2 God's Gift of HOPE

Things to do at this stop:

Sing about Hope:

○ *Little Town of Bethlehem*

○ little town of Bethlehem,
how still we see thee lie!
Above thy deep and dreamless sleep
the silent stars go by;
Yet in thy dark streets shineth
the everlasting Light.
The hopes and fears of all the
years are met in thee tonight.

Discuss: As a child, what is the one Christmas gift you hoped for more than anything else?

Look Up: The name Jesus means Savior. Having a savior brings us hope. Use the website meaningofthename.com to look up the meaning of everyone's names in your vehicle.

3 God's Gift of LOVE

Things to do at this stop:

Sing about Love: *Away in the Manger*

Away in the manger,
no crib for His bed,
The little Lord Jesus
laid down his sweet head;
The stars in the sky
looked down where he lay,
The little Lord Jesus
asleep on the hay.

Discuss: Jesus loved all people. How did he show it? How do you show love?

Eat: Enjoy eating a candy cane. Turn it upside down and it forms a "J" in honor of Jesus' name.

4 God's Gift of JOY

Things to do at this step:

Sing about Joy: *Joy to the World*

Joy to the world, the Lord is come!
Let earth receive its King;
Let every heart prepare him room
And heaven and nature sing
And heaven and nature sing

Discuss: There is a difference between happiness (a short-lived feeling often based on circumstances) and joy (a deeper feeling of contentment, knowing God is in control). How have you experienced joy in 2020?

Look Around: Without naming it describe something around you right now that brings you joy. Have others guess what it is.

5 God's Gift of PEACE

Things to do at this step:

Sing about Peace: *Hark! The Herald Angels Sing*

Hark! The herald angels sing,
"Glory to the newborn King!
Peace on earth and mercy mild,
God and sinners reconciled!"
Joyful, all ye nations rise;
Join the triumph of the skies;
With angelic hosts proclaim,
"Christ is born in Bethlehem!"
Hark! The herald angels sing,
"Glory to the newborn King!"

Discuss: Worry and fear can cause us to turn inward, away from God. Jesus' life on earth was an example of serving others. How do you feel when you do something kind to help someone else?

Breathe: Take 5 deep breaths to focus on Jesus. Inhale with thoughts of kindness and compassion. Exhale any anxious thoughts or negative feelings. Feel God's presence and find peace.




At Christmas, we celebrate the greatest gift of all—the birth of Christ. Plan to celebrate with Southwood through:


