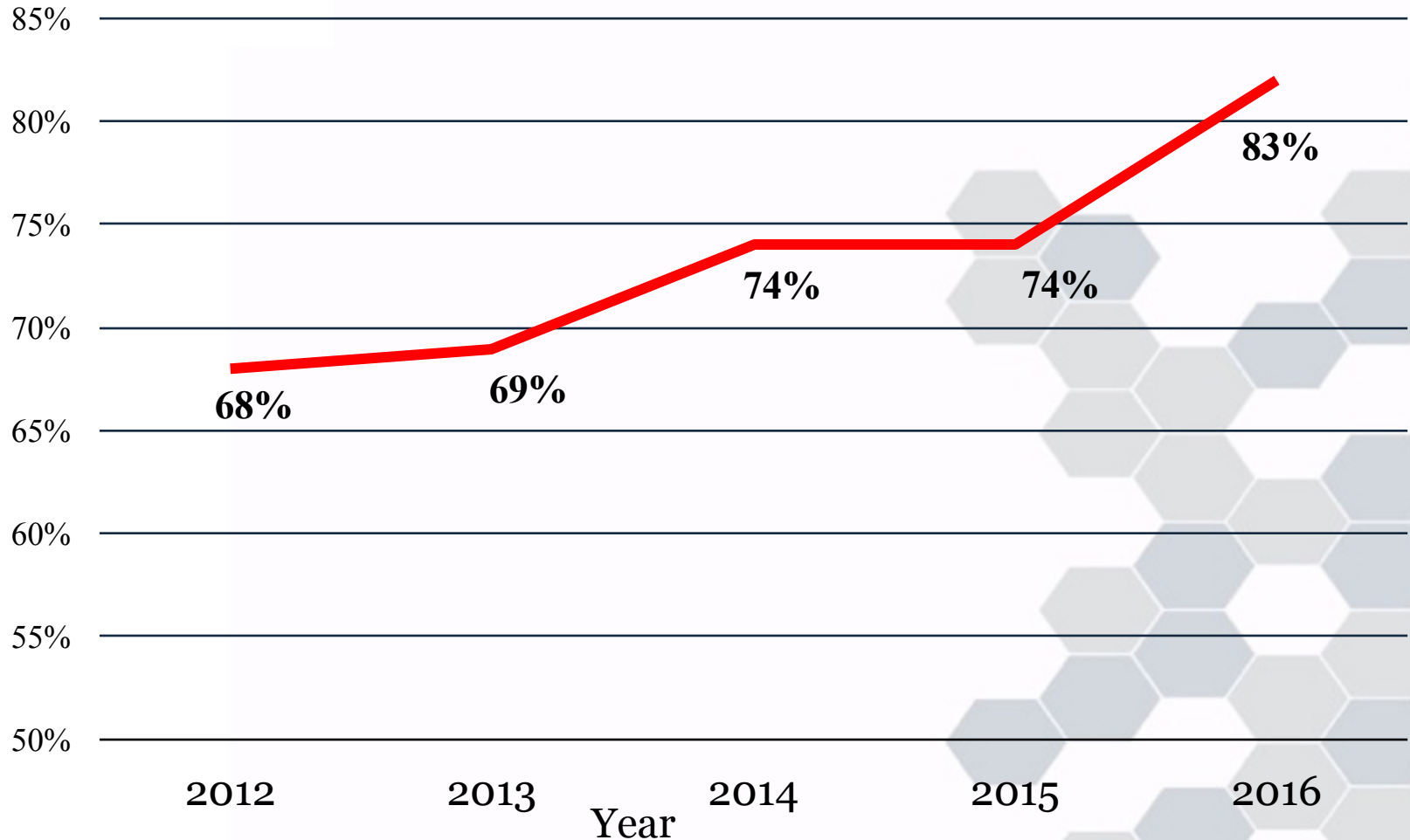

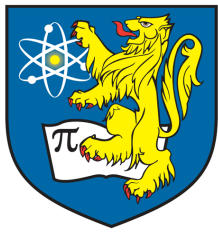

Percentage of Year 11 attaining 5A*-C including English and Mathematics

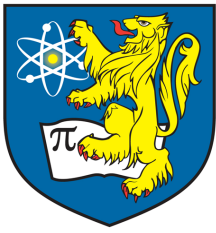
