#### **Weekly Message**

Dear Parents,

Today is World Teachers' Day, and I started the day with a big Thank You to all my teaching staff for the great work they do every day in shaping young lives and guiding our students to become great citizens. It is critical work, and I am proud to be part of the teaching profession.

It has been an extraordinarily busy week, with many extra activities occurring throughout the week.

Swimming School has continued, and our students are making great progress, finishing up today, having had their assessments done yesterday.

We had another good roll-up for Kindergarten Orientation on Tuesday with over 60 parents attending (as well as all new our 2018 students!) This was the first time that the students had been in the classroom without their parents, so it was very exciting for them to actually be learning like real big school students! Their parents attended an information session with Mrs Neaves and a number of teachers and also Karen Tominez from our P&C. Our thanks go to all those people who helped out.

On Wednesday night we had our BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) information evening, where we presented our vision for the next few years around how we will be implementing Mobile Technology into our school. There was some good discussion and a number of great questions which will help guide us as we explore the possibilities that modern technology offers us.

Yesterday the school got behind Aya Milton, fundraising for her upcoming trip to Adelaide to compete in the swimming at the Pan Pacific Games. We held a Come as Your Favourite Sports Star Day, with many fine looking athletes parading through the school during the day. Aya and her family would like to pass on their thanks to everyone for their support, and we wish her all the best in the competition.

We are currently implementing PAT tests across our school. These are Progress Achievement Tests and are a series of tests designed to provide objective, norm-referenced information to teachers about their students' skills and understandings in a range of key areas. They are recognised as one of the most effective ways to track students' progress, and as they are completed on-line, analysis of the results is relatively simple. These tests will be conducted regularly and will form part of our analysis of our students' learning and will provide valuable information in supporting every student in their learning journey.

On Monday Claire Wren from 6S travelled to Sydney where she was presented with a Fred Hollows Humanity Award, The award recognises Year 6 students who show compassion, integrity and kindness in their lives, just as Fred did. Claire was nominated in recognition for the values and caring actions that she displays every day at Wollongong PS and in the wider community. Congratulations Claire, a well-deserved award.



Next Monday we are having a visit from an NRMA team who will be doing workshops around road safety with all of our classes. Only a few schools state-wide are able to participate in this program each year so a big Thanks to Miss Gray for organising the visit.



#### Intention to apply for Year 7 entry to a selective high school in 2019

Dear Parent/Carer

Selective high schools cater for high achieving academically gifted students who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic and social level. These schools help gifted and talented students to learn by grouping them with other gifted and talented students, teaching them in specialised ways and providing educational materials at the appropriate level.

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on **Thursday 15 March 2018**.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2019, you need to apply soon. You will need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available from 10 October 2017 in a printed application information booklet and at <a href="https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7">https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7</a>. The application website opens at <a href="https://education.nsw.gov.au/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7">https://education.nsw.gov.au/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7</a> on 10 October 2017 and closes on 13 November 2017. You must apply before the closing date.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Unit for assistance after 10 October 2017.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

Remember: the tear-off slip below is not an application and the school cannot apply on your behalf.
