A LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Wow, what a great year! Many people are probably not saying that or even thinking it, but here at House of Mercy we have seen so many blessings this past year. From some of our best programs like the Campaign to End Hunger and Christmas with Mercy to many new volunteers and partnerships, we have seen so much generosity.

The pandemic certainly threw a wrench into any planning we had been doing to continue to expand the mission of mercy, but it also gave us many opportunities. At the height of the stay-at-home order, our client need increased by 800%, our thrift store was closed and we were losing \$30,000+/mo in revenue, and we could only accept 4-6 volunteers to help our five-person staff. God always prevails. Thanks to all of our supporters, we were able to serve all of our clients and continue our ministry despite these challenges as well as expanding our mission to include making over 5,000 face masks for local healthcare workers. Since mid-June, our client need has decreased slightly but has continues to grow, and our funding has significantly decreased. We know the Lord will guide and protect this wonderful mission, but we need your help.

The verse that has come to mind for me recently is Luke 10:2 which says, "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few." We all need to honor our call as laborers of the Lord's work of mercy because there is much work to be done in this plentiful harvest.

Thank you for all you are already doing to support House of Mercy and I look forward to the work we will do together in the coming year to continue our mission of mercy.




40 % of those served, were during the stay-athome order in Virginia at the start of the pandemic. This was a 54% total increase of people served from the same time period last year.

A 25 year old single mother, Jenifer Escobar Mata encountered struggle after struggle as an immigrant in an unfamiliar country. Her perserverance over abuse, unfavorable living conditions and single motherhood was assisted by the help she found at House of Mercy. It's clients like Jenifer that fuel our mission. At 17 years old, Jenifer escaped the abuse of her mother, stepfather and boyfriend with her 4-month old son to find herself in the care of strangers who opened their home to her to help her get her life back on track. They encouraged her to finish her high school education and helped her to find work.

One of the first things they did was take her to House of Mercy to register for food and baby supply assistance for her and her son. She saw the assistance she got from House of Mercy as a true blessing. That assistance enabled her to spend what little money she made to help support herself and

her child.

The continued support she received allowed her to work towards eventually becoming a realtor.

To this day, she still shops at House of Mercy, not only to support the mission and help feed others like herself when they are in need, but because of the affordable bargains she can find to continue to save money.
