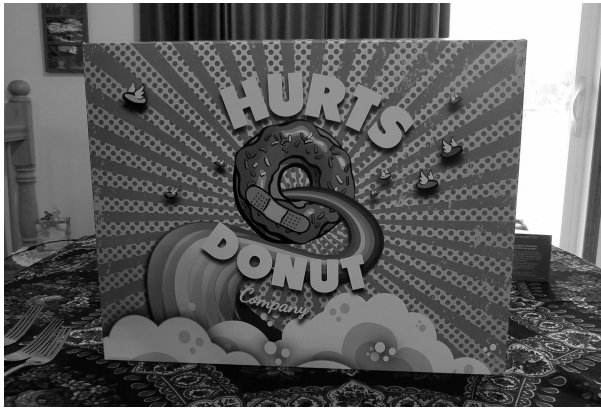


Dear friends,
