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## Workshops, Music & More At Harvest Fest

AlgomaTrad always seem to have something in the works, as they hosted their first “Harvest Fest,” a weekend festival, which included a concert, dancing, workshops, and a farm table dinner over the course of three days this past Thanksgiving weekend.

Despite the hectic schedule of running the event and having Thanksgiving, Julie Schryer, who runs AlgomaTrad along with her husband Pat O’Gorman, sat down to tell us about the event.

In total approximately 150 people were able to experience the weekend event. This included families who were home for the long weekend and those who were alone, they all had the opportunity to partake in the community event. Since it happened over the course of 3 days, many could make it to at least some of the events they

wanted to attend.

“It was never our intention to hold the AlgomaTrad Harvest Fest on the Thanksgiving weekend” Says Julie, “but we were faced with scheduling challenges that resulted

in a move to these dates for this year. In the future we plan to avoid the Thanksgiving weekend...”

The workshops at Harvest Fest were a big hit; blacksmithing was popular for both young and older people. Julie goes on to tell us, “The weekend ended with young people wanting to go home and build their own forges. The skill level built through the weekend, especially for those who focused on blacksmithing for the entire weekend. Basketry was also very popular, with again, very focused learners working on various projects and

honing their skills throughout the three days. Tracy Stevens also taught a workshop in birch bark basket making using coiled sweetgrass.

“The music and dance workshops were great - they were one-offs depending on interest and level. Fibre arts, block printing, and embroidery had several people dropping in to participate. The crochet community project, featuring local island wool had many participants, both experienced and beginners - this will be completed and assembled by community members, led by Hollie Lefebvre, and be auctioned off at next year’s AlgomaTrad summer family camp.”

The farm to Table dinner, which was one of the more popular events with all 72 seats being taken up, supported many local businesses including: Penokean Hills Farms (beef tenderloin) with blue cheese sauce, the Algoma Produce Auction (vegetables), Island sewist Carolyn McRae who designed and created the beautiful table cloths, a team of local chefs (Jane Wildman, Megan Byman, Suzanne Lambert), the local Food Bank (through a donation in lieu of paying hard working volunteers Rita and Jacques Cloutier), and St. Joseph Island Coffee Roasters’ coffee. The meal also featured a vegan entree for vegetarians.

The Saturday evening meal, concert and dance were



truly a highlight of the weekend where community gathered and were part of something quite special. The Wildman Sisters brought not only beautiful music, but “family” which AlgomaTrad has always supported and loves. All of the other musicians that evening added to the evening in a big way. So many young people, including these musicians got right in there and helped to serve the dinner, and to take dishes away afterwards. They were also joined by more of Jane’s family, including Jody Wildman, who pitched in many hours to make this event meaningful for the community.

This may become an annual event, pending funding, and pending the input from community to help disperse the work load more. There were 21 volunteers who helped with marketing, preparation of the site, food, tear down, and clean up for a total of 85 hours. Pat and Julie donated countless hours in kind for the event.

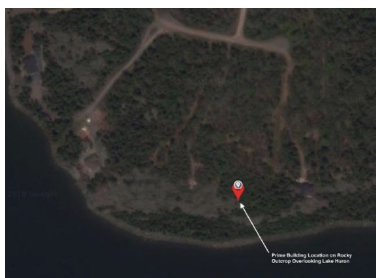

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## Sea Cadet Youth Practice On-Water Skills in Hilton Beach



**HILTON BEACH, ON.-** Seventeen youth from Royal Canadian Sea Cadet Corps 'Royal Sovereign' participated in an on-water training exercise in Hilton Beach, ON the weekend of 28-30 September/ 2018. This is the first time that the corps has conducted such an exercise in Hilton Beach, or on St. Joseph Island.

The purpose of the weekend was to familiarize the cadets with the use of ma-

rine VHF radios, to obtain their marine radio license, and to gain valuable experience on the water in a powerboat. The experience better enables the youth from our community to participate in recreational boating activities safely and increases their knowledge and skill when it comes to using small watercraft.

Participating cadets were coached by qualified instructors on required safety equipment, proper clothing to wear, docking and securing a vessel, maneuvering a boat at no-wake and planing speeds, recovering a man-overboard, coming alongside other vessels and proper use and care of an outboard motor. These skills were practiced while using marine VHF radios to communicate between boats and with personnel on shore.

The Sea Cadets were quartered in the Village of Hilton Beach Community Hall and used the Hilton Beach Marina for on-water training, with the support of council and the community. Despite the chilly weather, the cadets had an excellent time and made lasting memories!

Royal Canadian Sea Cadets aims to develop in youth the attributes of good citizenship and leadership; promote physical fitness, and stimulate an interest in the sea activities of the Canadian Forces. The cadet program is open to all Canadian youth from 12 to 18 years of age. There is no fee to join. They meet every Thursday evening during the school year at the Sault Ste. Marie Armoury from 6:00-9:00pm.


