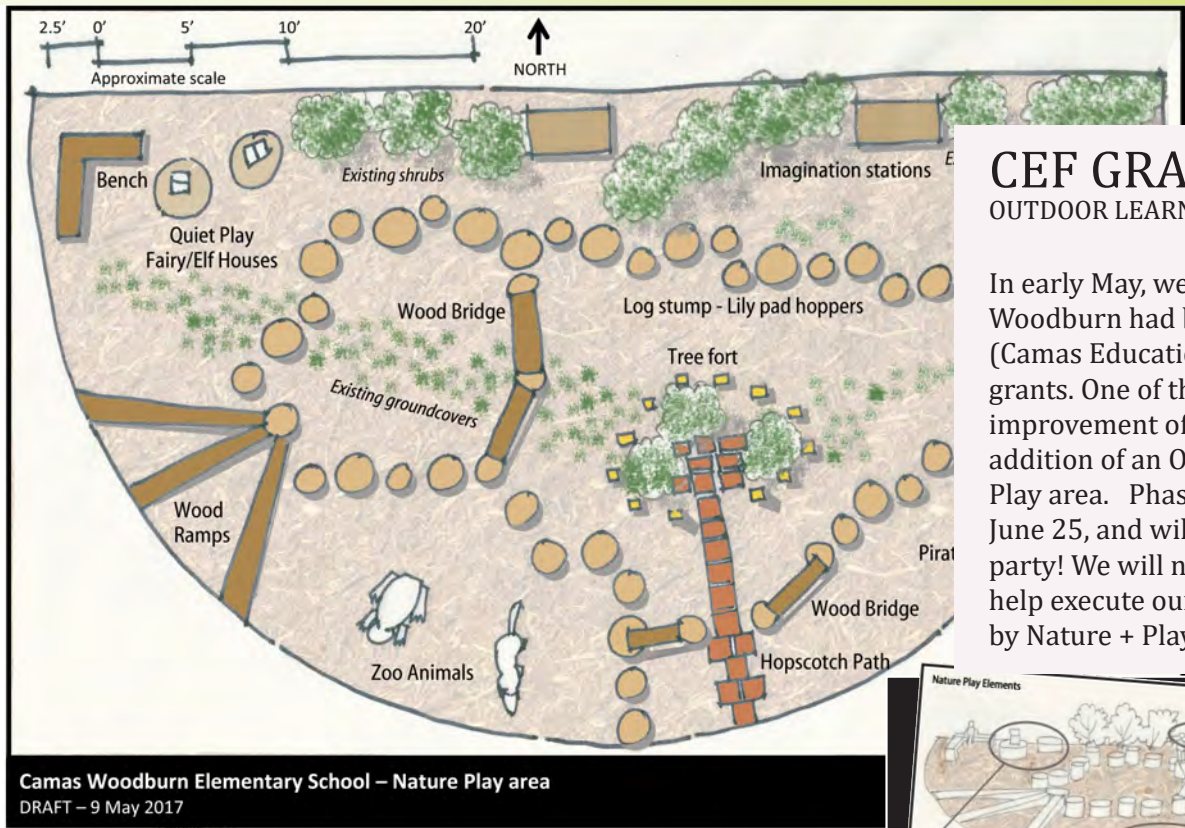
- Build log hopper path and bridges
